Subject :ô Acquisition of land for construction of road from Karipora to Railway Approach Road in District Budgam.

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Notification No. 02-Rev (LAK) of 2023

Dated 21-03-2023

Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by Chief Engineer, PW (R&B) Department, Kashmir vide letter dated 07-12-2017, notification under Section 4 (1) of Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 was issued by Collector,

Whereas, Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Budgam vide letter dated 08-10-2020 has reported that an area of land measuring 12 Kanals 16 Sq. Ft. came to be notified for public purpose viz. construction of road from Karipora to Railway Approach Road by issuance of above referred notification. Accordingly, the instant case was placed before the District PNC on 29-05-2019 and after threadbare discussions a rate of Rs. 38.00 lac per kanal was proposed and accepted by 23 out of 43 land owners, who also put forward their signatures on PNC sheet. The committee decided to afford number of opportunities to the aggrieved left out land owners for negotiation of the rates, but the left out land owners did not agreed the rates adopted by the committee. The committee finally decided that the case for left out land owners should be processed under compulsory mode of acquisition; and

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Budgam has intimated that the Indenting Department has deposited funds to the tune of Rs. 10809000/-with the Collectorate, which stands disbursed among the land owners/interested persons whose land has been acquired under PNC mode of acquisition for the construction of aforementioned road; and

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Budgam vide No. DCB/LAS/021/476 dated 10-08-2021 recommended the case to Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir who vide No. Divcom/LAS-Acq/3858/921 dated 23-01-2023 for issuance of declaration under sections 6, 7 & 17 of J&K Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 for land measuring 08 Kanals 3 Marlas and 50 Sq. Ft. at Village Karipora, Tehsil and District Budgam; and

Whereas, the report furnished by District Collector (DC), Budgam vide letter referred to above duly endorsed to Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir has been examined and found that no one objected with regard to Section 4 (1), when it was notified rather they had objected with regard to compensation as such that objection cannot be construed as objection under notification 4 (1), even Deputy Commissioner has granted opportunity of being heard and accordingly, it does not merit any consideration, hence

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the aforesaid land is required for public purpose i. e. construction of road from Karipora to Railways Approach Road situated at Village Karipora, Tehsil and District Budgam.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 08 Kanals 3 Marlas and 50 Sq. Ft. at Village Karipora, Tehsil and District Budgam is required for public purposes i. e. construction of road from Karipora to Railways Approach Road. Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Budgam is directed under Section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

Further, in pursuance of Section 17 of the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is also ordered that on expiry of fifteen days from the publication of the notification under Section 9 (2) of the said Act, the Collector will take possession of the aforementioned land at Village Karipora, Tehsil and District Budgam is required for public purposes, subject to fulfillment of the conditions prescribed under Section 9 (2) and Section17-A of the Land Acquisition Act and Rule 63 of the Land Acquisition Rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be held specifically responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in force, while making the award. The Collector/Indenting Department shall also ensure that no compensation shall be made for the portion of land which has already been acquired for the road in question and compensation disbursed.

Subject :ô Acquisition of land measuring 01 Kanal 19 Marlas situated in Village Dalwah, Tehsil Gool, District Ramban for construction of road from Sohil Morh to Surranda.

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Notification No. 03-Rev(LAJ) of 2023

Dated 21-03-2023.

Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by the Executive Engineer, PWD (R&B) Division, Ramban notification under Section 4 (1) of Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Gool vide No. 114-121/SDM/G/PWD dated 08-05-2019 for land measuring 01 Kanal 19 Marlas situated at Village Dalwah, Tehsil Gool, District Ramban, calling upon the objections from the land owners/interested persons; and

Whereas, pursuant to above notification, no objection was received from anyone within the prescribed time period and accordingly. Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Gool vide No. SDM/G/PWD/894-98 dated 28-12-2022, recommended the case to District Collector (DC), Ramban for aforementioned land for construction of road from Sohil Morh to Surranda situated in Village Dalwah, Tehsil Gool, District Ramban for issuance of declaration under Sections 6, 7 and 17 of J&K Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990; and

