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HIGH COURT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR AND LADAKH AT SRINAGAR

Notification

No. 2541 RG/LP Dated 30-10-2023.

In pursuance of the Judgment dated 12-10-2017 read with Judgment dated 12-05-2023 passed by Honøble Supreme Court in Writ Petition (C) No. 454 of 2015 titied Ms. Indira Jaising V/s Supreme Court of India through Secretary General & Ors and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16(2) of the Advocates Act, 1961, the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh in supersession of previous notification No.33 dated 25-04-2018 is pleased to notify the Criteria for Designating Senior Advocates.

- (a) This criteria shall be called õCriteria for Designating Senior Advocates, 2023.
- (b) It shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

(1) Definitions :ô

- a. Advocateø means a domicile of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir or a resident of Union Territory of Ladakh, who is duly registered/enrolled with a Bar Council constituted under the Advocates Act, 1961;
- b. Advocate Generalø means Advocate General of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir;
- c. Advocates Actø means Advocates Act, 1961 (Act 26 of 1961);
- d. :Chief Justiceø means Chief Justice of the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh and includes a Judge

- - e. High Courtø means the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh;
 - f. Judgeø means Judge of the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh;
 - g. -Registrar Generalø means Registrar General of the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh;
 - h. -Registryø means the Registry of the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh;
 - i. -Rulesø means the Jammu and Kashmir High Court Rules, 1999;
 - j. :Stateømeans the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir or UnionTerritory of Ladakh;
 - k. -State Bar Council' means the Bar Council of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh.

(2) Eligibility Conditions :ô

- (a) An Advocate shall be eligible to be designated as a Senior Advocate, if he/she:
 - (i) has attained the position of eminence at the Bar;
 - (ii) possesses ability, legal acumen, special knowledge or distinction and reputation achieved in practice of law;
 - (iii) is ordinarily practising in the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh for not less than ten years preceding the date of consideration of his/her case for designation as a Senior Advocate;
 - **Note**: That an application by an Advocate mainly practising before specialised Tribunals and having gained domain expertise shall be considered irrespective of his/her limited number of appearances before the High Court.
 - (iv) has been assisting the Court in administration of Justice maintaining high ethical standards, both inside and outside the Court expected of a Senior Advocate;

- (v) has furnished at least 15 judgments, in the preceding five years, where he has contributed to the growth of law;
- (vi) has furnished five of his best synopses in preceding five years indicating the assistance rendered by him/her to the Court.

(3) Procedure :ô

- (i) All matters relating to designation of Senior Advocates shall be dealt with by a Permanent Committee to be known as õCommittee for Designation of Senior Advocatesö;
- (ii) The Permanent Committee will be headed by the Chief Justice and consist of two senior-most Judges of the High Court; Advocate General will be a Member of the Permanent Committee. The above four Members of the Permanent Committee will nominate another Member of the Bar to be the fifth Member of the Permanent Committee;
- (iii) The Committee shall have a permanent Secretariat the composition of which will be decided by the Chief Justice in consultation with the other Members of the Permanent Committee:
- (iii-a) The process for Designation of Senior Advocates shall be initiated at least once in a year;
- (iv) All applications including written proposals by the Judges will be submitted to the Secretariat. On receipt of such applications or proposals from the Judges, the Secretariat will compile the relevant data and information with regard to the reputation, conduct, integrity of the Advocate(s) concerned including his/her participation in pro-bono work, reported judgments in which the concerned Advocate(s) had appeared; the number of such judgments for the last five years. The source(s) from which information/data will be sought and collected by the Secretariat will be as decided by the Permanent Committee;

