3. Deputy Commissioners	One tour per week	Four days in a week except <b>Wednesday</b> and on tour days, between 03:00 PM and 04:00 PM

# It is further ordered that :

- 1. Following shall be the focus areas of these tours/public hearings :ô
  - a) Review and inspection of projects and project sites.

- c) Any issue of public importance
- 2. It shall be ensured that the above schedule is followed in letter and spirit as far as possible and no official meetings and engagements shall be scheduled on the tour days and public hearing hours. In case of non-availability of these officers in their respective offices, appropriate arrangements by nominating the next senior available officer, shall be put in place for conducting public hearings.
- 3. Tour programmes and public hearing schedules shall be notified in advance and given adequate publicity.
- Administrative Secretaries shall visit the districts in a structured manner on rotational basis, so as to ensure that all districts are covered under the tour programmes.
- 5. Monthly reports, highlighting issues flagged during these tours and public hearings and possible solutions, shall be submitted by Administrative Secretaries directly to the office of Chief Secretary and by Heads of Departments through their concerned Administrative Departments.
- The Deputy Commissioners shall submit such monthly reports directly to the office of Chief Secretary and the office of concerned Divisional Commissioner.
- 7. Other activities pertaining to Block Diwas, Public Darbar, Thana Diwas etc. shall be carried out as per the already notified schedule.

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Subject :ô Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for declaring an area (Panchayat/ULB/Ward) as *Nasha Mukt* under the *Nasha Mukt Jammu and Kashmir Abhiyan*.

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Government Order No. 1641-JK (GAD) of 2023

In continuation of Government Order No. 1006-JK(GAD) of 2022 dated 05-09-2022, the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP), detailing objective criteria, actionable strategy and periodic review mechanism for declaring a Panchayat/ULB/Ward as *Nasha Mukt* under the *Nasha Mukt Jammu & Kashmir Abhiyan*, is hereby notified as per *Annexure-A* to this Government Order.

Annexure-A to Government Order No.1641-lK(GAD) of 2023 dated 20-12-2023

- A. Criteria for declaring an area (Panchayat/ULB/Ward) as Nasha Mukt :—
- 1. The cultivated area under any illicit crops (including area under illicit crops growing in wild) in the Panchayat/ULB/Ward must be zero.
- 2. The area of Panchayat/ULB/Ward must be free from any activity relating to processing/manufacturing of any product which is banned under NDPS Act.

- 3. No case of drug addiction should have been reported from the area of Panchayat/ULB/Ward in the last six months.
- 4. No drug smuggler/peddler is residing/operating in the Panchayat/ ULB/Ward at the time of certification.
- 5. No person in the Panchayat/ULB/Ward is booked/detained/ convicted under NDPS Act at the time of certification.
- 6. No person in the Panchayat/ULB/Ward is booked under the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003.
- **B.** Strategy :
- 1. Regular Gram Sabha/Bal Sabha/Youth Club/Mahila Sabha/Senior Citizen¢ Club meetings should be organized on drug menace at least once in a month.
- 2. Government Departments viz. Police, Social Welfare, Rural Development, Excise Departments, Health and Medical Education, Revenue, School Education etc. should work in coordination and highlight the hazardous implications of cultivation/consumption of illicit crops.
- 3. Local Committees/Youth Clubs/Religious Organizations should be proactively involved in combating the problem of drug addiction. Focus should be on organizing events such as *nukkad nataks*, walkathons, cycle rallies etc. in the area for mass awareness generation. Government Departments shall provide necessary support in this regard.
- 4. Mass Awareness & Sensitization Activities through regular Media Campaigns (print/electronic) should be conducted in the Panchayat/ ULB/Ward, at least once in a month, by the concerned departments. There should be implementation of a broad-based Media Strategy with special emphasis on Social Media : X (Twitter), Facebook, Instagram etc.