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner concerned vide No. DC/LA/Rbn/1743-44 dated 09-01-2023 endorsed to Divisional Commissioner, Jammu who, vide No. 502/4629/Acq/Dalwah/Rbn/23/2023 dated 11-02-2023 endorsed the same to Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K, who vide No. FCR-LAND/35/2023-06 dated 15-02-2023 forwarded to this department for the said purpose; and

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Gool vide letter referred to above, duly endorsed by District Collector (DC), Ramban, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the aforesaid land is required for public purpose i.e. construction of road from Sohil Morh to Surranda situated in Village Dalwah, Tehsil Gool, District Ramban.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 6 of the J&K Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 01 Kanal 19 Marlas under Khasra No. 509 situated in Village Dalwah, Tehsil Gool, District Ramban, is required for public purposes i.e. construction of road from Sohil Morh to Surranda. Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Gool is directed under Section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

Further, in pursuance of Section 17 of the J&K Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is also ordered that on expiry of fifteen days from the publication of the notification under Section 9 (2) of the said Act, the Collector will take possession of the aforementioned land at Village Dalwah Tehsil Gool, District Ramban is required for public purposes, subject to fulfillment of the conditions prescribed under Section 9 (2) and Section 17-A of the Land Acquisition Act and Rule 63 of the Land Acquisition Rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be held specifically responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in force, while making the award. The Collector/Indenting Department shall also ensure that no compensation shall be made for the portion of land which has already been acquired for the road in question.

Subject :ô Acquisition of land at Karewa (Village Budgam), Tehsil and District Budgam for establishment of Battalion Camping Site of 43 Bn. CRPF.

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Notification No. 04-Rev(LAK) of 2023

Dated 24-03-2023.

Whereas, CRPF had originally placed an indent for land measuring 211 Kanals 08 Marlas and 33 Sft. situated at Village Karewa, Tehsil and District Budgam for which Collector, Land Acquisition issued notification under Section 4(1) of Land Acquisition Act, Svt. 1990 vide No. DCB/LAS/019/1039-49 dated 12-10-2019 and subsequently a PNC meeting was conducted on 05-02-2020 wherein a rate of Rs. 65 lac per kanal was negotiated with the land owners and the proposal was submitted to Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir vide No. DCB/LAS/020/280-87 dated 23-04-2020, who after addressing certain clarifications furnished the proposal for approval of rates to the Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K vide No. DivCom/LAS-ACQ/3004/7724 dated 25-11-2020; and

Whereas, Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K returned the case with the observation to re-examine the proposal keeping in view the huge quantum of land acquired and the rates proposed being much higher than the stamp duty and the same was responded by the Deputy Commissioner concerned vide No. DCB/LAS/021/1028 dated 18-01-2021, intimating that although the rates negotiated are on higher side but the land owners do not agree to re-negotiate the rates; and

Whereas, Financial Commissioner, Revenue vide No. FC-LS/LA-5247/2020 dated 05-07-2021 again returned the case to the Deputy Commissioner, Budgam to identify a suitable alternate Shamilat/State land for the purpose as the rates are not justified. The Deputy Commissioner, Budgam vide letter No. DCB/LAS/862-66 dated 08-10-2021, intimated that two alternate locations measuring 100 Kanals and 79 Kanals in Tehsil Khansahib were identified for 43 Bn. CRPF and CRPF was requested to provide the feasibility of the locations identified; and

Whereas, Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K forwarded the case to this department vide No. FCR-LAND/20/2021-06-FCR (21730) dated 14-10-2021 for further appropriate action; and

Whereas, the case was examined in the department, wherein it was observed that PNC meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Budgam and CRPF was represent by only a DIG rank officer took decision about the rates for land measuring 211 Kanals 08 Marlas 33 Sft. leading to financial implication to the tune of Rs. 138 crores, on the basis of Rs. 65 lac per kanal which was much higher than the stamp duty rates i.e. 29 lacs for Orchard and 55.40 lacs for small plots and the land for semi ring road was given rate of Rs. 35 lacs; and

