Notification

Jammu, the 15th March, 2024.

SO-173. Whereas, on 26.09.2023, the Police Station, Beerwah, received a docket to the effect that a reliable information was received about the presence of one hybrid terrorist in village Eidgah Mohalla, Beerwah, identified as Azim Bashir Wani S/o Bashir Ahmad Wani R/o Eidgah Mohalla, Beerwah. Subsequently, a Joint Cordon and Search Operation was launched by the Police/Security Forces in the

said village. During the search, the Police recovered 03 Pistols, 06
magazines, 73 rounds and some incriminatory material from the
residential house of accused viz. Azim Bashir Wani ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 125/2023 under
Sections 7/25 Arms Act 13, 23 and 38 of ULA (P) Act, was registered
in the Police Station, Beerwah, and the investigation, of the case was
set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under
Sections 18 and 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of
the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and
the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances
of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Azim Bashir
Wani, was arrested in the case and it was found that accused along with
one Saim-Bin Nayeem S/o Nayeem Ahmad Banday R/o Eidgah,
Mohalla, Beerwah, were working as hybrid terrorists for the terrorist
organization of LeT, a banned outfit, and were in contact with some
unknown terrorists through virtual mode who provided arms/ammunition
and incriminatory material to them in order to promote terrorist activities
in the area. Subsequently, the accused viz. Saim-Bin Nayeem, was also
arrested in the case and during the investigation, 01 Pistol with magazine
and 07 rounds were recovered at his instance ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, two other persons identified
as Hanan Javid Banday S/o Javid Ahmad Banday R/o Yousuf-Abad,
Beerwah and Shabir Ahmad Ganie S/o Ali Mohd Ganie R/o Sadipora,
Beerwah, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently,
the accused were arrested in the case and during the investigation, 08
Pistol rounds and 10 blank posters of LeT, a banned outfit, were
recovered at their instance respectively ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the
accused viz. Azim Bashir Wani and Saim-Bin Nayeem, were associated
with the terrorist organization of LeT, a banned outfit and the accused
viz. Hanan Javid Banday and Shabir Ahmad Ganie, were working as
Over Ground Workers for the terrorists and were providing logistic
support to them, besides, the accused viz. Azim Bashir Wani, Saim-Bin
Nayeem, Hanan Javid Banday and Shabir Ahmad Ganie, under a well

 knit criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition and incriminatory material from some unknown terrorists for carrying out the terrorist/unlawful activities in the area ; and

7. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of unknown terrorists who provided the recovered arms/ ammunition and incriminatory material to the accused viz. Azim Bashir Wani, Saim-Bin Nayeem, Hanan Javid Banday and Shabir Ahmad Ganie, shall continue to ascertain their actual identity and to bring out their role/involvement in the case and the Supplementary Charge Sheet against them would be filed in the Court of Competent jurisdiction ; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :ô

9. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Saim-Bin Nayeem, has been found juvenile and in view of the Section 1(4) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Child) Act, 2015, the apprehension, detention, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act ; and
