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HIGH COURT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR AND LADAKH (Office of the Registrar General at Srinagar)

Notification

No. 2540 of 2023/RG Dated 23-10-2023.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 23 of the Contempt of Courts Act-1971, (Act No. 70 of 1991) read with Article 215 and 225 of the Constitution of India, the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh hereby makes the following Rules to regulate the proceedings for the Contempt of itself and of Courts Subordinate to it under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

1. Short Title and Commencement :

- These Rules may be called õThe Rules, to regulate proceedings for Contempt of the Subordinate Courts and the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir & Ladakh, 2023ö.
- (ii) These Rules shall come into force on the date of their publication in the J&K Govt. Gazette.

2. Definitions :— In these Rules unless there is anything repugnant to the context :

- (a) õActö means the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 ;
- (b) õAdvocate Generalö means the Advocate General (for the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir);
- (c) õChief Justicö means the Chief Justice of the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh ;
- (d) õCodeö means the "Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, as amended from time to time ;
- (e) õFormö shall mean the forms mentioned in the appendix to these Rules ;

- (f) õHigh Courö means the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh ;
- (g) õJudgeö means the Judge of the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh ;
- (h) õRegistrarö means -Registrar Judicialø and shall include Joint Registrar Judicial or any other officer as may from time to time be specified by the Chief Justice ;
- (i) õSubordinate Courtö means any court subordinate to the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir but does not include õPanchayati Adalat or Village Adalatö etc ;
- (j) õEx-facie contemptö includes a commission of any of the offences mentioned in Section 345 of the Code, in the view, or, presence of, any Judge or Judges of the High Court sitting in Court ;
- (k) All other words and expressions used in these Rules, but not defined herein, shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Act.

3. Form of Motion :

- Every motion for initiating action for Contempt of Court shall be in the form of petition described as Contempt Petition (Criminal) in respect of Criminal Contempt and Contempt Petition (Civil) in respect of Civil Contempt.
- (2) Every petition under the Act shall be presented in the office of Registrar and registered as Contempt Petition (Civil) or Contempt Petition (Criminal).
- (3) If there are allegations of commission of both Civil Contempt and Criminal Contempt against the same person/persons, two separate applications shall be moved, one dealing with Civil Contempt and the other with Criminal Contempt.
- (4) In case of Civil Contempts, certified copy of judgment, decree, order, writ or undertaking, which is alleged to have been disobeyed, shall be filed along with the petition.
- (5) Every Civil Contempt shall be accompanied by as many extra copies as there are respondents.

(6) The Registry shall prepare the paper book in triplicate in case of Criminal Contempt and all relevant material brought on the record from time to time shall be included in the paper book.

4. Cognizance :

- (1) Proceeding in connection with a Civil Contempt may be initiated :ô
 - (a) by a petition presented by a party or parties aggrieved ; or
 - (b) by the High Court on its own motion ; or
 - (c) in case of any Civil Contempt of a Subordinate Court on a reference made to it by that Court.
- (2) Proceeding in connection with a Criminal Contempt may be initiated :ô
 - (a) on a motion of the High Court in respect of a Contempt committed in its own view under Section 14 of the Act ; or
 - (b) on its own motion by the High Court under Section 15 of the Act ; or
 - (c) on a motion founded on a petition presented by the Advocate General ; or
 - (d) on a motion founded on a petition by any other person with consent in writing of the Advocate General ; or
 - (e) on a reference made to High Court by the Subordinate Court.

5. Contempt Proceedings :

When proceedings are initiated on behalf of an aggrieved person, every petition, motion or reference shall contain :ô

- (a) The name, description, age and registered postal address of the petitioner/petitioners and the person/persons charged ;
- (b) Nature of the Contempt alleged and the material facts including the date/dates of the Commission of alleged Contempt, as may be necessary for the proper determination of the case ;

- (c) If a petition has previously been made by him on the same facts, the petition previously made and shall also indicate the result thereof ;
- (d) the petition shall be supported by an affidavit ;
- (e) Where the petitioner relies upon a document in his possession or power, he shall file such document or documents or true copies thereof with the petition or make a reference in the petition that the document or documents relied upon cannot be immediately had due to reasons beyond his control and that the same shall be filed in due course of time ;
- (f) No court fee shall be payable on the petition or any documents filed in the proceedings ;
- (g) The petition shall be signed by the petitioner or his duly authorize agent ;
- (h) Every petition shall be verified by the solemn affirmation made by the petitioner or by a person/persons having cognizance of facts stated and shall state clearly by reference to the paragraph so the petition, whether the statements are based on knowledge, information and belief or on record, where a statement is based on record sufficient particulars shall be given to identify the records ;
- (i) Where the petitioner is a company there should be appended an affidavit of Competency and if the petitioner or the respondent is a Corporation provisions of Order XXIX of the CPC, in so far as they are applicable, shall apply;
- (j) Where the respondent is the State Govt., or the Central Govt., the cause title shall mention the person upon whom the notice or the rule is to be served.

6. Initiation of proceedings :

- (1) Every petition, motion or reference to Civil Contempt shall, unless directed otherwise by the Chief Justice, be laid before a Single Bench.
- (2) Every petition, motion or reference in relation of Criminal Contempt shall, unless directed otherwise by the Chief Justice

> be laid for motion hearing before Division Bench constituted by the Chief Justice.