Whereas, the Intending Department is CRPF, a Central Government Agency and it cannot take a decision which does not measure up the stringent requirement of financial procedure and Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K advised Deputy Commissioner, Budgam to find out suitable alternate state/shamilat land for locating the Bn. Hqrs. where the financial implications will be much less. The Deputy Commissioner, Budgam offered two pieces of land 100 Kanals and 79 Kanals at drastically less financial implication, however CRPF had not responded, as the Government has already transferred land measuring 524 Kanals at a number of places in the Valley, at transfer value of Rs. 40 crore (approx.) on no profit no loss basis in accordance with GFR 2017; and

Whereas, keeping in view the huge financial implication vis-a-vis its impact for future acquisitions in the area, the rates adopted in the PNC were not agreed and Director General, CRPF was conveyed accordingly vide DO No. Rev-LAK/37/2021 dated 30-10-2021 with the request to respond in respect of sites suggested by Deputy Commissioner, Budgam or select alternate places in consultation with Deputy Commissioner; and

Whereas, CRPF vide No. LI(Kalshipora)-l/2021-22-DA-Works dated 10-03-2022 communicated to Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir that both the locations were found unsuitable/not feasible for Battalion Camping Site. The Deputy Commissioner, Budgam vide No. DCB/LAS/2022/1812 dated 07-06-2022 forwarded a representation submitted by some land owners wherein the land owners had expressed the willingness to negotiate @ Rs. 53.5 lac instead of 65.00 lac per Kanal and the Deputy Commissioner also submitted Asamie-wise list of land owners involved in the acquisition vide No. DCB/LAS/022/1082 dated 20-01-2022; and

Whereas, CRPF vide No. dated 26-02-2022 has also sought the list of land owners along with quantum who have agreed to sell their land at the rate of Rs. 53.5 lac. per kanal which was also provided to CRPF authorities

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner concerned vide No. DCB/LAS/023/423-25 dated 04-03-2023 has reported that in view of the observations raised by Revenue Department vide D. O. No. Rev-LAK/37/2021 dated 30-11-2021, a fresh PNC was conducted with the land owners on 28-02-2023, in which CO 43 Battalion CRPF also participated and a rate of Rs. 46.00 lac per Kanal was negotiated with the land owners who attended and consented to the same. The Deputy Commissioner, Budgam vide letter dated 04-03-2023 recommended the case to Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir with the proposal to conclude the acquisition of land for which the consent @ Rs. 46 lacs has been received, adopted compulsory mode of acquisition for land not consented but required in view of contiguity/feasibility of the land and to de-notify the remaining land. The Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir vide No. DivCom/LAS-ACQ/3004/2023 dated 18-03-2023 endorsed the proposal to Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K for consideration; and

Whereas, Financial Commissioner, Revenue after examining the matter forwarded the proposal to this department vide No. FC-LS/5247/2020(CC-21730) dated 18-03-2023, with the following recommendations :ô

- 1. Approve the now proposed PNC rate of 46 lakhs per kanals for 78K 07M 166 Sft. land, for which landowners have given the consent;
- 2. Issue notification under section 6, 7 and 17 for compulsory acquisition of the land measuring 31 K 19 M since it is essential for contiguity;
- 3. Approve the now proposed PNC rate of 46 lakhs per kanals for 16K 7M land, for which land owners have given the consent and the land was included in the original indent but not in the subsequent indent of CRPF, with the rider that it would be given to CRPF in case the CRPF requests for the same:
- 4. De-notify land measuring 84K 15M 4 Sft. situated on the other side of ring road or at the fringes, which neither forms part of the subsequent indent of the CRPF nor has been consented to by the land owners.

