Srinagar, the 24th July, 2024.

SO-372. Whereas, on 03-03-2024, the Police Station M.R. Gunj, received a docket to the effect that a Naka was established by the Police

at Shah Mohalla Bund, Nawabazar, Srinagar. During the checking, three  
suspects while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but were chased  
down on the spot and identified as Arsalan Altaf Bhat S/o Mohammad  
Altaf Bhat R/o Sheedgunj, Srinagar, Salman Farooq Dar S/o Farooq  
Ahmad Dar R/o Bagawanpora, Noorbagh, Srinagar and Moomin Mehraj  
Sofi S/o Mehraj Din Sofi R/o Rathpora, Edgah, Srinagar. During their  
personal search, the Police recovered 02 badges, 07 posters and 01 flag  
of ISJK outfit from their possession respectively ; and

2.Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No.11/2024under  
Sections13 and 39 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in the Police Station  
M.R. Gunj, and the investigation of the case was set into motion ; and

3.Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the  
place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the  
statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of  
the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

4.Whereas, during the investigation, two more persons identified as  
Adil Ayoub Sofi S/o Mohammad Ayoub Sofi R/o Rathpora, Eidgah,  
Srinagar and Kaiser Altaf Hakeem S/o Mohammad Altaf Hakeem R/o  
Nawabazar, Srinagar were found involved in the case. Subsequently, the  
accused were arrested and during the investigation some incriminatory  
material were also recovered at their instance ; and

5.Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused  
viz. Arsalan Altaf Bhat,was in contact with an unknown person through  
virtual mode, who provide the recovered posters and flag to the accused  
viz. Arsalan Altaf Bhat, with the directions to distribute the same among  
other accused viz. Salman Farooq Dar, Moomin Mehraj Sofi, Adil  
Ayoub Sofi and Kaise Altaf Hakeem, in order topaste the same in the  
area for promotion of unlawful Activities ; and

6. Whereas,during the investigation,it was established that the accused viz. Arsalan Altaf Bhat, Salman Farooq Dar, Moomin Mehraj Sofi, Adil Sofi and Kaiser Altaf Hakeem, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorist organization of ISJK outfit and were providing logistic support to them, besides, procured incriminatory material from the terrorist for carrying out the unlawful activities in the area; and

7. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of unknown person who provided the incriminatory material to the accused viz. Arsalan Altaf Bhat, shall continue to ascertainis actual identity and to bring out his role/involvement in the case and the Supplementary Charge Sheet against him would be filed in the court of competent jurisdiction ; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and the other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for the commission of the offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967,as shown against theirnames:ô

9. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the

other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the  
conclusion that *aprima facie* case is made out against the above accused ;  
and

10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Arsalan Altaf Bhat, Salman Farooq Dar, Moomin Mehraj Sofi, Adil Ayoub Sofi and Kaiser Altaf Hakeem, for the commission of offences punishable under 13 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 11/2024 of Police Station, M.R. Gunj.
