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THE HIGH COURT OF JAMMU & KASHMIR AND LADAKH AT JAMMU

(Vested with Powers of State Bar Council U/S 58 of Advocates Act, 1961)

Subject :ô Guidelines for Issuance/Renewal of Identity Cards to Enrolled Advocates.

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### Notification

No. 679 of 2024/RG/LP Dated 24-04-2024.

In exercise of the powers conferred under the Constitution of India and Sections 34 r/w Section 57 of the Advocates Act 1961 and all other enabling provisions in this regard, the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh (vested with the powers of State Bar Council U/S 58 of Advocates Act, 1961), hereby frames and issues the following guidelines/instructions for issuance/renewal of Identity Cards to the Advocates.

### I. Eligibility:

Any person enrolled as an Advocate with the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh (vested with the powers of State Bar Council under Section 58 of Advocates Act, 1961), shall be eligible to apply for issuance of Identity Card in his favour unless disqualified to act as an Advocate, for any reason.

### 2. Application:

Application for issuance/renewal of the Identity Card shall be submitted in prescribed FORM-A to these Guidelines or such other form as may be prescribed by the High Court, to the office of Registrar Judicial of the High Court Jammu/Srinagar (as the case may be), together with necessary documents & fee of Rs 500/- or such other fee, as may be prescribed in this behalf.

### 3. Documents required to be submitted with the application:

An application for issuance of Identity Card, shall be supported by a copy of the Certificate of Enrolment, Adhar Card, Address proof, Recommendation Letter of Bar Association concerned or of two Advocates having at least 7 years standing at Bar, two latest passport size photographs and an affidavit stating that applicant has not applied for or obtained identity card already.

### 4. Register of Applications and Accounts:

Office of the Registrar Judicial, shall maintain a Register of Applications, in which all the applications received, for issuance of Identity Cards shall be entered in seriatim as per the date of the receipt of the application. Registrar Judicial shall also maintain a Savings Bank A/C for deposition of fee received with the applications and shall maintain a proper account of the same.

### 5. Scrutiny of application:

Office of Registrar Judicial after receiving the application shall scrutinise the application to see if the same is in prescribed Form and complete in all respects.

### 6. Deficiency to be informed:

Where the application is found deficient or not in conformity with the prescribed form, the office of Registrar Judicial shall inform and require the applicant to rectify the deficiency/ do the needful within 7 working days and the office shall make a note in this regard in the Register of Applications.

### 7. Failure to remove deficiency:

In case the applicant fails to remove the deficiency intimated within the stipulated time frame, the application shall not be processed further and an entry in this regard shall be made in the Register or Applications. Such, an applicant, however, shall, have a right to apply again after removing the deficiency.

### 8. Application complete in all respects to be processed:

Office of the Registrar Judicial concerned on receipt of application which is complete in all respects, shall process the same for issuance of Identity Card.

### 9. Submission of undertaking by applicant:

After the Identity Card is ready, Registrar Judicial concerned shall obtain an undertaking from the applicant to the effect that on expiry of the validity of the Identity Card or on his leaving practice or on his ceasing to practice as an Advocate, he/she shall surrender the same forthwith before the concerned issuing Authority.

### 10. Issuance of the Identity Card:

After the submission of undertaking by the applicant, identity card shall be issued to the applicant in Form-B or B-1 to these Guidelines, under the seal of Registrar Judicial concerned, against a proper receipt to be obtained on Register of Applications.

### 11. Validity of the Identity Card:

The identity Card issued to an Advocate holding Absolute Enrolment Certificate, shall be valid, unless cancelled/suspended/revoked earlier, for a period of 7 years or till the time he remains on the rolls of Bar Council whichever is earlier, However, the validity of the Identity Card issued to an Advocate enrolled, provisionally, shall be valid for the period, unless cancelled/suspended/revoked earlier, of his/her provisional enrolment i.e. 2 years from the date of his/her provisional enrolment and the Identity Card issued to such an Advocate shall prominently bear the word "Provisional".

### 12. Loss, damage or misuse etc. to be reported :

It shall be the duty of the Advocate to whom the Identity Card is issued to promptly report misuse, damage, loss or theft of the Identity Card, to the issuing authority thereof.

### 13. Renewal:

On expiry of the validity period, enrolled Advocate may apply for renewal of the validity of the Identity Card.

14. For renewal of the Identity Card after expiry of its earlier validity period, recommendation of the concerned Bar Association or two Advocates, shall not be required provided application for renewal is submitted prior to the date of expiry of the validity period.