- (v) The Secretariat will publish the proposal of designation of a particular Advocate in the official website of the High Court inviting the suggestions/views of other stakeholders in the proposed designation;
- (vi) After the data-base in terms of the above is compiled and all such information as may be specifically directed by the Permanent Committee to be obtained in respect of any particular candidate is collected, the Secretariat shall put up the case before the Permanent Committee for scrutiny;
- (vi-a) That it shall be the prerogative of the Committee for Designation of Senior Advocates, to decide the number of successful applicants for being called for personal interview depending upon the number of applicants, marks obtained and the number of applicants that can be invited for personal interview;
- (vii) The Permanent Committee will examine each case in the light of the data provided by the Secretariat of the Permanent Committee; interview the concerned Advocate; and make its overall assessment on the basis of a point-based format indicated below :ô

- Number of years of practice of the applicant Advocate from the date of enrolment. (10 points for 10 to 20 years of Practice i. e. one mark for each year of practice between 10 to 20 years and 10 points for practice beyond 20 years i.e., one point for each year of practice beyond 20 years to the maximum of 10 points (Total 20 points).
- 2. Judgments (Reported and unreported) which indicate the legal formulations advanced by the concerned Advocate in

- (vii-a) The Committee for Designating Senior Advocates, for assessing the applicant for designation shall take into consideration the judgments, synopsis, specific role played during proceedings before Court for rendering assistance, quality of writing, advocacy skills, contribution towards academic teaching, legal education, research work and publications and it shall be the prerogative of the said committee to decide on the manner of assigning the points under this categoryö.
- (viii) All the names that are listed before the Parmanent Committee/cleared by the Permanent Committee will go to the Full Court.
- (ix) Voting by secret ballot will not normally be resorted to by the Full Court except when unavoidable for reasons to be stated.
- (x) The decision in any event shall be carried by a majority. However, in case of a tie, the Chief Justice shall have deciding vote.
- (4) Undertaking :ô An Advocate who has been designated as õSenior Advocateö shall furnish an undertaking that,ô
 - (a) He/she will abide by the rules regulating the practice of Senior Advocates;

- (b) He will not draft or file pleadings in any Court and shall in all cases be assisted by another Advocate;
- (c) He/she shall not directly give consultation to any litigant.

(5) Registration as Senior Advocate :ô

- (i) Upon furnishing of the undertaking in the manner stated in clause (4), the name of the Advocate who has been designated as Senior Advocate, shall be entered in the Register of Senior Advocates to be maintained by the Court. The order to this effect shall be issued conferring such distinction on the Advocate, by the Registrar General. The Advocate shall thereafter be addressed a õSenior Advocateö of the High Court.
- (ii) Upon an Advocate being designated as Senior Advocate, the Registrar General shall communicate the same to the Supreme Court of India, all the High Courts, Bar Council of India, the State Bar Councils and Bar Associations of Jammu and Srinagar.
- **(6) Review of Proposals** :ô All cases that have not been favourably considered by the Full Court may be reviewed/reconsidered after expiry of a period of two years following the manner indicated above as if the proposal is being considered afresh.

(7) Rights and privileges of the Senior Advocates :ô

- (a) The Senior Advocate shall have a preferential right of audience in all Courts according to his/her seniority as such Advocate;
- (b) The Senior Advocate shall be entitled to wear special robes meant for Senior Advocates;
- (c) The Senior Advocate shall be entitled to such other rights and privileges conferred by the practice of Senior Advocate under the Advocates Act.
- (8) Withdrawal of designation of Senior Advocate by the Court in the event of violation of Rules: ô In the event a Senior Advocate is guilty of conduct which according to the Full Court disentitles the Senior Advocate concerned to continue to be worthy of the designation,

(9) Repeal and Savings :ô The criteria governing enrolment of an Advocate as a õSenior Advocateö and in force immediately before the commencement of these criteria are hereby repealed. Notwithstanding such repeal, any action taken under the criteria, so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these criteria; and all undertakings furnished by Senior Advocates under the criteria in force immediately before the commencement of these criteria shall be deemed to have been modified to comply to these criteria.

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Government Order No. 1041-JK (GAD) of 2023

Dated 28-08-2023.