- (3) Where a Bench constituted by the Chief Justice for hearing any petition declines to hear the case on personal grounds or otherwise or if one of the Judges constituting the Bench, in case it consists of more than one Judge, declines to hear the case on such grounds, the matter shall be placed before the Chief Justice for re-assigning the case to some other Bench.
- (4) When an application for initiating a proceeding in Criminal Contempt is received by a Judge other than the Chief Justice, he shall direct the Registrar that it be laid before the Chief Justice for orders.
- (5) The Chief Justice may decide either by himself or in consultation with other Judges of the Court whether to take cognizance of the information/application for initiating a proceeding in criminal contempt either received by him or by any other Judge and without the orders of the Chief Justice, such application/information shall not be registered as Criminal Contempt Petition.
- (6) Every petition shall be posted before the Court for preliminary hearing and orders as to issue of notice. Upon such hearing, that Court, if satisfied that no *prima facie* case has been made out for issue of notice, may dismiss the petition, and, if not so satisfied direct that notice of the petition be issued to the respondent.
- (7) Where Contempt is committed in the presence of Court, or during the hearing of a case by the Court, the proceedings initiated for such Contempt shall be conducted in accordance with the procedure laid down in Section 14 of the Act.
- (8) Every reference relating to Contempt of Court received from Subordinate Courts shall along with the report of Registry be laid before the Chief Justice who shall have the discretion to file the same or to order that the same be laid before the Bench constituted by him for orders.
- (9) All references made by the Subordinate Courts other than the Courts of District and Sessions Judge shall be forwarded

(10) In all cases cognizance of which has been taken *suo moto*, or on a reference made by the Subordinate Court, the UT Administration of Jammu and Kashmir or Ladakh, (as the case may be), shall be described as the petitioner and the Advocate General or any other Counsel representing Administration, shall conduct prosecution for Contempt in such cases.

7. Criminal Contempt of Subordinate Court u/s 15 of the Act :

- (a) Reference u/s 15(2) of the Act may be made by the Subordinate Court either *suo moto* or in an application received by it.
- (b) Before making a reference the Subordinate Court shall hold a preliminary enquiry by issuing a show cause notice to the alleged contemnor, along with copies of relevant documents, if any, and after offering an opportunity of being heard the subordinate Court shall write a concise reasoned order of reference indicating why Contempt of Court appears to have been committed ; and
- (c) Every motion made by the Advocate General u/s 15(2), of the Act shall state the allegations of facts and the view of the informant that in relation to these facts Contempt appears to have been committed of which the Court should take cognizance and take further action. The motion should contain sufficient material to indicate why the Advocate General is inclined to move the Court.

8. Admission and Notice :

- (a) Where the Chief Justice or such Judge or Judges of the High Court to whom the matter is referred under Rule 6 decides/ decide that action should be taken under the Act against the alleged Contemnor, the Registrar shall cause the notice to be issued to the alleged Contemnor ;
- (b) Every notice issued by the High Court shall be in the form appended to these rules and shall be accompanied by a copy

of the motion, or petition of reference, as the case may be, together with the copies of the affidavit, if any ;

- (c) The notice shall bear the date, the seal of the High Court and shall be issued under the signature of the Registrar Judicial;
- (d) Notice of every proceeding under the Act shall be served personally on the person charged, unless the Court, for reasons to be recorded, directs otherwise. In that case the service may be effected by alternative forms of service as may be directed by the Court ;
- (e) Where it is proved to the satisfaction of the High Court that the person charged is, absconding or is likely to abscond or is keeping or likely to keep out of the way to avoid service of the notice, the High Court may order the issue of warrant of his arrest in addition to attachment of his property under Sub-Sections (3) and (4) of Section 17 of the Act. Such warrant may be endorsed in the manner laid down in Section 76 of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973, in terms of the order of the High Court ;
- (f) In every case of Criminal Contempt, the accused shall appear in person before the High Court, on the first date of hearing and on every subsequent date to which the case is posted, unless exempted by an order of the Court ;
- (g) In every case of Civil Contempt, the accused shall appear either in person or through Counsel before the High Court on the first date of hearing and on every subsequent date to which the case is posted, but shall appear in person whenever directed by the Court.

9. Enquiry :

- (a) Any person charged with Contempt of Court other than contempt referred to in Sec.14, may file an affidavit in support of his defense on the date fixed for his appearance or on such other date as may be fixed by the Court in that behalf;
- (b) If such person pleads guilty to the charge, his plea shall be recorded and the Court may, in its discretion, convict him thereon ;

- (c) If such person refuses to plead or does not plead, or claims to be tried or the Court does not convict him on the plea of guilt, it may determine the matter of the charge either on the affidavits filed or after taking such further evidence as it deems fit ;
- (d) The Court may pass such orders for the purpose of securing the attendance of any person to be examined as a witness and for the discovery or production of any document as it deems expedient in the ends of justice.

Provided that the High Court may also direct any Subordinate Court to record evidence and submit. the same to the High Court. The Subordinate Court will have all the powers of recording evidence under the Civil Procedure Code and Criminal Procedure Code.

10. Bail :

(1) Where any person charged with contempt, appears or is brought before the High Court and is prepared, while in custody or at any stage of the proceedings to give bail, such person shall be released on bail, if a bond for such sum of money as the High Court thinks sufficient is executed with or without sureties on condition that the person charged shall attend at the time and place mentioned in the bond and shall continue to so attend until otherwise directed by the High Court.

Provided that the High Court may, if it thinks fit, instead of taking bail from such person, discharge him on his executing a bond without sureties for his attendance as aforesaid or without executing such bond.

