INTRODUCTION

These proceedings are under provisions of Section 23 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition,

Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for determination of compensation in respect of net area of land proposed to be acquired measuring 26 Kanals 605 marlas for Construction of link road namely Telan to Hari Part 2nd in Village Palmar of Tehsil and District Kishtwar. The land acquisition proceedings were initiated with the publication of Preliminary Notification under Section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

The requiring department PWD (R&B) submitted letter of indent for acquisition of land for Construction of link road namely Telan to Hari-Part 2nd in Village Palmar of Tehsil and District Kishtwar. The Tehsildar Kishtwar vide No. 3313-14/OQ/Gen. Dated 22-02-2022, had submitted the land acquisition papers to this office duly completed in all respect for further necessary action.

1. PUBLICATION OF NOTIFICATIONS AND ISSUE OF NOTICES :

The local SIA team was notified as Social Impact Assessment Team (SIA) under Section 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for conducting Social Impact Assessment Team (SIA) vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/97-103 Dated 02-05-2023. Accordingly, the concerned committee members had submitted the Social Impact Assessment Study report within a time bound manner and the same was submitted to the District Collector Kishtwar for appraisal under Section 7 of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/168 Dated 06-06-2023.

The District Collector Kishtwar, constituted a committee of expert group for appraisal of Social Impact Assessment Study report. Accordingly, the Multi-Disciplinary Expert Group for appraisal constituted vide Notification No. DCK/LA/22/F. No.102/107 Dated 08-06-2023 submitted its recommendation.

The SIA report and the recommendation of Multi-Disciplinary Expert Group was then approved and a Preliminary Notification No. ACR/LA/2022-23/207-213 Date 20-06-2023 was issued under Section 11 of the Act stating that the land described in the schedule thereto (thereafter referred to as the said land) was needed or likely to be needed for the public purpose. The notification issued for inviting objections within 60 days.

No objections were received against the Preliminary Notification. The proposal was then submitted to the Appropriate Government i. e. Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) Kishtwar, vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/252 Dated 19-07-2023 seeking approval to proceed with acquisition process and the same was approved ; and

Further on approval of Appropriate Government i. e. Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) Kishtwar, vide Declaration No. 09 of 2023 Dated 27-07-2023 read with endorsement No. DCK/LA/23/F. No. 294/181 Dated 27-07-2023, it was declared under the provisions of Section 19 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 that the land was required for the public purpose namely Construction of Link Road namely Telan to Hari-Part 2nd in Village Palmar of Tehsil and District Kishtwar to facilitate causation of the above requirements, Notice vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/428-34 Dated 21-08-2023 was served under Section 21 of the RTFCLARR Act, 2013, stating that all persons having interest in the land may submit their objections within 30 days and may appear personally or through an agent.

Under Section 21 of the RTFCLARR Act, 2013, the Government intended to take the possession of the land in 30 days from the date of issue of the Notice and claims to compensation for all interests in the land, had to be submitted to the Collector for disposal within 30 days from the date of issue of the Notice. No objections were received against the Notice under Section 21 of the Act.

The case file was as such submitted to the Deputy Commissioner (Appropriate Government) Kishtwar in the shape of Tentative award vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/480 Dated 04-09-2023 for approval of rates. The rates so recommended have been approved by the Deputy Commissioner (Appropriate Government) Kishtwar and conveyed to this office vide No. DCK/LA/23/F. No. 299/246 Dated 19-09-2023.

2. OWNERSHIP :

Name of the persons of whose land under acquisition is standing in the record of rights was ascertained from the revenue records and the same are shown in Award statement.

3. SITUATION, DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF THE LAND :

The total acquired land measuring 26 Kanals-05 Marlas, under acquisition is un-irrigated land and situated in village Palmar of Tehsil Kishtwar District Kishtwar.

4. VALUATION OF THE LAND :

The Principal for assessing the amount of compensation to be awarded has been laid down under Section 26(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 read with endorsement No. REV/LAJK/254/2020 Dated 26-08-2020 and accordingly the market value of the land was determined for further determination of compensation.

5. DETERMINATION OF COMPENSATION :

As per the provisions of Section 30 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, 100% of the Compensation Amount (including market value multiplied by Multiplication Factor) is to be awarded as Solatium as has been determined in the Award statement.

6. COMPENSATION OF LAND :

The Compensation of land is to be paid to land interested persons. The total amount of Award Workout to be Rs. 3,63,81,000/- (Rupees Three Crore Sixty Three Lakhs Eighty One Thousands only).

7. SUMMARY OF THE AWARD :

The award is summarized as under :

8. MUTATION OF OCCUPANCY IN RESPECT OF THE SAID LAND BEING ACQUIRED :

The acquiring department shall ensure that the record of right and all the relevant documents related to the ownership/occupancy of the

said land are accordingly modified and show the transfer of the said land solely in the name of Government consequent to taking over possession of the said land and the payment of the compensation to the concerned interested parties.

