Subject :ô Counting of previous service on joining new service in UT Government/Centre Government/Autonomous Body for the benefit of gratuity in respect of Government employees covered under Defined Contributory Pension Scheme (NPS).

CIRCULAR

The benefit of Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity was extended to NPS employees of UT Government service vide SRO-484 dated 29-11-2017 and SO-328 dated 24-09-2021 issued by Finance Department, on the same terms and conditions as is applicable to employees covered under Defined Pension Scheme (Old Pension Scheme) on the analogy of the pattern adopted by Government of India vide O. M. No. 38/41/06-P&PW (A) dated 05-05-2009 and O. M. No. 07-05-2012-P&PW (F)/B dated 26-08-2016.

Doubts has been expressed by various departments as to whether the service rendered by NPS employees who have taken another appointment in the UT Government after quitting the former service is entitled for counting of service for pensionery benefits (Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity).

The issue has been examined in the Finance Department. The counting of service for the purpose of gratuity on mobility of a NPS Government employee from one department to another department may be regulated in the following manner:ô

(I) On mobility from one department to another department of UT Government service, the service rendered in the previous department shall be counted for the purpose of grant of Gratuity.

 - (II) On mobility from Central Government Service to UT Government Service or vice-versa, having NPS with provisions of retirement gratuity/death gratuity for its employees, the service rendered in the Central Government or in UT Government, as the case may be, shall be counted for the purpose of grant of gratuity. There shall be no sharing of gratuity liability between the Center and UT Government.
- (III) On mobility from UT Government Service to UT Autonomous Body having NPS with provisions of retirement/death gratuity for its employees, similar to that in UT Government, the service rendered in the UT Government would be counted for grant of gratuity. The Government will discharge its gratuity liability by paying the amount of retirement gratuity for the service rendered in the Government to the UT Autonomous Body. This procedure shall be followed *mutatis mutandis* in respect of NPS employees going over from one autonomous body to another autonomous body or from an Autonomous Body to UT Government having NPS with provisions of retirement/death gratuity for its employees similar to UT Government employees.
- (IV) On mobility from UT Government Service to a UT Autonomous Body, where the provision for grant of gratuity similar to that in UT Government does not exist or to a Public Sector Undertaking, the NPS Government employees shall be granted retirement gratuity as per rules for the service rendered in the UT Government subject to the condition that the total gratuity admissible in respect of the service rendered under the Government of J&K, shall not exceed the amount that would have been admissible, had the Government servant continued in Government Service and retired on the same pay which he/she drew on retirement from later organization.

The above provisions would be applicable to Government employees covered under NPS who resign (technical resignation) to take up another appointment, with proper permission, in Centre/UT Government or Central/ UT Autonomous Body or a PSU.

It is hereby ordered that duly engaged Daily Rated Workers, including Casual Labourers, in all Government Departments and those of Municipalities & Local Bodies, as are in receipt of Rs. 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred) per day, shall be paid wages @ Rs. 311/- (Rupees Three Hundred and Eleven) per day w. e. f. 17-10-2022.

It is further ordered that:

- 1. Biometric attendance system will be enforced for all categories of persons engaged by Government in any capacity.
- The concerned DDO/Controlling Officer shall certify with every bill that the daily rated workers/casual workers have worked for the prescribed time period every day and that their performance has been satisfactory.
- 3. With respect to field staff, where biometric attendance may be difficult, the concerned DDO shall certify attendance. However, such staff shall be required to mark attendance at defined intervals.
- 4. The Aadhaar based data base shall be reconciled to avoid duplication.
- 5. The concerned departments shall submit full details regarding unauthorized engagements so as to identify officers/officials

- - 6. The number of hours of engagement may be restricted to budget availability.

Subject :ô Procurement of Goods and Services by the Government Departments/PSUs/Aided Institutions produced and provided by Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs).

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CIRCULAR

Attention of all the Administrative Departments is invited towards circular instructions issued by Finance Department vide No. A/106(03)-II-244 dated 11-01-2020, regarding procurement of Goods and Services by Government Departments/PSUø produced and provided by Micro and Small Enterprises.

It has been stipulated that every Department or Public Sector Undertaking shall procure a minimum of 20% of the total overall annual procurement of the Goods or Services from Micro and Small Enterprises. The instructions were issued on the basis of similar instructions notified by the Ministy of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises for procurement through MSMEs vide SO-581 (E) dated 23-03-2012.

Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India has vide SO-5670(E) dated 9-11-2018 made the following amendments to the Public Procurement Policy for the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012:ô

- (i) Throughout the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012, for the figures and word ::20 per cent@ wherever they occur, the figures and word ::25 per cent@shall be substituted.
- (ii) Special provision for Micro and Small Enterprise owned by women, out of the total annual procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises, 3 per cent from within the 25 per cent target shall be earmarked for procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises owned by women.