- (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in Sub-Rule (1) :ô
 - (a) Where a person fails to comply with the time and place of attendance, the High Court may refuse to release him on bail, when on a subsequent occasion in the same case he appears before the High Court or is brought in custody and any such refusal shall be without prejudice to the powers of the High Court to call upon any person bound by such bond to pay the penalty thereof.
 - (b) The relevant provisions of Code of Criminal Procedure 1973, shall so far as may be, apply to all bonds executed under the Rules.

11. Appeals :

- (1) Every appeal filed under S.19 of the Contempt of Courts Act 1971 shall be registered as "Contempt Appeal" and duly numbered as such.
- (2) (a) Every such appeal, shall be posted before a Bench of not less than two Judges, if the order appealed against is passed by a Single Judge of the Court ;

(b) If the order appealed against is passed by a Bench of not less than two Judges, the appeal shall lie to the Supreme Court ;

(3) The procedure for regulation of such appeals shall be the same as for appeals under clause 15 of the Letters Patent.

12. Miscellaneous :

- (1) *Right to defend*: Every person against whom proceedings are initiated under the Act may as a matter of right be defended by an advocate of his choice competent to appear before the High Court.
- (2) Evidence : In all matters under the Act the charge may be determined either on the affidavits filed (and documents, if any) or after taking such further evidence as may be necessary. Where the Court summons any person to appear as a witness in any proceedings, the expenses of such witness or witnesses, as determined according to the rules for the time being in force, shall be paid by the Registrar out of the contingency funds, provided that the Court may direct any party to the proceedings to pay such expenses.
- (3) Provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure/Civil Procedure Code to be followed : The provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure and the Civil Procedure Code which are not inconsistent with the provisions of the Act and these Rules, shall be applicable to enforce and execute the orders passed by the High Court in proceedings for Contempt.
- (4) *Proceedings under other Laws*: Proceedings initiated under the Act, shall not be a bar to any Court for proceeding under the provisions of other laws relating to Contempt of Courts. The Proceedings in the High Court may be in addition to any impending proceedings before the Courts or proceedings that

may be initiated during the pendency of a contempt proceeding before the High Court.

13. Costs :

The High Court may direct any party to a proceeding under the Act to pay the costs thereof as determined by it to any other party thereto.

14. Execution :

It shall be the duty of the Registrar to carry out, enforce and execute the orders passed by the High Court in any proceeding under the Act, and in particular, orders imposing fines or awarding costs.

15. Procedure on Apology :

- (a) If at any time during the pendency of the proceeding or thereafter before the execution of the sentence, the accused tenders an apology, the same shall be placed for orders of the Court at once with the entire records of the case.
- (b) If the Court accepts the apology, further proceeding shall be dropped and the warrant, if any issued, shall be recalled by an order.

16. Rules not to apply to *ex-facie* Contempt :

Nothing in these rules shall apply to *ex-facie* Contempt governed by Section 345 of the Code.

17. Repeal and savings :

On the coming into force of these Rules, all existing Rules governing the subject that is dealt with or covered by these Rules shall stand repealed.

Provided that this repeal shall not affect or invalidate anything done, any action or decision taken, any disposal made, any order or proceeding made before the enforcement of these Rules.

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Government Order No. 1390-JK (GAD) of 2023

Dated 17-11-2023.

In supersession of all previous orders/circulars on the subject and pursuant to the Government instructions under Rule 31 of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956, the Review Committees to review periodically the cases of suspension of officers of the Jammu and Kashmir Administrative Service (JKAS) and Jammu and Kashmir Police (Gazetted) Service (JKPS), are hereby constituted as under :ô

I. For officers of the Jammu and Kashmir Administrative Service (JKAS) :

1.	Chief Secretary	Chairman
2.	Administrative Secretary, Home Department	Member
3.	Administrative Secretary, General Administration Department	Member-Secretary
4.	Administrative Secretary, concerned department	Special Invitee
5.	Administrative Secretary, Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs	Member
II.	For officers of the Jammu and Kashmir	Police Service (JKPS) :
1.	Chief Secretary	Chairman
2.	Administrative Secretary, Home Department	Member-Secretary

- 3. Director General of Police Member
- 4. Administrative Secretary, Member General Administration Department
- 5. Administrative Secretary, Member Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs

It is further ordered that the Review Committee constituted to review suspension cases of JKAS officers shall besides any other matter which the Chief Secretary may like to discuss, review the suspension cases of :ô

- i. Gazetted officers of different Departments placed under suspension for their alleged involvement in the vigilance cases.
- ii. Non-Gazetted officials involved in a vigilance case, if they belong to more than one Department.
- iii. Non-Gazetted officials of different Departments placed under suspension after being caught red handed while demanding and accepting illegal gratification (Trap Cases).
- iv. Employees both Gazetted and Non-Gazetted who have been placed under suspension for allegedly possessing assets disproportionate to their known sources of income.

Further, all Administrative Secretaries shall furnish brief notes in respect of suspended officer(s)/official(s) of their respective Departments to General Administration Department for placing their cases before the concerned Review Committee.

Besides, the other suspension cases of officers/officials of the Departments shall be reviewed by the concerned Departments at their own level by constituting Review Committees in their respective Departments, keeping the General Administration Department informed about the outcome of such reviews.

Moreover, the Review Committees/Departments shall ensure that periodic reviews of suspension cases are held as per the Rules and Hon'ble Supreme Court/CVC guidelines, as applicable.

