was registered in the Police Station Mahore, and the investigation, of  
the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the  
offence under Section 2/3 ESA was dropped and the Section 122,201  
IPC, 13,16,17,18-B and 40 of ULA (P) Act and Section 4,5 and 6 of  
ESA were added in the case; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the  
place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the  
statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances  
of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

4. Whereas during the investigation, the accused viz. Talib Hussain  
Shah and Faisal Bashir Dar, were found in contact with two terrorists  
of LeT, a banned outfit, namely, Mohd Qasim @ Salman S/o Mohd Shafi  
R/o Angralla, Mahore A/P Pok/Pakistan and Zia-ul-Rehman Malik  
S/o Abdul Gafoor Malik R/o Samote, Budhal A/P Pok/Pakistan. The  
accused viz Mohd Qasim @ Salman, motivated/recruited the accused  
viz. Talib Hussain Shah, to join the outfit and sent arms/ammunition and  
an amount of Rs. 12.50 lakhs to him through drone for further  
distribution among the terrorists in order to promote terrorist activities  
in the area and the accused terrorist viz. Talib Hussain Shah, was  
facilitated by two persons identified as Mohd Shabir and Mohd Sadiq,  
to receive and conceal the said arms/ammunition in the forests.  
Subsequently, during investigation, 01 Pistol, 03 magazines, 01 UBGL  
launcher, 03 UBGL grenades, 75 AK rounds, 15 pistol rounds, 04 Pistol  
30 Bore rounds, 01 IED remote and 06 Stick Bombs, were recovered  
from the forests at Draji Kotrenka, Rajouri, at the instances of accused  
viz Talib Hussain Shah; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused  
viz. Faisal Bashir Dar, was instigated/motivated by the accused viz, Talib  
Hussain Shah and Mohd Qasim @ Salman, to join the outfit and provided  
arms/ammunition to him for carrying out the terrorist activities. During  
investigation an amount of Rs. 50,000/- was also recovered from one  
Fazul-ul-Rehman Malik (brother of accused terrorist Zia-ul-Rehman  
Malik) which were handed over to him by the terrorist viz, Talib Hussain  
Shah; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the  
accused viz. Talib Hussain Shah and Faisal Bashir Dar, were members  
of LeT, a banned outfit and under a well knit criminal conspiracy  
collected arms/ammunition and explosive material from the Pakistani  
based terrorists viz. Mohd Qasim @ Salman and Zia-ul-Rehman Malik,  
in order to carry out the terrorist activities and to wage war against