- - (a) Every Department or Public Sector Undertaking shall procure a minimum of 25% of the total overall Annual Procurement of Goods or Services from Micro and Small Enterprises.
 - (b) Out of the total annual procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises, 3 per cent from within the 25 per cent target shall be earmarked for procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises owned by women.

Subject :ô Verification of Status of GSTIN of the contractor and authenticity of GST-3B return through the Peridot App (available in the Playstore) or from the State Taxes Department.

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CIRCULAR

It has come to the notice of Finance Department that dealers/contractors whose GSTIN have been cancelled or deactivated are applying for Government tenders with submission of fake/forged GST returns. Such practice happens because tender inviting departments do not cross-verify documents submitted by the tenderer with the State Taxes Department.

In terms of General Sales Tax Act, 1962, it was mandatory for the Contractors to get NOC from the State Taxes Department before applying for a tender. This practice has been done away with, post implementation of GST Act, 2017.

In order to have timely compliance of returns by contractors as well as DDOs, the State Taxes Department with the help of NIC, Jammu has recently developed an Online Web application namely ::APNA TDS portal which helps in identifying payment made to work contract service providers by DDOs through JK Paysys portal.

Before allotting any work contract, the status of GSTIN of the contractor and authenticity of GST-3B return submitted by the contractor can also be verified through the Peridot App (available in the Playstore) or from the State Taxes Department. Also before releasing of payment to contractor, the DDOs can verify the latest status of the GSTIN of the contractor by using the information available in Peridot App or through the State Taxes Department in order to ascertain that contractor has not defaulted in GST tax compliance. Payment to such contractor who are not fulfilling statutory obligations under GST Taxation Law should be avoided.

Accordingly all the Administrative Departments are advised to direct their subordinate officers that before allotting any contract/releasing payment to the contractor, the status of GSTIN of the contractor and authenticity of GST-3B return submitted by the contractor should be verified through the Peridot App (available in the Playstore) or from the State Taxes Department. Further, the DDOs should check latest Status of Contractor using the information available on Peridot App or from State Taxes Department. The payments in favour of those contractors who are not fulfilling Statutory Obligations under GST Taxation Law should be avoided.

Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 23/2021 under section 307 IPC, 7/27 Arms Act, 18, 20, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Tral, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the Section 19 and 23 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, two died bodies were recovered from the place of encounter, who were later on identified as the terrorist of AGH outfit namely Imtiyaz Ahmad Shah S/o Ab. Ahad Shah R/o Ratsuna, Tral and Zahid Ahmad Koka S/o Ab. Hamid Koka R/o Melhora, Shopian. During the search, the arms/ammunition viz. 02 AK 47 Rifles, 04 Magazines, 31 rounds, 01 Pistol, 07 rounds and 01 UBGL, were also recovered from the place of occurrence; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of place of the occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstancesof the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, one Danish Rafiq Wani S/o Mohd Rafiq Wani R/o Amirabad, Tral, was found involved in the case. Subsequently, the accused was arrested and it was found that the accused constructed a hideout in his paddy filed for hiding of terrorists in order to promote terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Danish Rafiq Wani, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of Ansar Gazwat-ul-Hind (AGuH) outfit particularly the killed terrorists namely Imtiyaz Ahmad Shah and Zahid Ahmad Koka, and was providing logistic support to them, besides, under a well knit criminal conspiracy voluntarily harbouring the terrorists in the hideout constructed by him in his paddy field for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 7. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Shah and Zahid Ahmad Koka, have been killed in the said encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against him; and

Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below-mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :ô

Whereas, the School Education Department is administering the Jammu and Kashmir õ**Beti Anmol**ö Scheme to provide stipend to the BPL Girl students which is being implemented through the Director School Education Jammu/Kashmir and under the Scheme, Stipend @ Rs. 5000/- per annum per Girl Student is given to the Below Poverty Line (BPL) Girl students of J&K UT on passing 10th Standard Board Examinations at the time of the getting Admission in 11th standard by respective Director School Education Jammu/Kashmir as per the extant scheme guidelines; and

Whereas, under the Scheme, õ**Beti Anmol**ö of UT of J&K, meant for increasing literacy rate of BPL Girl Students and is given to the (BPL) Girl students of J&K UT on passing 10th Standard Board Examinations at the time of the getting Admission in 11th standard by respective Director School Education Jammu/Kashmir as per the extant scheme guidelines;

Whereas, the aforesaid Scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

- - (3) As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Administrative Department School Education, Jammu and Kashmir, is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar enrolment centre located in the respective Block or Tehsil, the respective Director School Education, Jammu/Kashmir Administrative, shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the Student, the benefit under the Scheme shall be given to such student subject to production of the following documents, namely :ô

- (a) if the student has been enrolled (with biometrics collection), his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification slip, or of bio-metric update identification slip; and
- (b) any one of the following documents, namely :ô
 - (i) Birth Certificate; or Record of birth issued by the appropriate authority; or
 - (ii) School identity card, duly signed by the Principal of the school, containing parentsø names; and
- (c) any one of the following documents as proof of relationship of the beneficiary with the parent or legal guardian as per the extant Scheme guidelines, namely :ô
 - (i) Birth Certificate; or Record of birth issued by the appropriate authority; or
 - (ii) Ration Card; or

- - (iii) Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS)
 Card; or Employeesø State Insurance Corporation
 (ESIC) Card; or Central Government Health Scheme
 (CGHS) Card; or
 - (iv) Pension Card; or

 - (vi) any Government Family Entitlement Card; or
 - (vii) any other document as specified by the Department :

Provided further that the above documents shall be checked by an officer specifically designated by the respective Director School Education, Jammu/Kashmir for that purpose.