15. Where the renewal of identity card is sought after the expiry of validity of Identity Card, recommendation of Bar Association or two Advocates with 7 or more years of practice shall be required. In case of renewal, Registrar Judicial, may relax the condition of recommendation by two Advocates or Bar Association concerned, for reasons to be recorded.

### 16. Surrender of Identity Card:

It shall be the duty of Advocate to surrender the Identity Card to IssuingAuthority, where the Advocate : ô

- (a) leaves the practice.
- (b) engages in any business, job or profession not consistent with the Provisions of Advocates Act, 1961.
- (c) His name is removed from the rolls or his enrolment is suspended; or

for any other reason ceases to practice as an Advocate.

### 17. Suspension/Canellation or Revocation of Identity Cards:

In case of any misuse of the identity card issued or any expedient reason, Registrar Judicial Jammu/Srinagar, shall have the power to suspend, cancel or revoke the Identity Card issued after issuing show cause notice to the Advocate concerned and considering the same.

### 18. Appeal:

An appeal may be preferred by the aggrieved advocate against the order of Registrar Judicial, suspending or cancelling the Identity Card issued to him/her within 30 days from the date of passing of order, to the Registrar General, whose decision thereon shall be final. Any delay in filing the appeal may be condoned by the Appellate authority, for any sufficient cause shown.

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Subject :ô AI-Assisted Translation of Judgments & Judicial Records in Vernacular Languages Guidelines, 2023.

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### Notification

No. 847 of 2024/RG/GS Dated 09-05-2024

With the object, to enable and improve the access to justice for all Honøble Supreme Court has initiated a project to translate the judgments of the Supreme Court and High Courts into regional languages and to make the same available in vernacular languages for the information of general public. To achieve the desired results, it has been decided to make use of Artificial Intelligence Technology, for translating the Judgments into vernacular languages.

Honøble, Supreme Court in order to operationlise the project has constituted an "AI- Assisted Legal Translation Advisory Committeö and has requested all the High Courts to constitute similar committees in the High Courts. Besides, Hon'ble Supreme Court has also requested the High Courts to frame guidelines for AI- Assisted Translation of the Judgments/Judicial Record. It is in this backdrop, High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, has already constituted a two-member committee called as "AI- Assisted Legal Translation Advisory Committee of High Court of J&K and Ladakh".

The High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, in order to implement the project, hereby frames following guidelines for AI- Assisted Translation of Judgments into vernacular languages to be called as Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court AI-Assisted Translation of Judgments & Judicial Records in Vernacular Languages Guidelines, 2023.

### **Monitoring Committee:**

 There sr.all be a Monitoring Committee, to aid and assist the AI Assisted Legal Translation Advisory Committee of the High Court with respect to implementation of the AI-Assisted Translation

Project in the High Court which shall comprise of at least three members having expertise in the field of law, etymology, linguistics and translation. The members to the said Committee shall be nominated by the AI- Assisted Legal Translation Advisory Committee of the High Court.

### 2. Separate Cadre:

The matter pertaining to creation of a separate cadre in the High Court for AI-Assisted Translation comprising of Registrar (Translation), to be manned by a District Judge Cadre officer with academic/linguistic inclinations, two posts of Joint Registrar (Translation), one for each wing of the High Court to be manned by an officer of a Civil Judge (Senior Division) rank with academic/ linguistic inclinations, two posts of Chief Translators (One each for the Jammu/Srinagar wing of the High Court), Four Senior Translators (two each for, Jammu/Srinagar wing of the High Court), 10 translators (5 each for Jammu/Srinagar Wing of the High Court) for translating the judgments into vernacular/regional languages, who shall be in addition to the already available translators, two System Assistants (one for each wing) and two Class-IV employees (one for each wing), shall be taken up with the Government. The cadre so created shall act according to the advice and instructions of õAI- Assisted Legal Translation Advisory Committee of the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh". Registrar (Translation) shall be the coordinator of AI- Assisted Translation project of High Court, who shall be responsible for monitoring the progress of AI- Assisted Translation on day-to-day basis.

### 3. Pending creation of Separate Cadre:

Pending creation of the separate cadre for the AI- Assisted Translation Project, the High Court shall create a panel of Retired Judicial Officers and retired translators willing to work for translating the Judgments under the project, on the remuneration to be paid as per the slab prescribed by Supreme Court Committee or Translation Advisory Committee of High Court of J&K and Ladakh or the Government and the Registrar (IT) shall act as Coordinator of AI-Assisted Translation Project of the High Court, who shall monitor the progress of the AI - Assisted translation.