Whereas, the report furnished by District Collector (DC), Budgam vide letter referred above, duly endorsed by Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir and Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K has been examined and it has been found that the CRPF is given important security assignments due to its unique capability to quickly adapt to various situational requirements, and also, to work in harmony with the State Police. Besides Law and Order and Counter Insurgency (CI) duties, the CRPF is guarding vital Government/ public installations. CRPF has a substantial presence in J&K but a large number of units are in temporary accommodations, therefore, to establish Battalion Camping Site (BCS) is urgently required which is an important public purpose; and

Whereas, no objections has been filed by anyone to the basic notification under Section 4(1) of Land Acquisition Act, rather the interested persons have agreed to private negotiations and later some of the interested person have declined to negotiate and that patch of land has been requested for de-notification. The patch of land measuring 31 Kanals 19 Marlas which is contiguous to the proposed land and is therefore required for acquisition keeping in view the security and operational requirements. The Deputy Commissioner has provided due opportunity of being heard to the interested persons while holding the PNC meeting and considering the requirement of land for BCS, the objection, if any, doesnot merit any consideration; and

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the aforesaid land is required for public purpose i.e. for establishment of Batallion Camping Site (BCS) of 43 Bn. CRPF in Village Karewa, Tehsil and District Budgam.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 6 of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 31 Kanals 19 Marlas 135 Sft. situated in Village Karewa, Tehsil and District Budgam as per *Annexure-A*, is required urgently for public purposes i.e. for establishment of Batallion Camping Site (BCS) of 43 Bn. CRPF. Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Budgam is directed under Section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

Laws, Regulations and Rules passed thereunder.

#### GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR CIVIL SECRETARIATÔ PLANNING DEVELOPMENT AND MONITORING DEPARTMENT, JAMMU.

#### Notification

Jammu, the 22nd February, 2023.

SO-94.—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor hereby makes the following rules; namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Statistical Training Rules, 2023.

- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. **Definitions.**—In these rules unless the context otherwise requires,—
  - (a) "Administrative Department" means the Department in the Civil Secretariat holding administrative charge of the School:
  - (b) "Class" means the Statistical Training Class;
  - (c) "Controller of Examination" means Controller of Examination of Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission;
  - (d) "Government" means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
  - (e) "School" means the School of Applied Economics and Statistics (SAES), Jammu/Kashmir;
  - (f) "Trainee" means a person who has been admitted to any of the Statistical Classes in the School of Applied Economics and Statistics, Jammu/Kashmir for training directly after his/her appointment as Junior Statistical Assistant/Statistical Assistant:
- 3. **Training.**—The School shall conduct the following types of training courses:—
  - (a) Junior Statistical Assistant Course;
  - (b) Statistical Assistants Course;
  - (c) Capacity Building Courses for Junior Statistical Assistants, Statistical Assistants, Statistical Officers and Assistant Directors as per the requirement for which the syllabus shall be designed/framed by the Principal of the Training School, Jammu/Kashmir in consultation with Directorate of Economics and Statistics.

- 4. **Eligibility.**—The following categories of personnel shall be eligible to the regular training courses referred to in Rule 3 (a) and (b):—
  - (a) Junior Statistical Assistants Course.— Junior Statistical Assistants recruited direct or by promotion for Junior Statistical Assistants Training Course.
  - (b) **Statistical Assistants Course.**—Statistical Assistants recruited direct or by promotion for Statistical Assistant Training Course:

Provided that, Refresher courses shall be conducted for Junior Statistical Assistants, Statistical Assistants, Statistical Officers and Assistant Directors from time to time for capacity building of the in-service officers/officials in the field of Applied Economics and Statistics.

- 5. Selection of Trainees and Governing Conditions.—
  (1) Selection of Trainees for Junior Statistical Assistant and Statistical Assistants Course shall be made by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, J&K as per the following procedure:—
  - (a) The minimum qualification for selection of trainees for these courses shall all be the same as laid down in the Non-Gazetted Statistical Cadre Rules, 1975 and amended vide SRO-107 dated 08-03-1983, SRO-252 dated 27-06-1989 and SRO-03 dated 04-01-2005; and
  - (b) Selection of in-service candidates for the various courses shall be strictly in accordance with seniority list maintained by the Department.
- 6. **Training period.** (1) The training period for the courses mentioned in rule 3 shall be as under:—

Junior Statistical Assistants Course a. Theoretical Training.

04 Months & 15 days

b. Practical Training.

- 01 Month
- c. Preparation and submission of Field 15 days report and viva voce Examination.

Statistical Assistants Course a. Theoretical Training.

05 Months

[No. 46-j

b. Practical Training.

20 days

c. Preparation and submission of report 10 days on the topic related to Economics and Statistics and viva voce.

