SO6331.ô Whereas, on 22-02-2024 an information was received by the Police Station Qaimoh, to the effect that two persons identified as Zahoor Ahmad Pandit S/o Ab. Gani Pandit and Bashir Hussain Pandit S/o Farooq Ahmad Pandit residents of Wanpoh, Qaimoh, have been working as OGWs for the terrorists of LeT/TRF banned outfits and are providing logistic support to them for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

 terrorist viz. Firdous Ahmad Bhat, and were providing logistic support to him, besides, under a well knit criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition from the said terrorist for carrying out terrorist activities in the area ; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names:

9. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Firdous Ahmad Bhat is absconding and proceeding under Section 299 Cr. PC have been proposed to be initiated against him ; and

10. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Zahoor Ahmad Pandit, Bashir Hussan Pandit, Gulzar Ahmad Khar, Imtiyaz Gull and Firdous Ahmad Bhat, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against the each accused at Para (8) above, arising out of FIR No. 14/2024 of Police Station Qaimoh.