Subject :ô Filing of Annual Property Return by the J&K Government Employees through Online Property Returns System (PRS Portal).

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Circular No. 36-JK (GAD) of 2023

Dated 21-12-2023.

Sub-Section 2 of Section 9 of the Jammu and Kashmir Public Men and Public Servants Declaration of Assets and other Provisions Act, 1983 lays down that it shall be incumbent on the part of every public servant to submit annual returns of the assets held by him and his family members in the month of January every year and shall indicate the reasons for increase, if any, in the assets and source thereof.

2. The Jammu and Kashmir Public Servants Declaration of Assets Act and Rules made thereunder provides for imposing a penalty for nonsubmission of the property returns by the public servants. It is further provided that if any public servant without any reasonable cause which he shall be required to show, fails to submit the return annually, he shall be guilty of committing criminal misconduct under the Prevention of Corruption Act and shall be punishable under the said Act.

3. The said Act and Rules also lay down that every public servant shall submit annual property returns, as per instruction issued by the Government from time to time, in respect of all the assets possessed by him and his family members.

4. With a view to make the process of flling of property returns employee friendly, the Government of Jammu & Kashmir has launched online portal for flling of annual property returns (PRS-Portal) by each and every J&K Government Employee, as mandated under the Jammu and Kashmir Public Servants Declaration of Assets Act and Rules made thereunder and also as per the provisions of the Employees Conduct Rules, every year ending 31st December, by or before 31st January of the next calendar year.

5. The PRS-Portal is accessible on *http://prs.jk.gov.in*. The employees can file their annual property returns on the said portal from 1st of January and the facility automatically gets closed on 31st of January every year.

6. The non-submission of property returns by the employees shall invite action against them under the Prevention of Corruption Act, besides, shall result in denial of their Vigilance Clearance.

7. Accordingly, all the employees working under the Jammu and Kashmir Government are advised to file their property returns for the year 2023, on the PRS-Portal, from 1st January, 2024 upto 31st January, 2024.

8. Further, it is enjoined upon all the DDOs to ensure registration of those employees, who have not yet registered on the PRS Portal. Besides, ensuring filing of property details by their cent percent employees, within the specfled timelines. <u>The portal will automatically close on 31st January, 2024.</u>

SO6488.ô Whereas, the Anti Corruption Bureau vide communication No. ACB-FIR-10/2022-ACB-J-13292-93 dated 20-07-2022 reported that a case FIR No. 10/2022 has been registered in P/S ACB, Jammu on 17-06-2022 under Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and section 120-IPC against Smt. Jyoti Devi, Corporator, Ward No. 53

Whereas, the matter referred to General Administration Department with the request to suggest further course of action enabling to proceed under the relevant provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000 ; and

Whereas, the General Administration Department vide U.O. No. GAD-VIG0SP/124/2022-09 (7044496) dated 24-03-2023 opined as under :ô

∴Returned. On consideration of the matter in the General Administration Department, it has been observed that Jyoti Devi, Corporator has, in active connivance with her husband Sham Lal and after entering into a criminal conspiracy with him, demanded and accepted illegal gratification from the Complainant, who being a Contractor had executed works in the ward of the Corporator. This act on part of the Corporator, who being a public Servant, *prima facie* tantamounts to a grave criminal offense attracting provisions of the Prevention of Corruption Act and IPC. The accused lady Corporator, has abused her official position, which entails action against her in terms of Section 34 of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000.

On further consideration, the Competent Authority has directed that the Housing and Urban Development Department be advised to proceed against the delinquent Ms. Jyoti Devi, Corporator Ward No. 3, in terms of Section 34 of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000 and furnish the Action Taken Report (ATR) to General Administration Department for consideration of the Government.

Consequently, the decision of the Competent Authority is conveyed to the Housing and Urban Development Department for further action.@

Whereas, vide Government Order No. 56-JK(HUDD) of 2023 Dated 12-04-2023, an enquiry was ordered to be initiated by the Department under Section 34 of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000, wherein Mr. Anil Kaul, JKAS, Secretary Housing and Urban Development was appointed as Inquiry Officer in the case to conduct an enquiry into the matter of alleged misconduct of Smt. Jyoti Devi, Councilor, for abusing official position ; and

Whereas, Smt. Jyoti Devi, was afforded an opportunity to present her case/defence by the Inquiry Officer and she appeared before the Inquiry Officer on 26th of May 2023 and submitted a written statement of defense which *inter alia* referred to the provisions of Section 8 of the Municipal Corporation Act, 2000 asserting therein that no action can be taken against her ; and

Whereas, the written statement was taken on record and considered however, it was found that the said section has no applicability in view of the offence committed by the Corporator and as such her assertion is not legally tenable ; and

Whereas, the Inquiry Officer vide letter PS/Secy/HUDD/Jmu/36 dated 06-06-2023 recommended as under :ô

::The assertion of the Corporator in her supplementary statement that she was not present on the scene of arrest cannot obviate the trail of events in the instant case which eventually has led to the lying of successful trap of arrest by the Anti Corruption Bureau. The act of demanding/accepting illegal gratification has unfolded at the scene of incidence of arrest. As per records available and statement of reply, the conduct of the Corporator does not absolve her from the alleged connivance involved in the offense keeping in view that ACB has registered FIR No. 10/2022 under Section 7 of PC Act, 1988 and Section 120 IPC against Smt. Jyoti Devi, and her husband. Moreover, the Corporator has not produced any evidence to substantitate her non involvement in the said offense.

