Dear Chief Secretary,

As you are aware, a campaign **::**Meri Maati, Mera Desh" has been launched to venerate the **::**Veersø who gave up their today for our tomorrow. It envisages paying tribute to the **::**Veersø who have made the supreme sacrifice for the country by collecting soil from panchayats across the country and bringing the same to Delhi (Kartavya Path) to create Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) memorials and an Amrit Vatika as a lasting tribute and legacy of this commemorative activity. A copy of the document about this campaign is attached for reference.

2. In the campaign *∺*Meri Maati Mera Deshøø, there are two key parts ; as underô

- a. Panchayat level programs ;
- b. Mitti Yatras from Panchayat to Blocks to Delhi-leading to a final event at Kartavya Path in Delhi.

3. The Panchayat level programmes comprise of dedication of :::Sila-Phalakam@, ::Panch Pran Pledge & Selfie@, :::Vasudha Vandan@, :::Veeron ka Vandan@and ::Flag Hoisting & Rashtragaan@

4. The Vasudha Vandan event is an event of planting 75 indigenous saplings in every Panchayat. The saplings are to be provided by State Forest/ Horticulture Departments. This will lead to creation of \therefore Amrit Vatikaøø This Vasudha Vandan event should be organized in and around Amrit Sarovar located in that Gram Panchayat. If Amrit Sarovar is not available in such case plantation may be done at the site of any water body. Otherwise, in any location other than Amrit Sarovar or water bodies such as Panchayat Office/School etc.

5. The Vasudha Vandan programme is an event of plantation activity and this may be taken up under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS. At every Vasudha Vandan site, there should be Sila-Phalakam to inform the citizen about the supreme sacrifice made by such ::Veersøfor the greater cause of the nation. A design of Sila-Phalakam is attached.

The Gram Panchayats should obtain the required approval of Gram Sabha for Plantation activity and Sila-Phalakam under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS.

6. It is suggested that Villagers may be informed about the event . Meri Maati, Mera Deshø, through and awareness generation exercise in the Gram Sabha meetings. Subsequently, the Gram Panchayats may be asked to work out the plan of action for Vasudha Vandan and having Sila-Phalakam. The timeline of this activity is 9 to 15th August, 2023.

7. It is requested that suitable instructions may be issued to the PRIs in your State/UT for preparing and implementing an action plan on the proposal.

Subject :ô Guideline to Sanctioning Authority/Drawing and Disbursing Officers for sanctioning of GP Fund advance/withdrawal.

Circular

It has been observed that Drawing and Disbursing Officers are not adhering to GP Fund (Central Service) Rules, 1960 and O.M. No. 3/2/2017- P&PW(F)(ii) dated 07-03-2017. Drawing and Disbursing Officers need to ensure that following guidelines are adhered to in letter and spirit :ô

- A subscriber is not permitted to take an advance more than once in six months under Rules 12 of GP Fund (Central Service) Rules, 1960.
- 2. GPF withdrawal cannot be applied for more than one house (M.F. O.M. No. F. 4(1)-EV(b)/62 dated 17-04-1962).
- 3. No temporary advance or withdrawal to be sanctioned during last three months of service. (Ministry of P&PW O.M. No. 13(3)-Pen/85, dated 31-01-1986. In exceptional circumstances which should be rare, part final withdrawal may be sanctioned with the approval of the Head of the Department.
- GPF withdrawal/advance should be in accordance to amount permitted under GP Fund (Central Service) Rules, 1960 and G. I. Department of P&PW, O.M. No. 3/2/2017-P&PW(F)(ii) dated 07-03-2017.
- 5. The competent authority while sanctioning withdrawal or refundable advance shall take into account any withdrawal or refundable advance already sanctioned by it in favour of the employee as per Rule 15(2) of GP Fund (Central Service) Rules, 1960.

- 6. Drawing and Disbursing Officers shall ensure that individual bill is generated for individual employee for drawal of GP Fund, rather than clubbed bill for more than one employee, a practice which is to be discouraged.
- There shall be only one withdrawal for the one purpose. An advance and withdrawal not to be applied/sanctioned for the same purpose together (M.F. O.M. No. F. 23(2)-E. V(b)-66 dated 07-01-1966.
- 8. Utilization Certificate that the GP Fund advance/withdrawal is utilized for the same purpose as applied for is compulsory for further GP Fund advance/withdrawal. If the sanctioning authority is not satisfied regarding proper utilization of above, the amount can be recovered from the subscriber according to provisions of Rule 14. Wrongful use of advance/withdrawal shall be dealt with disciplinary action under rules and amount shall be recovered in one go.
- 9. The Drawing and Disbursing Officers must ensure that any GP Fund advance/withdrawal bill sent to Treasury is included in the Form 10 and Form 10A at the time of submission of final payment case.

Sanctioning Authority/Drawing and Disbursing Officers must examine the cases thoroughly so that they are compliant with the GP Fund (Central Service) Rules, 1960, before sanctioning advance/withdrawal in fovour of the subscriber.

- (i) Actø means the Registration Act, 1908 (XVI of 1908);
- (ii) Aadhaar Numberømeans a twelve digit unique identification number generated and issued to an individual by the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) after de-duplication of demographic and biometric information pertaining to the individual;
- (iii) -Consent based AadhaarAuthentication Serviceø means the electronic authentication carried out by the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) or agencies appointed by it, after matching the biometric information of an individual at his request or with his consent, with the information maintained by UIDAI in its own central servers, and includes a -Yes/Noø response or a response containing the demographic information and photograph of the individual;
- (iv) -UIDAIø means Unique Identification Authority of India ;
- (v) -UTø means Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir ;
- 3. Validity of Consent based Aadhaar Authentication Service.— Any person presenting any document at the proper registration offfice for registration under Section 32 of the Act or appearing before the Sub Registrar for the purpose of Section 34 or being examined as per Sub-Section (2) of Section 35 of the Act may utilize the facility of Consent based Aadhaar Authentication Service to fulfil requirements under the relevant sections of the Act in accordance with these rules.
- 4. *Procedure*.ô Where the option of using the Consent based Aadhaar Authentication Service is utilized by the person/party,

the following procedure shall be adopted by the registering officer, namely :ó

- a. The explicit consent of such person, either in electronic format or other mode, for the use of the Consent based Aadhaar Authentication Service shall be obtained ;
- b. Upon granting of consent, the twelve digits Aadhaar Number, along with the finger print scan or iris of the person shall be entered into the UIDAI system through registration software. Matching with either finger print or iris of a person shall be sufficient for the purpose of these rules.
- c. Upon authentication the system of UIDAI shall automatically, return the Consent based Aadhaar Authentication data of the person/user;
- d. The information generated through Consent based Aadhaar Authentication Service along with the unique transaction code for that authentication shall be printed in the summary reports generated through the registration software and the summary report along with the unique transaction code, shall also be stored in the appropriate electronic format.
- 5. *Power of Registering Officer to examine*.ô Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules.ô
 - a. In case of the party appearing for admitting execution whose identity has been verified through Consent based Aadhaar Authentication Service, the Registering Officer in order to satisfy himself about the identity of the said party, shall not examine any other persons ;



Mohd Sofi R/o Padgampora ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz.
