registered in the Police Station, Beerwah, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Section 20 and 38 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Mohd. Younis Dar, Syed Jhangir Shah and Irfan Ahmad Wagay, were found in contact with the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit and were working for them in order to promote terrorist activities in the area. The accused viz. Mohd. Younis Dar and Irfan Ahmad Wagay, procured the recovered AK ammunition and posters from an unknown terrorist at Chadoora and the accused viz. Syed Jahangir Shah, procured the hand grenade from the terrorist namely Syed Farooq Ahmad Shah @ Feroz Molvi S/o Syed Amin Shah R/o Chewdara, Beerwah; and

5. Whereas during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Mohd Younis Dar, Syed Jhangir Shah and Irfan Ahmad Wagay, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, particularly the terrorist viz. Syed Farooq Ahmad Shah @ Feroz Molvi, and were providing logistic support to them, beside under a well knit criminal conspiracy procured the recovered AK ammunition/hand grenade and incriminatory material from the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist/unlawful activities in the area; and

6. Whereas, the accused terrorist viz. Syed Farooq Ahmad Shah @ Feroz Molvi, has been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against him; and

7. Whereas, the investigation in respect of unknown terrorist who provided the AK ammunition and posters to the accused viz. Mohd. Younis Dar and Irfan Ahmad Wagay, shall continue to ascertain his identity and to bring out his/involvement in the case and the

 Supplementary Charge Sheet against him would be filed in the Court of competent jurisdiction; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :-

9. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act,1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and

10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now therefore,in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activites (Prevention) Act,1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mohd. Younis Dar, Syed Jahangir Shah and Irfan Ahmad Wagay, for the commission of offences punishable under