In accordance with Section 3 and 3A of Chapter II of the Information Technology Act, 2000, read with its Section 5 of Chapter III, dealing with promoting use of digital technologies in government operations and with a

- Digital Signature Certificates (DSC): Digital Signature Certificates (DSC) are a secure and legally valid method for single/ bulk signing and issuing digitally signed certificates for online services.
- eSign: eSign service is an online electronic signature service that can facilitate an Aadhaar holder to digitally sign a document. An Aadhaar holder can Sign a document after Biometric/One Time Password authentication thus requiring no paper-based application form or documents.
- 3. **Document Signer Mode**: Document Signer certificate are issued to organizational software applications for operating automatically to authenticate documents/information attributed to the organization by using Digital Signature applied on the document, documents/information.

All Administrative Departments/Heads of Departments/Deputy Commissioners/Managing Directors of various PSUs/Boards/Corporations are accordingly advised to adopt any of the above-mentioned modes for digital signing of certificates/documents w. e. f. 1st September, 2023 along with ensuring necessary training and awareness of employees in this regard. Details of the aforesaid authntication techniques are annexed as Annexure-A to this order for reference.

- Digital Signature Certificates (DSCs): DSCs ensure secure and legally valid online service certificates, offering robust authentication through electronic signatures in accordance with illegal provisions. Hereøs a general outline of the process:ô
 - a. Choose a Certifying Authority (CA): Select a trusted Certifying Authority (CA) accredited by the Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) in your country. CAs are authorized entities to issue digital signature certificates.
 - b. **Application Form**: Obtain the DSC application form from the chosen CA\(\omega\) website or physical location. Fill out the required detailed accurately and completely.
 - c. **Identity Verification**: You will need to provide valid identity and address proof documents as per the CA requirements. Commonly accepted documents include Aadhaar card, Passport, PAN card, voter ID, and utility bills.
 - d. **Verification Process**: The CA will verify your submitted documents. This may involve in-person verification or submission of documents through an authorized person. Some CAs offer online verification processes as well.
 - e. **Payment**: Pay the prescribed fee for the DSC as specified by the CA. Fees can vary based on the type and validity period of the DSC.
 - f. **Generate Key Pair**: Once your documents are verified and payment is confirmed, the CA will generate a key pair-a private key (Kept confidential) and a corresponding public key. The private key will be securely stored on a hardware token or software, while the public key will be part of your DSC.
 - g. **Issue of DSC**: After verification and key pair generation, the CA will issue your DSC. This may involve providing you with a physical token (USB dongle) containing your DSC or sending you the DSC file along with instructions for installation.

- - h. **Installation**: Install the DSC on your computer system or hardware token as per the CA guidelines. The installation process may include setting a PIN for accessing the private key.
 - i. **Testing**: Test the DSC by signing and verifying sample documents to ensure its functioning correctly.
 - j Use: Your DSC is now ready to use. You can sign documents, authenticate transactions, and access various online services securely.
- 2. **eSign**: eSign provides a streamlined method for subscribes to electronically sign online service certificates, upholding authenticity and compliance with electronic authentication standards. The process is as follows:ô
 - a Choose an eSign Service Provider: Select a recognized eSign service provider that is compliant with legal regulations in your country. These services providers are authorized to offer eSign services.
 - b. **Provide Identity Information**: You'dl need to provide your identity information to the eSign service provider. This might include details such as your name, Aadhaar nember (or other identification number) and contact information.
 - c. Aadhaar Verification: In many cases, eSign is closely linked to Aadhaar authentication. You might be required to authenticate your identity using your Aadhaar number and a One-Time Password (OTP) sent to your registered mobile number.
 - d. **Select the Document**: Choose the document you want to electronically sign. This could be a contract, agreement, form, or any other type of document that requires your signature.
 - e. **Sign the Document**: Use the eSign platform provided by the service provider to affix your electronic signature to the document. This could involve clicking a ::Sign@button, entering a password or PIN, or other authentication methods.