(2) Capacity Building Course will be for a period of 15 days each in the case of Junior Statistical Assistants, Statistical Assistants, Statistical Officers and Assistant Directors:

Provided that the period of Training for a particular course may be extended by the Administrative Department on the recommendations of the Principal of the SAES/Directorate of Economics and Statistics.

- (3) After the theoretical training, Junior Statistical Assistants (Trainees) will be deputed by the Principal of the School for a specified term to the various Departments and Institutions of the Government such as Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Forest Department, Directorate of Economics and Statistics, N.S.S. Organization and any other Commercial concerns of the Government and such other Government Offices or Institutions as may be considered suitable for imparting training to the trainees.
- (4) The trainees will maintain daily diaries of work which will be submitted by them through the Head of the Offices to the Principal of the School.
- (5) The Principal will depute Junior Statistical Assistants and Statistical Assistants to the Office of Regional Director, Evaluation and Statistics, Jammu/Kashmir where each trainee/group of trainees will be assigned specific topics for project/field work. After completion of the field work, the trainees will be required to submit reports to the Regional Director, Evaluation and Statistics along with the daily diaries maintained by the trainees duly verified by the Supervising Officers for furnishing to the Principal. The project reports submitted by the trainees will be duly evaluated by the concerned Regional Director.

- (6) The maximum intake capacity for each class of training shall be as under:—
  - (a) 10% of the total sanctioned strength of each cadre. Any further enhancement in the intake capacity shall be made by the Administrative Department in consultation with Directorate of Economics and Statistics.
  - (b) The applicants recruited/promoted in the Economics and Statistics Organization shall be called for departmental trainings for each category as per rule strictly in accordance with the seniority in their respective cadres.
  - (c) A candidate falling in the consideration zone shall be called for maximum of 02 number of times for training in each category. In case, the applicant fails to avail the opportunity of departmental training, it will be presumed that he/she has foregone the training and shall not be deputed again for training in next batches. However, one (01) mercy chance will be granted to the candidate by the Director General, Economics and Statistics for admission in the Training School only on medical grounds or due to circumstances beyond his/her control with relevant proof.
- 7. **Examination.**—(1) After completion of theoretical and practical training, the trainees shall be required to pass the departmental examination for each course to be conducted by the Controller of Examination, Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission. The Examination for the courses mentioned in rule 3 shall be termed as under:—
  - (a) Junior Statistical Assistants Course (JSAC); and
  - (b) Statistical Assistants Course (SAC).
- (2) The courses, syllabi and the standard prescribed for Junior Statistical Assistants Course and Statistical Assistants Course examination shall be as prescribed in Annexure õAö and õBö.
- (3) The Administrative Department may however revise syllabi when necessary. The syllabus for the capacity building courses shall be

framed/designed by the Principal Statistical Training School, Jammu/ Kashmir in consultation with Directorate of Economics and Statistics.

- (4) Minimum pass percentage of marks required in each paper to secure exemption from appearing in a particular paper in respect of trainee who fail in the examination on the whole will be regulated as under:—
  - (a) For Junior Statistical Assistants, the minimum marks shall be 37 per cent in each paper. Candidates, who obtain 37 percent or more marks in any paper but fail in the examination as a whole, shall be exempted from appearing in that paper. No exemption shall however, be granted in Practical Paper.
  - (b) For Statistical Assistants, the minimum marks shall be 37 percent in each paper. Candidates, who obtain 37 percent or more marks in any paper but fail in the examination as a whole, shall be exempted from appearing in that paper. No exemption shall however, be granted in practical paper.
  - (c) Marks in any paper being a fraction like ½ shall be rounded off to the nearest whole number i.e. 36½ shall be rounded off to 37.

## 8. No trainee shall be eligible to appear in the departmental examination for which he/she has been recruited unless.—

- (1) (a) He/She has attended at least 90 per cent lectures in each paper of the examination; and
  - (b) He/She is reported to have devoted him/her self to his studies and he/she has given a good account of his/her conduct throughout the course of training:

Provided that the Principal of the school may at discretion relax the restriction of 90% attendance in any individual case where he/she is satisfied that progress of a trainee has been satisfactory and the shortage of attendance was due to circumstances beyond his/her control.