Whereas, in contemplation to proceed further under Section 34 (1) (b) of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Act, a notice for affording a final opportunity of being heard was served upon Smt. Jyoti Devi, Councilor, H. No. 219/3, Vasant Vihar, Ward No. 53 vide Letter No. HUD/60/2022-01(C.No. 234617) dated 01-08-2023 as mandated under Section 34 of the Act ; and

Whereas, Smt. Jyoti Devi, submitted her reply on 06-08-2023 wherein she denied the facts and further resisted from the applicability of provisions of section 8 and further Section 34 of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000 asserting therein that no action can be taken against her under the provisions of said sections ; and

Whereas, the applicability of Section 8 of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000 is not attracted in the instant case and the conduct of the councilor squarely falls within the ambit of Section 34(1) (b) which provides as under :ô

Whereas, on perusal of the factual details as furnished by Anti Corruption Bureau viz-a-viz circumstantial evidences collected on the arrest and the directions of the Competent Authority, the instant case is covered under the provisions of Section 34 of the Jammu and Kashmir

Whereas, the Inquiry Officer after considering the reply of the Councilor, statement of defense, has recommended that the Councilor namely Smt. Jyoti Devi has *prima facie* flagrantly abused her official position as a Councilor, and therefore is liable for an action under Section 34 (1) (b) of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 34 (1)(b) of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000, the Government hereby removes Smt. Jyoti Devi, Councilor, Ward No. 53 from her office on the ground of abuse of her official powers, with immediate effect.

SO-499.—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor hereby makes the following rules ; namely :ô

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Subordinate Judicial (Revised) Pay Rules, 2023.

 - (I) Civil Judge (Junior Division)
 - (II) Civil Judge (Senior Division)
 - (III) District Judge (Entry Level)
 - (IV) District Judge (Selection Grade); and
 - (V) District Judge (Super Time Scale)
- (c) õExisting Pay Scaleö means the existing pay scale of the members of the Judicial Services in terms of Jammu and Kashmir Subordinate Judicial Pay Rules, 2011 notified vide SRO-244/2011 dated 05-08-2011.
- (d) õBasic Payö means the pay as defined in Article 27 (a) (i) of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations, Vol. I drawn in the existing Pay Scale as on 01-01-2016.
- (e) õPay Matrixö means Matrix specified in Annexure-I, with Levels of pay arranged in vertical cells as assigned to corresponding existing Pay Scale.

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6. Revision of Pay in the Revised Pay Structure.—The existing pay scales of the Judicial Officers shall be revised as per the Pay Matrix shown in Annexure-I.

7. Fitment in the Revised Pay Structure.—The fitment/ migration from existing pay scales of the Judicial Officer, who was in service as on 01-01-2016, to new pay matrix shall be as per Annexure-II.

 a) The procedure that has to be followed in regard to migration/fitment of the serving Judicial Officers on the date 01-01-2016 is as under:ô

1. Multiply the existing pay by the factor of 2.81.

2. The figure so arrived at to be located in Annexure-I, in relation to the Level applicable to the officer (i.e. J1, J2 etc.).

3. Where there is an identical figure available in Annexure-I at the corresponding stage of the relevant level, the new revised pay shall be fixed at that stage.

4. Where there is no identical figure available, the new revised pay has to be fixed at the very next higher stage in that level in Annexure-I.

b) Promotion: For those who are promoted on or after 01-01-2016 from the previous level to the next level, or granted financial upgradation/ACP or Selection Grade or Super Time Scale, the procedure for fixing the pay in the new pay matrix on such promotion/financial upgradation, will be as follows:ô

- 1. Identify the level and the basic pay in Annexure-I on the date of promotion.
- 2. Add one increment in that level itself.
- 3. The figure so arrived at or the next closest figure in the level to which he/she is promoted will be the new pay on promotion.

c) Increment : The annual increment shall be @ 3% cumulative, meaning thereby that the increment @ 3% has to be calculated on the previous year basic pay instead of fixed amount increments recommended by FNJPC and JPC.

While there shall be no change in the existing system regarding the date of accrual of increment, the retiring Judicial Officer shall have the benefit of increment becoming due the next day following the retirement. This increment shall be for the purpose of pension only and subject to vertical ceiling of Rs. 2,24,100/-.

8. Payment in the revised structure and arrears.— The arrears shall be computed with effect from 01-01-2016 and after adjustment of interim relief @ 30% already paid vide Government Order No. 233-F of 2018 dated 25-04-2018, the balance amount shall be paid immediately.