- 5. Regular awareness programmes should be held in educational institutions of the Panchayat/ULB/Ward on drug addiction/ de-addiction at least once in a month.
- 6. Law Enforcement Agencies should take effective measures like regular police patrolling, sting operations and efforts to disrupt drug supply chains in the Panchayat/ULB/Ward.
- 7. Fortnightly destruction drives of illicit crops grown or growing in wild should be organized by the Government agencies in each Panchayat/ULB/Ward with active involvement of local community.
- 8. The people residing in Panchayat/ULB/Ward (highly vulnerable to illicit crops) should be motivated for cultivating alternative cash crops for which Agriculture Production Department should come forth and explore all possibilities in this regard.
- There should be complete ban on sale of over the counter drugs, psychotropic substances and cigarettes within 100 meters of any educational institution falling in the jurisdiction of Panchayat/ULB/ Ward.
- 10. The youngsters of the Panchayat/ULB/Ward should be involved in sports activities, as far as possible, so as to keep them away from drug addiction and other social evils.
- 11. Wall paintings and hoardings popularizing National De-addiction Helpline (14446) should be displayed at five (05) prominent places in the Panchayat/ULB/Ward.
- 12. Hot spots and vulnerable population in the Panchayat/ULB/Ward should be identified and due attention should be given to them.
- 13. Persons booked or detained under NDPS Act in the Panchayat/ ULB/Ward during last 03 months, should be reported and monitored regularly.
- Drug abusers of the Panchayat/ULB/Ward who have been sent to Rehabilitation Centers/Drug De-Addiction Centers for treatment/ counseling during the last 03 months should be monitored and measures should be taken for their well-being.

- 15. There should be easy access to treatment facilities with safe and secure drop-in space for drug dependent youth who shall be screened, assessed and counseled, with special emphasis on follow-up care.
- 16. Tehsil Level, Sub-Division Level and District Level Committees, constituted vide Government Order No. 1006-JK(GAD) of 2022 dated 05-09-2022, shall meet at least once a month and review the progress achieved in respect of implementation of *Nasha Mukt Abhiyan*.

# C. Periodic Review Mechanism :

1. Overall monitoring of certification shall be done by the District Level Committee, upon receipt of recommendations from Tehsil Level Committees & Sub-Divisional Level Committees, with the stipulation that *Nasha Mukt* certificate shall be issued by the District Magistrate of the concerned district.

2. *Nasha Mukt* status of Panchayats/Wards shall be reviewed on half yearly basis and certifications issued shall either continue or shall be withdrawn in light of performance of the Panchayat/Ward on the given parameters.

### Dated 15-01-2024.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the rationalization of expenditure for fiscal prudence and economy during the current financial year with immediate effect as per the following guidelines/measures for austerity and rationalization of expenditure :ô

# 1. Balanced Pace of Expenditure :

- i. During the last quarter of the current financial year the revenue expenditure should be limited to 30% of revised budget allocation and in the month of March, the expenditure should be limited to 15% of such allocation.
- ii. In the last month of the current financial year, payments may be made only for the works duly executed, and the goods and services already procured. Hence, no amount should be released in advance in the last month with the exception of the loans or advances to government servants as per service conditions or on compassionate grounds or to disaster victims as a measure of relief and rehabilitation.
- iii. Rush of expenditure on procurement of goods and services should be avoided during the last month of the current financial year to ensure that codal procedures are complied with and there is no infructuous expenditure. Director Finance(s)/Financial Advisor (s) are advised to specially monitor this aspect in their respective departments.
- iv. 10% economy cut is imposed on the budget allocation for OE, LTC, telephone, POL, travel, advertisements, publicity, hospitality and sumptuary activities.

# 2. Seminars and Conferences :

- i. Utmost economy shall be observed in organizing conferences, seminars/workshops.
- Holding of exhibitions/fairs/seminars/conferences outside J&K is strongly discouraged.

- iii. There shall be complete ban on holding of meetings and conferences at private hotels. Government buildings/halls should be utilized for holding of meetings and conferences instead.
- iv. 10% economy cut is imposed on the budget allocation for conduct of camps, conferences and seminars.