### 4. Technology for AI- Assisted Translation:

The tool which shall be utilised for AI- Assisted translation of judgments/record shall be SUVAS or such other tool as may be decided by the õAI- Assisted Legal Translation Advisory Committee of High Court of J&K and Ladakhö.

### 5. Workflow of the cadre:

Registrar (Translation) shall be the Editor-in-Chief of the Translation Cadre and shall have the overall supervision over the day-to-day working of the Cadre.

- 6. Joint Registrar (Translation)/ Civil Judge (Senior Division), shall be Editor of the Translation for the Jammu/Srinagar Wing of the High Court, as the case may be.
- 7. The job of the Translators shall be to edit the translation of judgments/ records done with the help of AI tool to make same in tune/consistent with the source Judgment/Document.
- 8. The job of the Senior and Chief Translators shall be to verify and to do the curation of the translation edited by the translators.

### 9. Selection of Judgments for AI- assisted translation:

The judgments for AI- assisted translation shall be selected by the monitoring committee with the prior approval and guidance of the õAI- Assisted Legal Translation Advisory Committee of High Court of J&K and Ladakhö.

### **Priority of Judgments for AI Translation:**

- 10. The priority for translation of Judgments shall be decided by the Monitoring Committee with the prior approval of the AI- Assisted Legal Translation Advisory Committee of High Court but as a general rule, following priority shall be observed:
  - (a) Judgments of Supreme Court.
  - (b) Judgments of the High Court.

- (c) Judgments of Public Importance.
- (d) Judgments covering large number of citizens.
- (e) Judgments affecting personal law issues.
- (f) Any other category of Judgment as may be decided by Translation Advisory Committee.

### To make improvements by collection and preparation of Data for achieving desired outcomes:

11. It shall be the endeavor of AI Assisted Translation Cadre to collect and prepare the data to improve AI Assisted Translation Model, to achieve the desired level of accuracy and outcomes.

### **Collaboration with the Government:**

12. Translation Cadre shall collaborate with other Government Translators, Linguistic experts to accomplish the project with accuracy and also for seeking technical and financial support for achieving the goal of access to Justice for all.

### Translated Judgments/record to be made available in regional languages:

13. Translation Cadre shall make the judgments translated in vernacular languages available to people to give them access to justice.

### Subject-wise categorization of Translated Judgments:

14. All the translated judgments shall be categorized subject-wise and kept available for general public.

### Translated Judgments to be used for spreading Legal Awareness:

15. Translated, copies of Judgments, shall be made available to Legal Services Authorities for spreading awareness as part of Legal Literacy Mission.

### Translated Judgments to be made available to the parties to proceedings:

16. Translated copies of the Judgments shall also be made available to the parties to proceedings by e-mail, for which database of e-mail of the parties be kept updated.

### Translated copies be made available to Government departments:

17. Copies of the Translated Judgments be also forwarded to Government departments for proper understanding and implementation of the same.

### **Procedure for Translation:**

- 18. The first round of translation shall be done by SUVAS or such other AI tool as may be prescribed by Translation Advisory Committee of the High Court which shall be followed by manual editing by using the tool.
- 19. As the accuracy level of AI tool is likely to vary from subject to subject and from language to language, a gradual improvement by means of continuous use of tool and development of vocabulary would be needed for translation and editing of the translation.
- If for the purpose of translation, creation of a new word/term is needed, then the Translation Advisory Committee must be consulted.
- 21. Monitoring Committee shall on a continuous basis prepare a glossary of words and phrases of regional languages which may be used for translation and keep on updating the same.
- 22. For the easy understanding of the translated judgments/record, the complex technical terms may be given in English within brackets after the English language equivalents of the same if they are available. If the regional language equivalent is not available, the English word may be transliterated in the language script and be given in its place.
- 23. Common vocabulary of the regional language should be used for translation to make the translated copy easy to comprehend.
- 24. In case of synonyms, most commonly used synonym of the word which is available should be selected.
- 25. Where there are many words for a particular object, the word which is generally used in that particular domain shall be used for translation to make the concepts understandable to the readers.