2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 146/2018 under Sections 452, 342, 392 RPC, 7/25 Arms Act and Section 30 of Police Act, was registered in Police Station, Chadoora, and investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Section 3 PEPO and the Sections 16 and 20 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused guard personnel identified as Mohd Afzal Malla S/o Ab. Rahim Malla R/o Sogam, Chadoora, Budgam, Ab. Rashid Mir S/o Mohammad Samender Mir R/o Koul Mukam, Bandipora, Mushtaq Ahmad Gilkar S/o Ab. Aziz Gilkar R/o Dalgate, Srinagar, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat S/o Mohd Ayoub Bhat R/o Krawah Manloo, Shopian, Taj-ud-Din Ganie S/o Gh. Nabi Ganie R/o Chanderhar, Pampore and Ali Mohd Naikoo S/o Mohd Sultan Naikoo R/o Shalatang, Awantipora, were arrested in the case ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that on the date of occurrence six terrorists identified as Muzamil Nabi Dar S/o Gh. Nabi Dar R/o Rahmoo, Pulwama, Wasim Akram Wani S/o Mohd Akram Wani R/o Taken, Pulwama, Muzmual Nazir Bhat S/o Nazir Ahmad Bhat R/o Pruchoo, Pulwama, Syed Baiee S/o unknown R/o Pakistan, Saqib Shafi Dar S/o Mohd Shafi Dar R/o Arihal, Pulwama, and one unidentified Pakistani terrorist, entered in the guard room of retired SSP in village Gopalpora, Chadoora, and confined the guard personnel, besides, decamped with 02 weapons of his PSOøs; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused Police personnel viz. Mohd Afzal Malla, Ab. Rashid Mir, Mushtaq Ahmad Gilkar, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat, Taj-ud-Din Ganie and Ali Mohd Naikoo, exhibited cowardice and dereliction towards their

assigned duties due to which the terrorists succeeded in decamping with two weapons of the PSOs deployed with retired SSP Shri Sheikh Gulam Ahmad Gureezi ; and

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7. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Muzamil Nabi Dar, Wasim Akram Wani, Muzmual Nazir Bhat, syeed Baiee, Saqib Shafi Dar and an unknown Pakistani terrorist, have been killed in different encounters with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under Section as shown against their names :—

Mohd Afzal Malla, Ab. Rashid Mir, Mushtaq Ahmad Gilkar, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat, Taj-ud-Din Ganie and Ali Mohd Naikoo, for the commission of offences punishable under 30 Police Act, r/w 3 Police Enhanced Penalties Ordinance, (PEPO), arising out of FIR No. 146/2018 of Police Station, Chadoora.

The terrorists boarded in the vehicle fired indiscriminately upon the Naka Party with their illegal arms/ammunition, with the intention to kill them and managed their escape from the spot ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 98/2020 under Sections 307 IPC, 7/27 Arms Act and the Sections 16, 18, 19, 20, 23, 38 and 39 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Imamsahib, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Sections 19, 23 and 39 of ULA(P) Act were dropped and the offence under 364 IPC was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, three terrorists of LeT banned outfit identified as Hidayatullah Malik S/o Ab. Subsequently, during the investigation, the said vehicle was seized in the case ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Hidyatullah Malik, Junaid Shafi Lone and Adil Ahmad Bhat, were members of LeT banned outfit and on the date of occurrence kidnapped, the person namely Gowher Hussain Wani, alongwith his vehicle in order to kill him, besides, under a well knit criminal conspiracy fired indiscriminately upon the Naka Party at Trenz, with the intention to kill them and escaped from the spot; and

7. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Junaid Shafi Lone and Adil Ahmad Bhat, have been killed in different encounters with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them ; and 8. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under Section of the Unlwful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :—

4. Whereas, during the investigation, four persons identified as Naseer Nabi Dar, S/o Gh. Nabi Dar, Mohd Abass Dar S/o Ab. Khaliq Dar Rø/o Gundchahal, Aqib Majid Ganie S/o Ab. Majid Ganie R/o Badroo and Zahid Ali Bhat S/o Ali Mohd Bhat R/o Kokergund, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused were arrested and during the investigation arms/ammunition viz. 01 Pistol, 02 Magazines, 14 Rounds and 01 Hand Grenade were recovered at their instances respectively ; and

SO-469.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 121 of the Mental Healthcare Act, 2017 (10 of 2017), the Lieutenant Governor, UT of Jammu and Kashmir, makes the following rules namely :ô

CHAPTER I

Preliminary

1. **Short title, extent and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Mental Healthcare (Mental Health Authority) Rules, 2023.

(2) These shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires :ô

- (a) "Act" means the Mental Healthcare Act, 2017 ;
- (b) **"Board"** means the Mental Health Review Board constituted by the Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir ;
- (c) **"Department"** means the Health and Medical Education Department, Jammu and Kashmir ;
- (d) **"Form"** means a form appended to these rules ;
- (e) **"Government"** means the Government, Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir ;
- (f) "Mental Health Authority" means the Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir ;
- (g) "Non-official member" means a member of the Jammu and Kashmir Mental Health Authority nominated under clauses (g) to (n) of sub-section (1) of section 46 of the Act;
- (h) "Rules" means rules of the J&K Mental Health Care (Mental Health Authority) rules;
- (i) "Section" means section of the Act ; and
- (j) **"Union Territory"** means the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

(2) Words and expressions used in these rules which are not defined therein, but are defined in the Act, shall have their respective meanings as assigned to them in the Act.

CHAPTER II

J&K Mental Health Authority

3. Norms for selection of non-official members of Mental Health Authority.—A person shall not be selected as a non-official member of Mental Health Authority unless, heô

- (a) is an Indian National;
- (b) is of the age not exceeding sixty-seven years ;
- (c) possesses qualification and experience as specified in clause (f) sub-section (1) of section 46 of the Act.