# 3. Purchase of vehicles :

i. Purchase of new vehicles is strictly discouraged. Exceptional cases for meeting critical operational requirement shall be permitted with 20% reduction against condemnation as a replacement measure and with the concurrence of Finance Department. The already condemned vehicles must be auctioned and auction proceeds deposited as Miscellaneous Revenue before submitting such proposal.

# 4. Domestic and International Travel :

- Travel expenditure should be regulated so as to ensure that each department remains within the revised allocated budget. Re-appropriation/augmentation proposals on this account will not be entertained.
- ii. International travel shall not be allowed without specific permission is granted by the Finance Department.
- iii. Within the country, the officers should travel only by economy class regardless of entitlement.
- iv. Facility of Video Conferencing may be used effectively and travel for the purpose of attending meetings should be avoided to the extent possible.
- v. 10% economy cut is imposed on the travel expenses budget allocation for 2023-24.

# 5. Furniture and Fixtures :

i. No furniture shall be procured except in case of newly established offices with the concurrence of the Finance

# 6. Holding of Official Functions :

i. There shall be complete ban on holding of official dinners and lunches, except those hosted by the Chief Secretary and Honøble Lieutenant Governor or with specific approval of the Honøble Lieutenant Governor.

# 7. Creation and Filling of Posts :

- i. No new post shall be created.
- ii. Filling of regular posts may be undertaken only through JKSSB/ JKPSC routes and with concurrence of the Finance Department.
- iii. Posts that have remained vacant for more than two year should be identified for surrender. Such posts should be not revived except under rare and unavoidable circumstances and after seeking clearance from the Finance Department.

# 8. Local Fund Utilization :

- i. The local fund available with various Departments, Universities, Authorities and Agencies will be subject to these austerity measures.
- ii. The compliances of GFRs, CVC guidelines and instructions issued by Government for e-tendering, GEM based procurement, technical sanction and administrative approval must be followed.
- 9. No fresh financial commitments will be made on items and proposals which are not provided for in the approved budget of 2023-24.
- 10. Any exceptional case should be dealt only with the approval of the Finance Department.
- **11. Compliance :** Administrative Secretaries shall be responsible for ensuring compliance of the measures

Zubair Ahmad Sofi and Mushtaq Ahmad Itoo, motivated and facilitated the joining of accused viz. Rasiq Ahmad Ganie, with the terrorist ranks for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Rasiq Ahmad Ganie and Zubair Ahmad Sofi, have been killed in the different encounters with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under section of the Unlawful activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against hisname :ô

Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Section 436 IPC was dropped and the offences under Sections 201 IPC, Section 5 of ESA, 2/3 E&IMCO and the offence under Sections 13, 19, 23, 38, 39 and 40 of ULA(P) Act, were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, four persons identified as Nisar Ahmed S/o Mohd Sharief, Mushtaq Hussain S/o Mir Mohd, Mohd Fareed S/o Mohd Sharief and Bilal Ahmed S/o Nisar Ahmed R¢/o Gursai, Mendhar, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused were arrested in the case and during the investigation, arms/ammunition and explosive material viz. 04 Hand Grenades, 03 AK Magazines, 90 AK rounds and an amount of Rs. 28000/- were recovered at their instances respectively ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Nisar Ahmed, Mushtaq Hussain, Mohd Fareed and Bilal Ahmed, were found in contact with a Pakistan based terrorist Abu Qatal Sindhi S/o Unknown R/o Sind Pakistan, through the virtual mode, who provided arms/ammunition, explosive material and some cash to them through the drone in order to promote terrorist activities in the area. The accused viz. Nisar Ahmed, Mushtaq Hussain, Mohd Fareed and Bilal Ahmed, on the directions of Pakistan based terrorist viz. Abu Qatal Sindhi, constructed a hideout for hiding of terrorists near the house of accused viz. Mushtaq Hussain ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Nisar Ahmed, Mushtaq Hussain, Mohd Fareed and Bilal Ahmed, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists particularly the terrorist viz. Abu Qatal Sindhi, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to them, besides, the accused viz. Nisar Ahmed, Mushtaq Hussain and Bilal Ahmed, voluntarily harboured the terrorists who on the date of