- 26. Final translation should be such that same conveys the complete meaning and context of the original text. It need not necessarily be a word-to-word translation.
- 27. The terms/words/phrases which may have connotative meanings with both positive and negative dimensions or features which are not there in the source language should be avoided in the translation.
- 28. In case the original text is translated into word-to-word sequence by AI translation tool, then for the efficient and meaningful translation it should be rephrased partially or completely, if required.
- 29. While translating text with the aid of AI tool, the text shall be carefully edited by reading each sentence several times of both original judgment/document and the translation thereof, for understanding the proper meaning and context of the subject.
- 30. These guidelines are not exhaustive and therefore, may require additions/deletions in future and in case of any ambiguity, the Chief Justice shall have the power to issue directions/instructions for removal of the same.

Vide GO No. 473-F of 2019 dated 28-11-2019, sanction has been accorded to the grant of Children Education Allowance and Hostel Subsidy in favour of Employees of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, at par with the Central Government Employees.

The admissibility and procedure for grant of the allowance has been explained in the Ibid Govt. Order at Para 2 (i) of the G.O dated 28-11-2019; as under :ô

"i. The reimbursement of Children Education Allowance/Hostel subsidy can be claimed only for the two eldest surviving children with the exception in case the second child birth results in twins/multiple birth. In case of failure of sterilization operation, the CEA/Hostel Subsidy would be admissible in respect of children born out of the first instance of such failure beyond the usual two children norm".

References have been received seeking clarification regarding the admissibility of Children Education Allowance in case of multiple births in first child birth event.

The matter was taken up with Department of Personnel & Training, Ministry of Personnel, P. G and Pensions, Government of India for clarification, vide letter No. A-27012/02/2022-Estt.(AL) dated 12-02-2024, the DoPT has clarified as under :ô

"Para 2(a) of O. M dated 17-07-2018, is in accordance with two child policy of the Central Government for Central Government employees. "Multiple Birth in first child birth is out of human control, accordingly, in case of multiple birth (more than 02) in first birth, reimbursement of CEA may be allowed for all children born in first Child birth, in a Similar way as mentioned in para 2(a) of O. M dated 17-07-2018".

Accordingly, it is hereby clarified that in the event of multiple births (more than 02) in first child birth, reimbursement of Children Education Allowance may be allowed for all children born in first child birth.

### "Annexure A" DRAFT NOTIFICATION

Whereas, an application has been received from Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board (SMVDSB) through the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu for grant of permission under Aerial Ropeways Act, 2002 for the Construction of Passenger Ropeway at katra from Tarakote to Sanjichhat.

Whereas, it has been submitted that the project has been conceived to facilitate elderly, specially-abled, medically unfit and such other pilgrims visiting the holy shrine. The entire land falling under the alignment of the proposed project including terminal stations and corridor belongs to Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board.

Whereas, the application has been endorsed by Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide communication number 502/Mis/Gen./24/227 dated 20-05 -2024 highlighting that Rs. 200 crore investment proposal shall boost the local economy by attracting more pilgrims and shall also expand the commercial activities in the region. Further, it has also been mentioned that the proposed ropeway project is environment friendly having low dust emissions.

Whereas, a Sub-Committee Constituted by the J&K Government vide Order No. 1276-GAD of 2018 dated 14.08.2018 has also directed for reduction in the number of mules ferrying pilgrims on the track to the Shrine, in the interest of environment preservation and preventing pollution of the holy Banganga river and it has been desired by the Government that the Board develops eco-friendly modes of transport like Battery operated vehicles/aerial Ropeways, Cable Cars, Elevators, Escalators etc. for the pilgrims in pursuance to the direction of the Hon'ble NGT.

Whereas, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board v/s Gauri Mulekhi in its Order dated 26-11-2018 has constituted a Centrally Empowered Committee to examine the issues of reduction in number of mules on the track and other allied matters. The committee in its report dated 12-07-2019 has recommended creation of a Passenger Ropeway from Katra to Adhkuwari with preferable extension upto Sanjichhat within a span of 4 years.

Whereas, M/s RITES Ltd, a PSU in Ministry of Railways, a leading sector expert in the field of ropeways, has been engaged as the Project Management Consultant by the Board and shall also serve as the Independent Engineer to oversee the construction and commissioning of the Ropeway project.

Whereas, the application clearly describes the 2.543 Km route to be followed for the proposed aerial ropeway supported by maps, plans, section, diagram and other related information pertaining to the project. The tender document has incorporated state of the art equipment and technology confirming to CEN standards with adequate Integrated Rescue System as a fool proof safety mechanism for the pilgrims.