9. CORRECTION OF THE RECORD IN THE RECORD OF RIGHTS :

The Tehsildar, Kishtwar shall carry out necessary mutation in the Record of Rights in the name of Indenting Department in respect of land so acquired as per the enclosed Award statement.

10. APPORTIONMENT :

The amount of compensation payable to interested persons as shown in the Apportionment Statement is in accordance with the provisions of Agr. Reform Act, 1976 and the guidelines given by the Revenue Department vide No. REV (LB) 10/80 Dated 23-02-1980 and the latest Girdawari entries in the Field Book as well as in Girdawari Copies. However, in case of any dispute, which is not settled within reasonable time, the amount of compensation will be remitted to the Court under section 64 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for jurisdiction.

11. ENCUMBRANCES :

The land under acquisition is free from all encumbrances and it has been mentioned in the Award statement.

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 86/2022 under Sections 13,18,19 and 39 of ULA (P) Act was registered in the Police

 Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Section 19 of

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Zubair Ahmad Malik and Abdul Majid Deva, were arrested in the case and were found in contact with a terrorist of LeT banned outfit namely Uzair Ahmad Khan S/o Bashir Ahmad Khan R/o Nagam, Kokernag, who provided some posters to the accused viz Zubair Ahmad Malik and Abdul Majid Deva, for carrying out the unlawful activities in the area. Subsequently, during the investigation, 22 posters of LeT banned outfit and some incriminatory material were recovered at their instances respectively ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Zubair Ahmad Malik and Abdul Majid Deva, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of Let banned outfit particularly the terrorist viz. Uzair Ahmad Khan, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to him, besides, procured some posters from the said terrorist for carrying out the unlawful activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :

Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz Zubair Ahmad Malik, Abdul Majid Deva, and Uzair Ahmad Khan, for the commission of offence punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA (P), as indicated against the each accused at Para (6) above, arising out of FIR No. 86/2022 of Police Station, Achabal.

SO—467.—Whereas, on 17-10-2022, a reliable information was received by the Police Station, Shopian, to the effect that some unknown terrorists with the help of their associates/OGWs hurled a hand grenade upon a rented accommodation of non-local labourers, belonging to one Arshid Ahmad Ganie S/o Bashir Ahmad Ganie R/o Herman, Shopian,

with the intention to kill them, resulting in on spot death of two non-local labourers identified as Munesh Kumar S/o Ram Avtar and Ram Sagar S/o Goja Rø/o Danaparwa, UP ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 214/2022 under Sections 302, 307, 120-B IPC, 7/27 Arms Act, 3/4 ESA and Sections 16, 18 and 38 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Shopian, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Section 3/4 ESA was dropped and the offences under Section 224 IPC, 7/25 Arms Act and Sections 20, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, two persons identified as Imran Bashir Ganie S/o Bashir Ahmad Ganie and Owais Manzoor Ganie S/o Manzoor Ahmad Ganie Rø/o Herman, Shopian, were found involved in the commission of offence. Subsequently, both the accused persons were arrested in the case; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Imran Bashir Ganie and Owais Manzoor Ganie, were in contact with the terrorists of LeT banned outfit namely Bilal Ahmad Bhat S/o Gh. Rasool Bhat R/o Check Cholina, Shopian, and one unknown Pakistani terrorist through virtual mode. The accused viz. Imran Bashir Ganie and Owais Manzoor Ganie, on the directions of unknown Pakistani terrorist procured two hand grenade from the accused terrorist viz. Bilal Ahmad Bhat, and on his directions the accused viz. Imran Bashir Ganie, hurled the grenade upon the non-local labourers. Subsequently, during the investigation, 01 hand grenade was received at the instances of accused viz. Owais Manzoor Ganie ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Imran Bashir Ganie and Owais Manzoor Ganie, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit particularly the terrorists viz. Bilal Ahmad Bhat and unknown Pakistani terrorist and under a well knit criminal conspiracy procured hand grenade from them for carrying out the terrorist activities,

besides, on the date of occurrence the accused viz. Imran Bashir Ganie, hurled a hand grenade upon the non-local labourers which resulted on spot death of two labourers ; and

7. Whereas, the accused viz. Imran Basir Ganie, has been killed in an encounter which took place between the terrorists and Security Forces for which a separate case FIR No. 215/2022 stands registered in Police Station, Shopian, and the proceedings under the law would abate against him ; and

8. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of unknown Pakistani terrorist shall continue to ascertain his actual identity and to bring out his role/involvement in the case and supplementary charge sheet against him would be filed in the Court of competent jurisdiction ; and

9. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *aprima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused in the commission of offences punishable under section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names:—

10. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Owais Manzoor Ganie, has been found juvenile and in view of the Section 1(4) of the juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Child) Act, 2015, the apprehension, detention, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act ; and

11. Whereas, the accused terrorist viz. Bilal Ahmad Bhat, is absconding and the proceedings under Section 299 Cr. PC. have been proposed to be initiated against him ; and

12. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the case diary file and all the

other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

13. Whereas, after perusing the Case Dairy File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Bilal Ahmad Bhat, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 18, 20 and 38 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 214/2022 of Police Station, Shopian.