 - h. Verfication: The recipient of the eSigned document can verify its authenticity and integrity by using the appropriate verification tools provided by the eSign service provider or other authorized entities.
- 3. **Document Signer**: Document Signer mode, adhering to established guidelines, ensures the legitimacy and integrity of online service certificates, enhancing trust in digital transactions. The process is as follows:ô
 - a. Choose a Document signing Tool : Select a reputable and secure electronic document signing tool or software. There are various options available, both online and offline, that allow you to sign documents electronically.
 - b. Create an Account (if applicable): If the chosen tool is an online service, you might need to create an account on their platform.
 - c. **Upload Your Document**: Use the toolog interface to upload the document that you need to sign. This could be a contract, agreement, form, or any other type of document.
 - d. **Position Your Signature**: Once the document is uploaded, the tool will typically allow you to place your signature on the document. You might be able to draw your signature using a mouse or stylus, or upload a scanned image of your physical signature.
 - e. Add Additional Information (if needed): Depending on the tool and the document requirements, you might also be able to add additional information like dates, text fields, checkboxes, or initials.

Whereas, on the basis of indent placed by the Inspector General, BSF, Jammu vide No. Axxv/BOP-Maluchak/Engg/2011/430 dated 14-11-2011, notification under Section 4(1) of land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 was issued by Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM), Vijaypur, vide Notification No. 05 of 2015 dated 18-08-2015 endorsement No. SDM/V/201-16/754-60 dated 19-08-2015 followed by Corrigendum No. SDM/V/

Whereas, pursuant to above notification, no objection was received from anyone and District Collector (DC), Samba, accordingly recommended the case to this department vide No. ACR/LAS/16-17/1119 dated 11-11-2016 read with No. DCS/ACR/LAS/18-19/157-58 dated 17-07-2018 and No. DCS/ACR/LAS/19-20/346-47 dated 06-09-2019 for issuance of declaration under Sections 6 and 7 of J&K Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, for construction of Border Out Post (BOP) namely Maluchak; and

Whereas, vide No. Rev/LAJ/Nanga/40/2021 dated 05-03-2021, Deputy Commissioner, Samba was requested to furnish the shadow file containing revenue papers duly authenticated, copy of Section 4(1) and recommendations/letter for issuance of declaration under Sections 6 and 7 of Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990; and

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Samba vide No. DCS/ACR/LAS/2023-24/200-204 dated 01-07-2023 has forwarded the shadow file duly prepared by Collector, Land Acquisition concerned which includes copies of all relevant documents pertaining to the case :ô

- a. Land is needed purely for public purpose i.e. construction Border Out Post (BOP) by BSF at Village Nanga, Tehsil Ramgarh.
- b. Sufficient funds on account of land compensation are available with the border Security Force (BSF).
- c. Land has not been acquired earlier on for subject public purpose.
- d. aks titima has been authenticated by the Border Security Force (BSF) as a token of its correctness.

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Samba vide letter referred above has requested that declaration under Sections 6 and 7 of Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 be issued for acquisition of land measuring 26 Kanals 01 Marla situated in Village Nanga, Tehsil Ramgarh being acquired for public purpose i.e. construction of Border Out Post (BOP) by BSF; and

Whereas, the case was examined in the department and it has been found that no one has filed any objection to the proposed acquisition; and

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof are given above is required for public purpose i.e. for construction of Border Out Post (BOP) namely ∴Maluchak∰

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 6 of the J&K Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 26 Kanals 01Marla situated in Village Nanga, Tehsil Ramgarh, District Samba is required for public purpose i.e. for construction of Border Out Post (BOP) namely
∴Maluchakøby Border Security Force (BSF). Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Vijaypur is directed under Section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person(s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be held specifically responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of land involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested person/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in force, while making the award. The Collector/Indenting Department shall also ensure that no compensation shall be made for the portion of land which has already been acquired for the road in question.