Whereas, all the stakeholders of Katra and adjacent areas have been consulted by SMVDSB for the execution of the project via detailed interactions held from May, 2023 to February, 2024 by a High-Level Committee constituted by Hon'ble Lt. Governor of J&K (Hon'ble Chairman, SMVDSB) comprising two members of the Board and Divisional Commissioner, Jammu.

Whereas the suggestions and objections of various stakeholders have been considered by the High-Level Committee and accordingly a report was placed before the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board in its 72nd meeting held on 03-04-2024 chaired by Honorable Lt. Governor, J&K, wherein the same have been deliberated and subsequently, the project has been approved in consultation with the local stakeholders and District Administration, Reasi.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 (1) of the Jammu and Kashmir Aerial Ropeways Act, 2002 read with Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation (Adaptation of State Laws) Fifth Order, 2020 NO: SO 3808(E) dated 26-10-2020, and on the recommendation of the Divisional Commissioner Jammu, the Government of Jammu & Kashmir hereby grants permission to the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board (SMVDSB) for the construction of an Aerial ropeway at Katra from Tarakote to Sanjhichhat. This permission is granted in consideration of the proposal submitted by SMVDSB to facilitate the pilgrimage to Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine by providing an efficient and safe transportation system with following details:

### A. Project Details:

- i. Starting Point: Tarakote LTP
- ii. Ending Point: Sanjhichhat UTP
- iii. Length of Ropeway: 2.543 km
- iv. Stations: 02 Stations i.e Tarakote LTP and Sanjhichhat UTP, with 16 towers along the corridor.
- v. Carrying Capacity: 1500 persons per hour
- vi. Type of Ropeway: monocable with CEN standards,
- vii. Estimated Project Cost: Rs 200 Cr.
- viii. Mode of Execution Build-Own-Operate-Transfer (BOOT)

  Model: The project will be executed under the BOOT model,

where the contractor will Build, Own, Operate, and subsequently Transfer the ropeway to SMVDSB after a specified period.

- ix. Contractor Selection: SMVDSB shall engage a reputed and experienced contractor through a transparent bidding process, using the e-tendering mode to award the contract for project execution.
- x. **Ownership Period:** Shall be decided by SMVDSB through contract.
- xi. **Revenue Sharing:** Shall be decided between SMVDSB and the Contractors. During the operation period, a revenue-sharing agreement will be in place between SMVDSB and the contractor, details of which will be outlined in the contract.

### **Terms and Conditions:**

### 1. Time frames:

- i. Capital Raising: The bidder must raise the capital required for the construction of the aerial ropeway within six months.
- ii. Commencement of Construction: The construction shall commence within nine months from the date of issuance of this order.
- iii. Completion of Construction: The construction shall be completed within 1035 days (two years and ten months) from the appointed date.
- 2. **Government Support:** The Government shall not be liable to give any concession, guarantee or financial assistance to SMVDSB.
- 3. **Right of Purchase:** After the expiry of the concession period, the Shrine Board will be the owner of the ropeway.
- 4. **Audit and Accounts:** The SMVDSB shall maintain detailed accounts of the project as per SMVD Shrine Act, 1988
- 5. **Arbitration:** Any disputes arising from this project shall be settled through arbitration according to the rules laid in the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- 6. **Technical Specifications:** The ropeway construction must adhere to the specified structural designs, quality of materials, safety factors

- and methods of computing stresses as outlined in the technical guidelines provided.
- 7. Construction Over Public Ways: The construction of the aerial ropeway over roads and other public ways of communication, excluding railways, must follow the prescribed rules. Prior sanction of the Central Government shall be taken, if required, for the construction over railways.
- 8. **Transfer of Rights:** After the expiry of the concession period, the Shrine Board will be the owner of the ropeway.
- Takeover Conditions: The Government reserves the right to take over the aerial ropeway to be operated by SMVDSB or any other person, if deemed necessary.
- 10. Motive Power: The motive power to be used on the aerial ropeway shall be electric, subject to conditions on its use as specified by the relevant authorities.
- 11. **Minimum Headway:** As per specified norms, a minimum headway must be maintained under different parts of the rope.
- 12. **Bridges and Guards:** To ensure safety, bridges or guards must be constructed and maintained at specified points under the ropeway.

### 13. Traffic Regulations:

- i. The ropeway is permitted to carry passengers and Material goods within the specified operational capacity.
- ii. The promoter/ operator shall not carry hazardous materials in the Ropeway.

