SO6108.& Whereas, on 21-09-2023, a reliable information was received by the Police Station, Litter, to the effect that one person identified as Ashiq Bashir Khan S/o Bashir Ahmad Khan R/o Khan Mohalla, Niloora, Pulwama, had uploaded a video of terrorists of TRF, a banned outfit, on social media in order to provoke/instigate the general public against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of India ; and

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary, File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Ashiq Bashir Khan for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 13 and 39 of ULA(P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 98/2023 of Police Station, Litter.
