Jammu, the 1st March, 2024.

SO-142.66-Whereas, on 21-09-2023, a reliable information was received by the police Station, Baramulla, to the effect that one person identified as Mohammad Yaseen Shah S/o Tariq Ahmad Shah R/o Shah Mohalla, Janbazpora, Baramulla as joined the terrorist ranks of LeT/ TRF, banned outfit, in order to carry out terrorist activities in the area ; and

R/o Wagila, Wagoora, Kreeri, Baramulla and Mudasir Mohi-ud-Din Rather S/o Gh. Mohi-ud-Din Rather R/o Takiya, Wagoora, Kreeri, Baramulla, were found involved in the case. Subsequently, the accused were arrested and during the investigation, 01 Pistol with magazine, 08 rounds and 05 hand grenades were recovered at their instances respectively ; and

8. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Mohammad Yaseen Shah, procured arms/ammunition and hand grenades from the terrorist viz. Umar Lone, on the direction of Pakistani terrorist viz. Syed Aijaz Rizwi @ Javid, and distributed among the accused viz. Parvaiz Ahmad Shah, Mst. Nageena, Mst. Aafreena, Showkat Ahmad Malik and Mudasir Mohi-ud-Din Rather, in order to promote terrorist activities in the area, which were recovered at their instances. During the investigation, 01 Pistol with magazine and 08 rounds were also recovered at the instance of accused viz. Mohammad Yaseen Shah ; and

9. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Mohammad Yaseen Khan, was member of LeT /TRF banned outfit and the accused viz. Parvaiz Ahmad Shah, Mst. Nageena, Mst. Aafreena, Showkat Ahmad Malik and Mudasir Mohi-ud-Din Rather, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists particularly the terrorist viz. Mohammad Yaseen Shah, and were providing logistic support to him, besides, the accused viz. Mohammad Yaseen Shah, procured arms/ammunition and hand grenades from the terrorists viz. Syed Aijaz Rizwi @ Javid and Umar Lone, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy distributed among the accused viz. Parvaiz Ahmad Shah, Mst. Nageena, Mst. Aafreena, Showkat Ahmad Malik and Mudasir Mohi-ud-Din Rather, for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

10. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of Pakistani prisoner viz. Imdaullah @ Ali Babar @ Dujana, shall continue to bring out his role/ involvement in the case and the supplementary charge sheet against him would be filed in the court of competent jurisdiction ; and

11. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating

13. Whereas, the accused terrorist viz. Syed Aijaz Rizwi @ Javid and Umar Lone, are absconding and proceedings under Section 299 Cr.PC have been proposed to be initiated against them ; and

14. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

15. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary file, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mohammad Yaseen Shah, Parvaiz Ahmad Shah, Mst. Nageena, Mst. Aafreena, Showkat Ahmad Malik, Syed Aijaz Rizwi @ Javid and Umar Lone, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against the each accused at Para (11) above, arising out of FIR No. 194/2023 of Police Station, Baramulla.
