

in the area. Subsequently, a Naka was established by the Police at Tanga Adda, Bagiyas, Srinagar. During the checking, the Naka Party intercepted a vehicle (Wagon-R) and on personal search of the driver identified as Umer Khan S/o Gh. Nabi Khan R/o Kalamdanpora, Nawa Bazar, Maharaj Gunj, Srinagar, the police recovered 01 Pitol with Magazine, 12 Rounds and cash to the tune of Rs. 17000/- Indian currency from his possession; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 156/2023 under Section 7/25 Arms Act, and Sections 13, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Safakadal, and the investigation of the case was set into motion ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of the witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Umer Khan, was in contact with some unknown Pakistani based terrorists of LeT, a benned outfit, through virtual mode, who provided the recovered arms/ammunition to him through some unknown persons in order to promote terrorist activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was estavblished that accused viz. Umer Khan, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit and was providing logistic support to them, besides, procured arms/ammunition from the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of unknown terrorists who provided the arms/ammunition to the accused viz. Umer Khan, shall continue to ascertain their identified and to bring out their role/involvement in the area and the supplementary charge sheet against them would be filed in the Court of Competent Jurisdiction ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below

mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :

Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Dairy File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Umer Khan, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 23 and 39 of ULA(P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 156/2023 of Police Station, Safakadal..