The fire was retaliated, triggering an encounter; and

Whereas, during the investigation, the dead body of one terrorist of HM banned outfit who was later on identified as Mohd Iqbal Ganie S/o Mohd Abdullah Ganie R/o Nowpora, Dooru, was recovered from the place of encounter. During the investigation, arms/ammunition viz. 01 Pistol with magazine, 04 Rounds and 01 hand grenade, were also recovered from the place of occurrence; and
- 4. Whereas, during theinvestigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recordedunder the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, one Shabir Ahmad Rather S/o Ab. Razzag Rather R/o Mehmoodabad, Dooru, was found involved in the case. Subsequently, the accused was arrested and it was found that he was working for the said terrorist in order to promote terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Shabir Ahmad Rather, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists particularly the killed terrorist viz. Mohd Iqbal Ganie, and was providing logistic support and information anout the movement of Police/Security Forces to the said terrorist; and
- 7. Whereas, the accused terrorist viz. Mohd Iqbal Ganie, has been killed in the said encounter and the proceedings under the law would abate against him; and

8. Whereeas, on the basis of investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and the other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name:—

Whereas,the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section(2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Shabir Ahmad Rather, for the commission of offence punishable under Section 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 30/2019 of Police Station, Dooru.

SO-448.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 19 of the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006 (Central Act 6 of 2007) read with Notification S.O. 1274(E) dated 30-05-2008 issued by Ministry of

Home Affairs, GoI, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby makes the following rules; namely:—

- 1. **Short title and commencement**.ô (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Prohibition of Child Marriage Rules, 2023.
- (2) These rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. **Definition**.ô (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,ô
 - (a) õActö means the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006 (Central Act 6 of 2007);
 - (b) õGovernmentö means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
- (2) Words and expressions used and not defined in these rules but defined in the Act shall have the meaning respectively assigned to them in the Act.
- 3. **Child Marriage Prohibition Officer**.ô The following officers of the various Departments of the Government shall act as Child Marriage Prohibition Officer in terms of Section 16(1) of the Act within their respective jurisdiction :ô
 - (a) Chief Medical Officer.
 - (b) Chief Education Officer.\
 - (c) Assistant Commissioner (Panchayat).
 - (d) Block Medical Officer.
 - (e) Block Development Officer.
 - (f) Assistant Labour Commissioner.
 - (g) District Social Welfare Officer.
 - (h) Child Development Protection Officer.
 - (i) Tehsildar.
 - (i) Naib-Tehsildar.
 - (k) Zonal Education Officer.

4. **Duties and functions of Child Marriage Prohibition Officer**.ô In addition to the duties and functions assigned to the Child Marriage Prohibition Officer under Sub-Section (3) of Section 16 of the Act, it shall be the duty of every Child Marriage Prohibition Officerô

- (a) to act immediately upon any information of solemnization of any child marriage that may be received through any mode of communication including written or oral i. e. through a letter, telephone, telegram, e-mail etc. or by any other means and forthwith initiate all necessary action;
- (b) produce the child whose marriage is expected to be solemnized or child victim of Child Marriage before the Child Welfare Committee constituted under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2016 and Jammu and Kashmir Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Rules, 2021;
- (c) to furnish quarterly return and statistics to the District Magistrate concerned and the Directorates of Social Welfare, Jammu/Kashmir in Form I;
- (d) to file petition before a Judicial Magistrate, First Class/ Metropolitan Magistrate for obtaining information prohibiting a Child Marriage;
- (e) to file petition for annulling a child marriage in District Court in case any of the contracting party to the marriage is a minor;
- (f) to file petition before the District Court for maintenance and residence to the female contracting party of the Marriage until her remmariage;
- (g) to file petition before the District Court for the custody and maintenance of children of the child marriage
- (h) to file petition under Section 3(2) of the Act along with the child.
- 5. **Filing the case**.ô Any person in the best interest of the child may also file a petition through Child Marriage Prohibition Officer.