(2) The Departmental Examinations shall be conducted in the Public Service Commission on such date(s) as may be fixed by the Controller of

Examination. The examinations shall be supervised by the Controller/ Deputy Controller Examinations, Public Service Commission who will be assisted by Gazetted and Non-Gazetted Officers/Officials to be selected by him for this purpose.

- (3) The remuneration to examiners, supervisors and other staff engaged by the Controller of Examination in connection with holding of various Departmental Statistical Examinations shall be according to the rules/rates sanctioned by the Government and embodied in Schedule III of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations.
- (4) The trainees shall be required to execute an agreement with the Government in the Form given in **Annexure 'C'** in these rules, which shall among other things stipulate for the passing of the prescribed examination within a maximum of (03) three continuous chances, the first chance being counted from the date in respect of the examination in which the trainee could first appear after completion of training in the Institute. However, 01 mercy chance may be allowed by the Controller of Examinations of Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission on the recommendations of Principal Training School with the approval of the Director General, Economics and Statistics, J&K, failing which his/her seniority shall not remain intact and the candidates junior to him/her shall be considered for next promotion and shall by-pass his/her seniority. Further, there shall be no bar on age limit for appearing in the Departmental Examination.
- (5) The trainee has to serve in the Economics and Statistics Cadre after such successful completion of training for a period of 03 (three) years (Except those who attain superannuation before the stipulated period), failing which he/she shall be required to refund the amount of stipend received by him in full with or without penalty as the Government or an officer authorized by it may prescribe the quantum of penalty from time to time in consultation with the Administrative Department.
- **Note:**—The failure of the trainee to appear in an examination shall be regarded as has having utilized the chance.
- (6) Those who have successfully completed a lower course and happen to be selected for training in a higher course at any time shall be

required to execute a supplementary bond which will *inter alia* provide that period of three years for which they are required to serve the Government will commence from the date of successful completion of training in the higher course.

- (7) The trainee drawn from services shall at the time of joining the School and on being relieved therefrom for joining the offices to which they are posted be allowed transit days only and no preparation days. The joining time and pay on joining the School shall be debitable to the grants of the School whereas joining time pay on being relieved from the School for joining the offices to which the trainees are posted shall be debitable to the grants of the respective offices.
- (8) In case where a trainee avails of excess transit days, the excess time taken by the trainee may be regulated by the Principal of the School at the time of admission to the School by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics and after the completion of the training, as the case may be, if the Principal SAES/Director General (E&S) is satisfied that the excess time taken by the trainee was due to circumstances beyond his/her control.
- (9) The trainee drawn from any Government office or institution for admission to the School shall on joining the School be entitled to tour T. A. only. The T. A. on joining the School shall be debitable to the grant of the School whereas T. A. on being relieved from the School for proceeding to the office to which the trainee(s) is/are posted shall be debitable to the grants of the respective offices.
- (10) In case of journey undertaken during the course of training i.e. for study tours or practical training assignments, the trainee shall be allowed T. A. for tour journey as admissible under rules.
- (11) Trainees who are guilty of misconduct/deliberate disobedience of orders or who reportedly refuse to conform to the procedures prescribed for the conduct of training may be discharged from the School or reverted to their departments from which/where they have been drawn and further disciplinary action as per Classification, Control and Appeal (CCA) Rules, 1956 shall be initiated.

- (12) The trainee drawn from the departments shall be under the administrative control of the Principal SAES, Jammu/Kashmir during the training period.
- 9. Grant of leave during the training period shall be regulated as under.— (1) Officials drawn from the service may be granted leave by the Principal as admissible to them under rules:

Provided that the trainees proceeding on leave of any kind will do so at their own risk and this will not entitle the trainees to claim condonation of deficiency in attendance as envisaged in rule 8 and will be excluded from training in the next batch unless otherwise absence on leave is beyond his/her control, provided justification is given with evidence.