 - (a) in case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the respective Director School Education, Jammu/ Kashmir, shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with finger-print authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;
 - (b) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;

- (c) in all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the scheme may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of Quick Response code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Administrative Department of School Education, Jammu & Kashmir through its implementing Agency.
- 4. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, no eligible student shall be denied benefit under the Scheme in case of failure to establish his identity by undergoing authentication, or furnishing proof of possession of Aadhaar number, or in the case of a eligible student to whom no Aadhaar number has been assigned, producing an application for enrolment. The benefit shall be given to him by verifying his identity on the basis of other documents as mentioned in clauses (b) and (c) of the proviso of sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 1, and where benefit is given on the basis of such other documents, a separate register shall be maintained to record the same, which shall be reviewed and audited periodically by the Administrative Department of School Education, Jammu and Kashmir through its Implementing Agency.
- 5. This notification shall come into effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

S.O.-162—Whereas, the use of Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency, and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity; and

Whereas, the School Education Department is administering the Jammu & Kashmir "Children of Army Personal Martyred in War" Scheme to provide stipend to the students which is being implemented

through the Administrative Department School Education Jammu/ Kashmir and under the Scheme, Stipend @ Rs. 250/- per Month per Children (i.e., @ Rs. 3000/- Per Annum per Children) is given to the students/Children of Army Personal Martyred in War of J&K UT, studying in Director Sainik Welfare Boards, by the Administrative Department as per the extant scheme guidelines; and

Whereas, under the Scheme "Children of Army Personal Martyred in War" is meant for *the UT of J&K* is given to the Childrens of Army Personal Martyred in War of J&K UT, studying in Director Sainik Welfare Boards, by the Administrative Department as per the extant Scheme guidelines;

Whereas, the aforesaid Scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby notifies the following, namely:—

- (1) A student eligible for receiving the benefits desirous under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.
 - (2) Any eligible student desirous of availing the benefit under the Scheme, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment subject to the consent of his parents or guardians, before registering for the Scheme provided that he is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per Section 3 of the said Act and such eligible student shall visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) website www.uidai.gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.
 - (3) As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Administrative Department School

Education, Jammu and Kashmir, is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar enrolment centre located in the respective Block or Tehsil, the Administrative Department School Education, Jammu and Kashmir, shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the student, the benefit under the Scheme shall be given to such student subject to production of the following documents, namely:—

- (a) if the student has been enrolled (with biometrics collection), his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification slip, or of bio-metric update identification slip; and
- (b) any one of the following documents, namely:-
 - (i) Birth Certificate; or Record of birth issued by the appropriate authority; or
 - (ii) School identity card, duly signed by the Principal of the school, containing parents' names; and
- (c) any one of the following documents as proof of relationship of the beneficiary with the parent or legal guardian as per the extant Scheme guidelines, namely:-
 - (i) Birth Certificate; or Record of birth issued by the appropriate authority; or
 - (ii) Ration Card; or
 - (iii) Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) Card; or Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) Card; or Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) Card; or

- (iv) Pension Card; or
- (v) Army Canteen Card; or
- (vi) any Government Family Entitlement Card; or
- (vii) any other document as specified by the Department:

Provided further that the above documents shall be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Administrative Department of School Education, Jammu and Kashmir for that purpose.

- 2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Administrative Department of School Education, Jammu and Kashmir shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.
- 3. In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely:—
 - (a) in case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Administrative Department of School Education, Jammu & Kashmir, shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with finger-print authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;
 - (b) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;
 - (c) in all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the scheme may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity

can be verified through the Quick Response code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of Quick Response code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Administrative Department of School Education, Jammu & Kashmir.

- 4. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, no eligible student shall be denied benefit under the Scheme in case of failure to establish his identity by undergoing authentication, or furnishing proof of possession of Aadhaar number, or in the case of an eligible student to whom no Aadhaar number has been assigned, producing an application for enrolment. The benefit shall be given to him by verifying his identity on the basis of other documents as mentioned in clauses (b) and (c) of the proviso of sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 1, and where benefit is given on the basis of such other documents, a separate register shall be maintained to record the same, which shall be reviewed and audited periodically by the Administrative Department of School Education, Jammu & Kashmir.
