SO-322.& Whereas, on 11-12-2023, the Police Station, Bijbehara, received a docket to the effect that a Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Jablipora, Bijbehara. During the checking two suspects while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Mohd Altaf Bhat S/o Ghulam Rasool Bhat R/o Semthen, Bijbehara and Shabir Ahmad Mir S/o Mohammad Ismail Mir R/o Kuchmulla, Pulwama. During the search, the Police recovered 01 Pistol, 02 magazines, 30 rounds, 02 metallic IEDs and 10 detonators from the bags carrying by the accused ; and

Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mohd Altaf Bhat and Shabir Ahmad Mir, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 18, 23 and 38 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 284/2023 of Police Station, Bijbehara.