- 6. **Power of Child Marriage Prohibition Officer**.ô In terms of Section 16 (4) of the Act, the Child Marriage Prohibition Officer are invested with the powers of Police Officer as prescribed in Sections 156, 160, 161, 165 and 175 of Criminal Procedure Code subject to the condition that such powers are exercised by the said officer herself/himself within her/his jurisdiction for taking cognizance of offences prescribed under the Act.
- 7. Panchayat Core Committee.ô The District Magistrate shall ensure that in every Panchayat, a Committee comprising of the following persons is constituted to assist the Child Marriage Prohibition Officer in obtaining information about such child marriages, in prevention of such ceremonies and in annulling of such marriages:ô

Sarpanch : Chairperson

Supervisor, : Convenor

Mission Poshan (Social Welfare)

Village Level Worker/ : Member

Secretary Panchayat

Headmaster of the nearest school/ : Member

Senior Teacher

(Where there is no Headmaster)

One Women Ward Member : Member

(If more than one Women Ward Member, the Senior most by age)

- 8. **Duty of Local Priest**.ô It shall be the duty of the local priest of any religion bestowed with the solemnization of marriages, to inform the Child Marriage Prohibition Officer of her/his area about the likelihood of such Child Marriages and shall refrain from solemnizing such marriages with a view to prevent such instances of child marriage.
- 9. **Information about child marriage**.ô (1) Any person who has reason to believe that a child marriage has been, or is being, or is likely to be solemnized, may give information through letter, e-mail, telephone call or in any other manner, to the Child Marriage Prohibition Officer,

Childline services, the Special Juvenile Police Unit, the Child Welfare Police Officer, the Child Welfare Committee having jurisdiction in the area.

10. **Award**.ô The Government may declare suitable awards for such persons on whose initiatives/information the incident(s) of Child Marriages have been prevented. The District Magistrates shall also felicitate such persons on suitable occasions of National importance:

Provided that the identity of the person would be kept confidential if he/she so desires, keeping his safety and interest in consideration.

Ms. Farhat Tasleem, applied for the grant of passport facility in Passport Office, Jammu with file No. 20/70/96 on 15.03.1996, along with the requisite documents for issuance of Passport including Vigilance Clearance issued from the Office of the Commissioner of Vigilance, J&K, with profession shown as Jr. Statistical Assistant, Planning Department. On receipt of clear PVR from CID, J&K the Passport was issued in her favour bearing Passport No. A5231007 with date of issue as 23-03-1998, valid up to 22-03-2008, issued by Passport Office, Srinagar. On the expiry of the Passport, the accused lady applied for re-issuance of the Passport at the Embassy of India, SaudiaArbia, under File No. SAURPO849508 with profession shown as a õHouse wifeö. Accordingly, a Passport No. F7207245 with the date of issue as 24-02-2008, valid up to 23-02-2009, was issued in her favour and later the validity of passport was extended up to 23-02-2018 from Embassy of India at Riyadh; and

- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that on the expiry of Passport No. F7207245, the accused lady viz. Ms. Farhat Tasleem, applied for re-issue of passport at Passport Office, Srinagar under file No. SG1071804573417 with requisite documents and mentioned her profession as õNot Employedö in the said form and on receipt of clear PVR from J&K CID, with the profession as õhouse wifeö the passport was issued in her favour bearing Passport No. R9002163 valid up to 15-02-2028, therefore, the accused lady viz. Ms. Farhat Tasleem, acquired Passport bearing No. R9002163, by submitting false information as the accused lady viz. Ms. Farhat Tasleem, was aware that the passport canot be issued in her favour as she was under suspension and to obtain the Passport she submitted the false information to the Passport Office; and
- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused lady viz. Ms. Farhat Tasleem has applied for Passport from the Passport Office, Srinagar vide Passport Application Form No. SG1071804573417 and mentioned her profession as õNot Employedö on the PVR Form, thereby knowingly acquired a Passport on submitting false information to the Passport Office; and
- 7. Whereeas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie* involvement of the accused lady Ms. Farhat Tasleem, Statistical Assistant, in the commission of offence punishable under Section 12 of the Passport Act, 1967; and