### 14. Rates and Revisions:

- i. The rates shall be finalized by the Shrine Board at the time of operationalization of the Project.
- ii. Revise the rates based on significant changes in operational costs, regulatory changes and annual economic reviews.
- 15. **Security Deposit:** A security deposit as specified in the tender document shall be deposited by the bidder with SMVDSB.

### 16. Environmental and Safety Standards:

i. The project shall adhere to all relevant environmental, safety, and regulatory standards as prescribed by the Government.

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- ii. Regular maintenance and safety checks of the ropeway system shall be conducted by the promoter.
- 17. **Disaster Management:** A comprehensive Disaster Management Plan must be in place to address potential emergencies.
- 18. **Cost Bearing:** The promoter shall bear all costs associated with the ropeway project's installation, operation and maintenance to be executed through BOOT model.
- Legal Jurisdiction: Any legal disputes arising from the project implementation shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble High Court at Jammu.
- 20. **Validity and Revocation:** This permission is valid for period of 1035 days subject to further extension of 181 days (6 months) days if the promoter applies with justified reasons.
- 21. The Government of Jammu & Kashmir reserves the right to revoke this permission in case of any violation of the stipulated terms and conditions or any other reason deemed appropriate.

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 12th February, 2024 and is hereby published for general information:—

### THE JAMMU AND KASHMIR LOCAL BODIES LAWS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2024

(No. 2 of 2024)

[12th February, 2024.]

An Act further to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Panchayati Raj Act, 1989 (IX of 1989), the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Act, 2000 (XX of 2000) and the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000 (XXI of 2000).

WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir is not in existence and proclamation made by the Government of India *vide* number S.O. 3937 (E), dated the 31st October,

2019, in terms of section 73 of the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act, 2019 (34 of 2019) is in force; and

WHEREAS, in terms of the aforesaid Proclamation, the powers of the Legislature of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir shall be exercisable by or under the authority of Parliament.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

#### CHAPTER I

### **PRELIMINARY**

- **1. Short title and commencement.** (1) This Act may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Local Bodies Laws (Amendment) Act, 2024.
  - (2) It shall come into force on such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

#### CHAPTER II

### AMENDMENTS TO THE JAMMU AND KASHMIR PANCHAYATI RAJ ACT, 1989

- 2. Amendment of section 2.— In section 2 of the Jammu and Kashmir Panchayati Raj Act, 1989 (Jammu and Kashmir Act IX of 1989) (hereafter in this Chapter referred to as the Panchayati Raj Act), in subsection (1), after clause (1), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—
  - '(*la*) "Other Backward Classes" means the Other Backward Classes declared by the Government of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir from time to time in accordance with sub-clause (*iii*) of clause (*o*) of section 2 of the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 (Jammu and Kashmir Act XIV of 2004);'.
- **3. Substitution of section 2A.** For section 2A of the Panchayati Raj Act, the following section shall be substituted, namely:—
  - **'2A.** Construction of reference of certain expressions by certain other expressions.—Throughout the Act, for the words "District Planning and Development Board" and "District Panchayat Officer" wherever they occur, the words "the District Development Council"

and "Assistant Commissioner of Panchayat" shall respectively be substituted.'.

- **4.** Amendment of section 4.— In section 4 of the Panchayati Raj Act, in sub-section (3),—
  - (a) in the first proviso,—
  - (i) in clause (a), the word "and" occurring at the end shall be omitted:
  - (ii) for clause (b), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—
    - "(b) the Scheduled Tribes; and
    - (c) the Other Backward Classes,";
  - (iii) in the long line, after the words "or of the Scheduled Tribes in that Panchayat area", the words "or of the Other Backward Classes in that Panchayat area" shall be inserted;
  - (b) in the second proviso,—
  - (i) in clause (a), for the words "or, as the case may be, the Scheduled Tribes,", the words "or the Scheduled Tribes or the Other Backward Classes, as the case may be," shall be substituted;
  - (ii) in clause (b), for the words "and the Scheduled Tribes", the words "the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes" shall be substituted.
- **5.** Amendment of section 27. In section 27 of the Panchayati Raj Act, in sub-section (3),—
  - (a) in the first proviso,—
    - (i) in clause (a), the word "and" occurring at the end shall be omitted;
    - (ii) for clause (b), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—
      - "(b) the Scheduled Tribes; and
      - (c) the Other Backward Classes,";
    - (*iii*) in the long line, after the words "or of the Scheduled Tribes in that district", the words "or of the Other Backward Classes in that district" shall be inserted;