4. Invitation of application for the posts of non-official members of Mental Health Authority.—A vacancy for the post of non-official member of the Mental Health Authority shall be given wide publicity through open advertisement in at least two daily newspapers (one English and one local language) having wide circulation in the Union Territory and the advertisement shall also be made available on the website of the Department of Health and Medical Education, Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

5. Selection Committee for nomination of non-official members of Mental Health Authority.— The Selection Committee for nomination of non-official members of the Mental Health Authority shall consist of the following :-

- (a) Chairperson, who shall be the Chairperson of the Mental Health Authority of the Union Teritory of Jammu and Kashmir;
- (b) The Head of Department of Psychiatry, Government Medical College, Srinagar, The Head of Department of Psychiatry, Government Medical College, Jammu ; and
- (c) Mission Director, National Health Mission, J&K.

6. Procedure for nomination of non-official members of Mental Health Authority.—(1) The Selection Committee constituted under rule 5 (above) shall consider all applications received by the Department and scrutinize such applications which fulfill the requirements of section 46 of the Act and rule 3 of these rules.

(2) The Selection Committee shall, having regard to the provisions of the Act and these rules, decide about the suitability of the applicants for being selected as members of the Mental Health Authority :

Provided that in case of persons to be nominated under clauses (l), (m) and (n) of sub-section (1) of section 46 of the Act, preference shall be given to the persons with ten years of experience in dealing with persons with mental illness.

(3) The Government shall nominate the persons selected by the Selection Committee as members of the Mental Health Authority.

7. Terms of office and allowances of non-official members of Mental Health Authority.—(1) Every non-official member nominated under rule 6 shall hold his office for a term of three years at a time from the date of his nomination.

(2) Every non-official member attending the meeting of the Mental Health Authority shall be entitled to sitting allowance, travelling allowance, daily allowance and such other allowances as are applicable to non-official members of similar commissions/committees of the Union Territories of Jammu and Kashmir.

8. Furnishing of Information.— The Government may call for information concerning the activities of the Mental Health Authority or the Mental Health Review Boards periodically or as and when required by it, which shall be furnished in Form-A.

9. Chief Executive Officer.—(1) The Mission Director, National Health Mission, J&K shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Mental Health Authority.

(2) The Government shall nominate senior MBBS Doctor with Masters in Health Administration/Masters in Hospital Administration as Medical Advisor to Chief Executive Officer of the Mental Health Authority for the purpose of carrying out the various activities under the Act in the Union Territory.

(3) The Mental Health Authority with the approval of Government shall determine the number, nature and categories of the officers and employees required by Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir in the discharge of its functions.

CHAPTER III

Provisional Registration of Mental Health Establishments (MHE) by Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

10. Procedure for provisional registration of mental health establishments.—(1) Every mental health establishment in the Union Territory, except the mental health establishment under the Control of the Central Government, shall be registered with the Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

(2) Every mental health establishment referred to in sub-rule (1) shall submit an application for provisional registration to the Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir in **Form-B**, containing details as specified therein, along with a fee of rupees twenty thousand (Rs. 20,000/-) by way of a demand draft drawn in favour of the Chairperson, Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir payable at the place where the Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir payable at the place where the Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir is situated.

(3) The Mental Health Authority shall, on being satisfied that the mental health establishment fulfils all the requirements as specified in sections 65 and 66 of the Act, grant to such mental health establishment, a Provisional Registration Certificate in **Form-C**.

11. Validity and renewal of certificate of registration.—The provisional registration certificate granted under sub-rule (3) of rule 10 shall be valid for a period of twelve months from the date of such grant and an application for renewal of such certificate shall be made in **"Form-B"** within thirty days before the date of expiry of the period of validity of such certificate and in case application is not made within the specified period, the mental health establishment concerned shall be liable to pay renewal fee of rupees five thousand by way of a demand draft drawn in favour of the Chairperson, Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir payable at the place where the Mental Health Authority is situated.

12. Issue of duplicate certificate.—Where a certificate of registration granted to a mental health establishment is destroyed or lost or mutilated or damaged, the Mental Health Authority issue a duplicate

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certificate on an application made by such establishment along with a fee of rupees two thousand (2000/-) by way of a demand draft drawn in favour of the Chairperson, Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir payable at the place where the Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir is situated.

13. Maintenance of digital register.—(1) A category-wise register in "Form-D" of all registered mental health establishments shall be maintained by the Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir in digital format in accordance with the provisions of sections 71 and 55 of the Act.

(2) A category-wise register in "Form-E" of clinical psychologist, mental health nurses, and psychiatric social workers as mental health professionals shall be maintained by the Mental Health Authority in digital format in accordance with the provisions of section 55(1), (d) of the Act.

CHAPTER IV

Finance, Accounts And Audit

14. Accounts and Audit of Mental Health Authority.—(1) The Mental Health Authority shall maintain accounts of its income and expenditure relating to each year and prepare an annual statement of accounts consisting of income and expenditure account and the balance sheet.

(2) Annual statement of accounts shall be submitted for audit not later than 30th June of every year in the common accounting format prescribed from time to time by the Ministry of Finance for the central autonomous bodies or as nearer thereto as the circumstances admit.

(3) The annual statement of accounts prepared under sub-rule (1) shall be signed on behalf of the Mental Health Authority by the officer-in-charge of Accounts and the Chief Executive Officer.

15. Annual Report of the Mental Health Authority.—(1) The Mental Health Authority shall prepare its annual report in "Form-F" and forwarded it to the Government within nine months from the end of the financial year for being laid before the legislature of Union Territory.

(2) The annual report shall give a full account of the activities of the Mental Health Authority during the previous year and shall include the audited accounts of the year and the report of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.