- (2) Certificate will be issued in favour of the persons who are declared successful in each course by the Public Service Commission under the signature and seal of the Controller Examinations.
- (3) The Certificate will indicate that the candidate has gone through the course of training and passed the departmental examination held by Public Service Commission with reference to the examination Roll No., the month and the year in which the examination was held along with the marks obtained. An attested copy of the certificate will be placed in the personal file of the trainee which will be referred to when considering his suitability for promotion to the next higher grade.
- 10. **Preparatory holidays.**—The concerned controlling officer shall allow preparatory days not exceeding five days immediately before the commencement of an examination notified by the Public Service Commission to enable the trainees to revise their course.
- 11. **Confidential Roll.**—The Principal of the SAES shall maintain Confidential Rolls of the trainees for the period they receive training in the School and forward the same to the Directorate of Economics and Statistics for forwarding to the Public Service Commission for compilation of the result.
- 12. **Stipend.**—(1) The Trainees who are drawn from any Government Department will draw stipend equivalent to their salary as admissible at Jammu/Srinagar.

- (2) The stipend shall be admissible from the date of admission of a trainee in the School to the date of his being relieved from the School on completion of the training. In the case of trainees drawn from services, the date of admission shall mean the date from which they are relieved from the Office/Department.
- (3) The passing of the examination through Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission shall be obligatory in case of Junior Statistical Assistant/Statistical Assistant for purpose of promotion to the next higher grade.
- (4) After the completion of training period, the trainees shall be posted by the Director General, Economics and Statistics, J&K.
- (5) Deputation of trainees in the Training School shall be made as per Rule 6 in this behalf by the Director General, Economics and Statistics, J&K.
- 13. Extension Lecture.—(1) The Principal SAES, Jammu/ Kashmir shall invite guest faculty for delivering extension lectures on technical subjects. The guest faculty from outside the department shall be paid honorarium equivalent to the rates on which Institute of Management, Public Administration and Rural Development (IMPARD) engages the guest faculty.
- (2) Conveyance charges shall be paid to the guest faculty equivalent to the rates paid by the IMPARD from time to time in case no official transport facility is provided.
- (3) Light refreshment to the trainees shall be provided during the training period as per the rates of IMPARD applicable from time to time.
- 14. **Repeal and savings**.— (1) The Jammu and Kashmir Statistical Training Rules, 1975 are hereby repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment order made or action taken under the provisions of the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

(3) The members of Economics and Statistics (Subordinate) Service who have been imparted training on the basis of the syllabus notified vide SRO-416 dated 09-09-1975 or Government Order No. 31-PD of 2000 dated 30-05-2000 or S.O.-312 dated 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2020, have to appear/qualify the departmental examination on the basis of the syllabus they have been imparted training.

Furthermore, trainees shall be allotted a topic either related to Economics and Statistics for which they shall be asked to prepare a small report based on the Secondary Data available. While doing so, they shall be encouraged to use books available in the library and make use of various websites related to the topic to write on the topic under the supervision of the Instructors in the STS. This assignment shall be completed by the trainees within a period of 10 days. This shall be followed by viva voce, which shall be conducted by the Principal of Statistical Training School. Field report shall be allotted 60 marks, assignment/topic on a particular subject 20 marks. Similarly class performance/attendance and viva voce shall be allotted 10 marks each.

AND WHEREAS, the trainee has agreed to serve the Government for a period of at least three years immediately after the completion of the said training course.

NOW, it is hereby AGREED as follows:—

 The trainee will be paid by the Government during the period of training stipend equivalent to their Salary as admissible at Jammu/Srinagar.

- The trainee will not be entitled to receive any other monetary aid from the Government to defray the cost of Books or other items of expenditure not specifically mentioned in Clause-I.
- 3. The trainee shall not engage in or prosecute during the aforesaid period of training any studies or work, other than the studies or work for which the stipend is paid nor will he/she do anything which might in any way be paid nor will he/she do anything which might in any way interfere with the aforesaid training or prevent or incapacitate him from completing successfully the aforesaid training course within the aforesaid period.
- The trainee will be allowed only such number of chances for passing his/her examination as are stipulated in the J&K Statistical Training Rules, 2023.
- 5.