- (b) in the second proviso,—
  - (i) in clause (a), for the words "or, as the case may be, the scheduled tribes,", the words "or the Scheduled Tribes or the Other Backward Classes, as the case may be," shall be substituted;
  - (*ii*) in clause (*b*), for the words "or the Scheduled Tribes", the words "or the Scheduled Tribes or the Other Backward Classes" shall be substituted.
- **6. Amendment of section 36A.** In section 36A of the Panchayati Raj Act, for sub-sections (2) and (3), the following sub-sections shall be substituted, namely:—
  - "(2) The salary, allowance and other conditions of service of the State Election Commissioner shall be such as the Lieutenant Governor may, by rules, determine:

Provided that if a person who, immediately before the date of assuming office as the State Election Commissioner is in receipt of or has received or has become entitled to receive a pension, other than a disability pension, in respect of any previous service under the Government of India or under the Government of a State or under the Government of a Union Territory, his pay in respect of service as State Election Commissioner shall be reduced—

- (a) by the amount of that pension; and
- (b) if he had, before assuming office, received, in *lieu* of a portion of the pension due to him in respect of such previous service, the commuted value thereof, by the amount of that portion of the pension.
- (3) The travelling allowance, provision of rent-free accommodation, conveyance facilities, medical facilities available to a person at the time of retirement or at the time of his appointment as State Election Commissioner, so far as may be, shall be admissible to him.
- (4) The power to grant or refuse leave to the State Election Commissioner and to revoke or curtail leave granted to him, shall vest in the Lieutenant Governor.".

- 7. Substitution of section 36B.—For section 36B of the Panchayati Raj Act, the following section shall be substituted, namely:—
  - **"36B. Removal of State Election Commissioner.**—The State Election Commissioner shall not be removed from his office except in like manner and on the like ground as a Judge of a High Court and the conditions of service of the State Election Commissioner shall not be varied to his disadvantage after his appointment.".
- **8.** Amendment of section 36D.—In section 36D of the Panchayati Raj Act, in sub-section (2),—
  - (a) for the opening portion "The Commission shall have the power to", the opening portion "The Commission referred to in sub-section (1) shall" shall be substituted;
  - (b) in clause (b), for the words "give such directions", the words "by order give such directions" shall be substituted;
  - (c) in clause (c), for the word "delegate", the words "by order, delegate, subject to such restrictions mentioned therein," shall be substituted.
- **9. Amendment of section 39.**—In section 39 of the Panchayati Raj Act, after clause (*iii*), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—
  - "(iv) such other grounds as may be determined by the State Election Commission.".
- **10. Amendment of section 45A**. In section 45A of the Panchayati Raj Act.—
  - (a) in sub-section (4),—
    - (i) in clause (a), the word "and" occurring at the end shall be omitted;
    - (ii) for clause (b), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—
      - "(b) for the Scheduled Tribes; and
      - (c) for the Other Backward Classes,";
    - (*iii*) in the long line, after the words "or of the Scheduled Tribes in the district", the words "or of the Other Backward Classes in the district" shall be inserted;

- (b) in sub-section (5), for the words "or, as the case may be, the Scheduled Tribes,", the words "or the Scheduled Tribes or the Other Backward Classes, as the case may be," shall be substituted;
- (c) in sub-section (6), for the words "Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes", the words "Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes" shall be substituted.

### **CHAPTER III**

### AMENDMENTS TO THE JAMMU AND KASHMIR MUNICIPAL ACT, 2000

- 11. Construction of reference of certain expressions by certain other expressions.— Throughout the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Act, 2000 (Jammu and Kashmir Act XX of 2000) (hereafter in this Chapter referred to as the Municipal Act), for the words "Chief Electoral Officer" and "Backward Classes", wherever they occur, the words "State Election Commission" and "Other Backward Classes" shall respectively be substituted.
- **12.** Amendment of section 2. In section 2 of the Municipal Act,—
  - (a) clause (1) shall be omitted;
  - (b) after clause (27), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—
  - '(27a) "Other Backward Classes" means the Other Backward Classes declared by the Government of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir from time to time in accordance with sub-clause (iii) of clause (o) of section 2 of the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 (Jammu and Kashmir Act XIV of 2004);';
  - (c) after clause (29b), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—
    - '(29bb) "State Election Commission" means the Commission constituted under section 36 of the Jammu and Kashmir Panchayati Raj Act, 1989 (Jammu and Kashmir Act IX of 1989);'.