CHAPTER V

7

Audit, Inspection and Enquiry of Mental Health Establishments

16. Audit of mental health establishments.—(1) The Mental Health Authority shall, for the purpose of conducting audit of registered mental health establishments in the Union Territory, authorize one or more of the following persons to ensure that such mental health establishments, comply with the minimum standards specified under the Act, namely :ô

- (a) a representative of the Deputy Commissioner of the district where the mental health establishment is situated;
- (b) a representative of the Human Rights Commission of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir where the mental health establishment is situated;
- (c) a psychiatrist who is in Government service ;
- (d) a psychiatrist who is in private practice ;
- (e) a mental health professional who is not a psychiatrist ;
- (f) a representative of a non-governmental organization working in the area of mental health ;
- (g) a representative of the care-givers of persons with mental illness or organizations representing caregivers ; and
- (h) Representative of the persons who have or have had mental illness.

(2) For conducting audit of registered mental health establishment, the Mental Health Authority shall charge a fee of rupees five thousand by way of a demand draft drawn in favour of the Chairpeson, Mental Health Authority of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir payable at the place where the Authority is situated.

17. Inspection and inquiry of mental health establishments.—

(1) The Mental Health Authority may, *suo moto* or on a complaint received from any person with respect to non-adherence of minimum standards specified by or under the Act or contravention of any provision thereof, order an inspection and inquiry of any mental health establishment, to be made by one or more of the following persons, namely:-

- (a) a psychiatrist in Government service ;
- (b) a psychiatrist in private practice ;
- (c) a mental health professional who is not a psychiatrist;
- (d) a representative of a non-governmental organization working in the area of mental health ;
- (e) a police officer in charge of the police station under whose jurisdiction, the mental health establishment is situated;
- (f) a representative of the Deputy Commissioner of the district where the mental health establishment is situated.

(2) The Mental Health Authority or the person authorized by it under sub-rule (1), if it has reasons to, believe that a person is operating a mental health establishment without registration or is not adhering to the minimum standards specified by or under the Act or contravening any of the provisions of the Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder, shall have the power to enter and search such mental health establishment.

(3) The mental health establishment upon search may be directed to produce the documents relating to its registration and it shall be obligatory on the part of the mental health establishment to, produce such documents in original. (4) A written report of the findings of such search conducted under sub-rule (3) shall be submitted to the Chairperson of the Mental Health Authority within two days.

(5) The Chairperson of the Mental Health Authority shall, on receipt of the written report under sub-rule (4), take such action as it deems fit, against the defaulting mental health establishment in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

CHAPTER VI

Maintenance of Online Registers

18. Online registers.—(1) The Mental Health Authority shall issue periodic regulations or notifications with regards to creating and operating online register of mental health professionals, advanced directives, mental health establishment etc. by taking into account prevailing laws, standards, guidelines, standard operating procedures, rules and regulations for such online databases or portal from time to time.

(2) All Mental health establishments and Mental health professionals shall abide by the rules for maintenance of online registers.

Majeed Ganie R/o Souch, Kulgam and Hilal Ahmad Wani S/o Mohd Akram Wani R/o Mochawa, Kulgam, along with their other terrorists attacked upon a cash van of J&K Bank at village Modergam, with their illegal arms/ammunition, with the intention to kill the persons boarded in the vehicle, resulting in the death of five Police personnel and two Bank Security Guards on the spot, besides, the terrorists snatched 04 INSAS rifles, 05 magazines and 80 rounds from the martyred Police personnel and escape from the spot; and

Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No.58/2017under Sections302, 392, 120-B RPC, 7/27 Arms Act and the Sections 10, 13, 18 of ULA (P) Act was registered in the Police Station, Kulgam, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Sections120-B RPC and 10 of ULA (P) Act were dropped and the offences under Section 7/25 Arms Act and the Sections 16, 19, 23, 38, 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ;and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, four other persons identified as Mohammad Abass Thoker S/o Gull Mohd Thoker, Rameez Ahmad Itoo S/o Mohd Amin Itoo Røs/o Mohamadpora, Kulgam, Rasik Ahmad Ganie S/o Mohd Amin Ganie R/o Souch, Kulgam and Suhail Mukhtar Malik S/o Ab. Hamid Malik R/o Tazipora, Mohamadpora, Kulgam, were found involved in the case. Subsequently, the accused were arrested and during

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that on the date of occurrence, the accused terrorists viz. Umar Majeed Ganie, Hilal Ahmad Wani, Rasik Ahmad Ganie, Zahid Bashir Mir S/o Bashir Ahmad Mir R/o Okey and Ishfaq Ahmad Thoker S/o Abdul Majeed Thoker R/o Harmain, of J&K Shopain, attacked upon the cash van Bank at VSillageModergam, and snatched arms/ammunition from the martyred Police personnel and escaped from the spot; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Mohammad Abass Thoker, Rameez Ahmad Itoo, Rasik Ahmad Ganie and Suhail Mukhtar Malik, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists particularly the terrorists viz. Umar Majeed Ganie, Hilal Ahmad Wani, Zahid Bashir Mir and Ishfaq Ahmad Thoker, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to them, besides, were voluntarily harbouring the said terrorists for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

7. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Umar Majeed Ganie, Hilal Ahmad Wani, Zahid Bashir Mir and Ishfaq Ahmad Thoker, have been killed in the different encounters with the Security Forces and the accused viz. Rasik Ahmad Ganie, after his release from the instant case also joined the terrorist ranks and subsequently, has been killed in an encounter. The proceedings under the law would abate against the killed terrorists ; and
