### Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.

Srinagar, the 2nd of July, 2024.

SO—353.—Whereas on 12-01-2014, the Police Station, Keran, received a docket to the effect that a Joint Patrolling was conducted by the Police/Security Forces in the general area of Keran. During patrolling

two suspects while seeing the patrolling party at Peer Baba Shrine near Krishan Ganga River, Keran, tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Sayyad Ahmad Khan S/o Mohammad Afzal Khan R/o Keran Bala, Kupwara and Rifaqat Ahmad Khan S/o Naseer Ahmad Khan R/o Dader, Kundiyan, Keran Kupwara. During their personal search, the Police recovered 01 AK-47 rifle, 01 Pistol with magazine and 05 rounds from their possession respectively; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 02/2024 under section 7/25 Arms Act and Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Keran, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Section 120-B IPC and Sections 18,20,23,38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and

3. Whereas during the course of investigation the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of Law; and

4. Whereas during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Sayyad Ahmad Khan and Rifaqat Ahmad Khan, were in contact with a Pakistani based terrorist of LeT, a banned outfit, namely Basharat Ahmad Khan S/o Shabir Ahmad Khan R/o Keran A/P PoK/PaK, through virtual mode, who provided the recovered arms/ammunition to the accused viz. Sayyad Ahmad Khan and Rifaqat Ahmad Khan, in order to promote terrorist activities in the area; and

5. Whereas during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Sayyad Ahmad Khan and Rifaqat Ahmad Khan, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists particularly the Pakistani based terrorist viz. Basharat Ahmad Khan, and were providing logistic support to him besides, under a well knit criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition from the said terrorist for carrying out the terrorist/unlawful activities in the area; and

6. Whereas during the investigation the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a prima facie involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections

of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names:-

7. Whereas the accused terrorist viz. Basharat Ahmad Khan, is absconding and the proceedings under section 299 Cr.PC have been proposed to be initiated against him; and

8. Whereas the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and

9. Whereas after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Sayyad Ahmad Khan, Rafaqat Ahmad Khan and Basharat Ahmad Khan, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against each accused at Para (6) above, arising out of FIR No.02/2024 of Police Station, Keran.