### 13. Amendment of section 11A.— In section 11A of the Municipal Act,—

- (a) in sub-section (1), for the words "the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes", the words "the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes" shall be substituted;
- (b) in sub-section (2), for the words "the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes", the words "the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes or the Other Backward Classes" shall be substituted;
- (c) in sub-section (3), for the words "the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes", the words "the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes" shall be substituted;
- (d) in sub-section (3A), for the words "Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe Certificate", the words "Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe or Other Backward Class Certificate" shall be substituted; and;

  - (i) require any person, including an officer or an employee of the Government of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, subject to any privilege which may be claimed by that person under any law for the time being in force in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, to furnish information on any matter which, in the opinion of the Commission, may be useful for or relevant to the subject of enquiry;
  - (ii) by order, give such directions to the officers and employees of the Government of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, or any other statutory body or society as it considers necessary to ensure smooth and efficient conduct of elections under this Act;

- (iii) by order, delegate, subject to such restrictions mentioned therein, any of its powers to such officers and employees of the Government of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir;
- (iv) determine and delimit the municipalities in accordance with the provisions of this Act;
- (v) regulate its own procedure, including the fixing of time and place of its sittings; and
- (vi) exercise such other powers as may be determined by the Government of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir, from time to time.".
- **15. Insertion of new section 282A.** After section 282 of the Municipal Act, the following section shall be inserted, namely:—
  - "282A. Application of certain provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Panchayati Raj Act, 1989.—Sections 36, 36A, 36B, 36C, 37 and section 39 of the Panchayati Raj Act [as amended by the Jammu and Kashmir Local Bodies Laws (Amendment) Act, 2024] shall, *mutatis mutandis*, apply to this Act.".

### **CHAPTER IV**

- 16. - '(59a) "State Election Commission" means the Commission constituted under section 36 of the Jammu and Kashmir Panchayati Raj Act, 1989 (Jammu and Kashmir Act IX of 1989).'
- **18. Insertion of new section 9A.**—After section 9 of the Municipal Corporation Act, the following section shall be inserted, namely:—
  - "9A. Application of certain provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Panchayati Raj Act, 1989 and Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Act, 2000.—Sections 36, 36A, 36B, 36C, 37 and section 39 of the Panchayati Raj Act and sub-section (2) of section 282 of the Municipal Act [as amended by the Jammu and Kashmir Local Bodies Laws (Amendment) Act, 2024] shall, *mutatis mutandis*, apply to this Act.".
- **19. Amendment of section 10A.**—In section 10A of the Municipal Corporation Act,—
  - (a) in sub-section (1), for the words "the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes", the words "the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Other Backward Classes" shall be substituted;

SO-588.ô -Whereas, on 15-09-2013, the Police Station, Sadder, received a docket to the effect that on a reliable information, a Joint Patrolling was carried out in Rambagh area, and during the Patrolling two suspects while seeing the Police Party tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Irfan Hussain Shah

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 176/2013 under Secton 7/25 Arms Act was registered in the Police Station, Sadder, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Sections 13, 18, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Irfan Hussain Shah and Showket Ahmad Sheikh, procured some arms/ammunition and incriminatory material from one Mohammad Amin Ellahi S/o Wali mohammad Ellahi R/o Mochwa, Chanpora, Budgam, in order to promote terrorist activities in the area. Subsequently, the said accused was also arrested in the case. During the investigation, arms/ammunition and incriminatory material viz. 01 AK 47 Rifle, 02 Magazines, 60 Rounds, 01 Pistol with Magazine, 20 Rounds and 04 Letter Pads of HM, a banned outfit, were recovered at the instances of accused viz. Irfan Hussain Shah and Showket Ahmad Sheikh, respectively; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Irfan Hussaain Shah and Showket Ahmad Sheikh, after procuring arms/ammunition from the accused viz. Mohammad Amin Ellahi, attacked upon a BSF vehicle at Chanpora, Bypass, which resulted death of one BSF Jawan and injuries to other, for which a separate case FIR No. 49/2013 stands registered in Police Station, Sadder, Srinagar; and
- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Irfan Hussain Shah, Shoket Ahmed Sheikh and Mohammad Amin Ellahi, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of HM, a vanned outfit, and under a well knit criminal

Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence colected, the Investigation Officer, has established *Prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their name :ô