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occurrence attacked upon the Army patrolling party which resulted killing of five Army personnel on the spot. The accused viz. Nisar Ahmed and Mohd Fareed, were also raising funds for the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area and to wage war against the Government of India ; and

7. Whereas, during the investigation, four more persons identified as Haq Nawaz A/P Saudia Arbia, Ali, Anas and one unknown terrorist were found involved in the case and the investigation, in respect of the said accused shall continue to ascertain their actual identity and to bring out their role/involvement in the case and the supplementary charge-sheet against them would be filed in the Court of competent jurisdiction ; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, and Indian Penal Code, as shown against their names :ô

Whereas, the Tribal Affairs Department, is administering the Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme for Scheduled Tribes which is being implemented through the Directorate of Tribal Affairs, J&K ; and

Whereas, under the Scheme, Pre-Matric Scholarship is provided to Scheduled Tribe Students by the Implementing Agency as per the extant Scheme guidelines ; and

Whereas, the aforesaid Scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016), the Government of Union Territory of J&K hereby notifies the following, namely :ô

- (1) A child desirous of availing the benefit under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.
- (2) Any child desirous of availing the benefit under the Scheme, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment subject to the consent of his parents or guardians, before registering for the Scheme provided that he is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per section 3 of the said Act and such children shall visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) (website www.uidai.gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.
- (3) As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and update) Regulations, 2016, the Department through its Implementing Agency, is required to offer Aadhaar Enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar enrolment centre located in the respective Block or Taluka or Tehsil, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves :

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the child, the benefit under the scheme shall be given

- (a) If the child has been enrolled after attaining the age of five years (with biometrics collection), his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification Slip, or of biometric update identification slip; and
- (b) Anyone of the following documents, namely :ô

(i) Birth Certificate ; or Record of Birth issued by the appropriate authority ; or

(ii) School Identity Card, duly signed by the Principal of the School, containing parents, names ; and

- (c) Anyone of the following documents as proof of relationship of the beneficiary with the parent or legal guardian as per the extant Scheme guidelines, namely :ô
  - (i) Birth Certificate ; or Record of birth issued by the appropriate authority ; or
  - (ii) Ration Card ; or
  - (iii) Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) Card ; or

Employees, State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) Card ; or Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) Card ; or

- (iv) Pension Card ; or
- (v) Army Canteen Card ; or
- (vi) Any Government Family Entitlement Card ; or
- (vii) Any other document as specified by the Department :

Provided further that the above documents shall be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

(4) In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required

Whereas, under the Scheme, Post-Matric Scholarship is provided to Scheduled Tribes by the Implementing Agency as per the extant Scheme guidelines ; and

Whereas, the aforesaid Scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of India/ Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016), (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir hereby notifies the following, namely :ô

- (1) An individual eligible for receiving the benefits under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.
- (2) Any individual desirous of availing benefits under the Scheme, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment before registering for the Scheme provided that he is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per section 3 of the said Act and such individuals shall visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) (website www.uidai.gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.
- (3) As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and update) Regulations, 2016, the Department through its Implementing Agency, is required to offer Aadhaar Enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar enrolment centre located in the respective Block or Taluka or Tehsil, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves :

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefit under the scheme shall be given to

- (a) If he has enrolled, his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification Slip; and
- (b) Any one of the following documents, namely :ô
  - (i) Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo ; or
  - (ii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card ; or
  - (iii) Passport ; or
  - (iv) Ration Card ; or
  - (v) Voter Identity Card ; or
  - (vi) MGNREGA Card ; or
  - (vii) Kisan Photo Passbook ; or
  - (viii) Driving License issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or
  - (ix) Certificate of identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head ; or
  - (x) any other document as specified by the Department :

Provided further that the above documents shall be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

- (4) In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.
- (5) In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other

- (a) In case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with fingerprint authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner ;
