**Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.**

Srinagar, the 9th August, 2024.

SO-389.—Whereas, on 08-02-2024, a written application was received by P/S Songam from a person namely Mohammad Arif Reshi S/o Gh. Rasool R/o Rakhi Gundimancher, Lolab to the effect that on 07-02-2024. his daughter left home to purchase some items from the market and did not return till late in the evening. During the search it

came to be learnt that she had been kidnapped by an unknown person who had kept her at some unknown place ; and

2. Whereas, on receipt of information, a FIR No. 04/2024 Under Sections 363 IPC came to be registered in the Police Station, Sogam and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation the offence under section 363 IPC was dropped and 83 JJ Act, 13, 18, 39 of ULA (P) Act, were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it came to the fore that the above-named girl was kidnapped by Imtiyaz Ahmad Dar S/o Ab. Khaliq Dar R/o Pohno, Shopian and was later recovered from his residential house. Her medical examination was done by the Investigating Officer and the Date of Birth Certificate of the girl was obtained. As per the DOB certificate, the victim was found minor and her statement was recorded under section 164 Cr. PC. ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was revealed that the abductee girl had come in contact with accused Imtiyaz Ahmad Dar through virtual mode who motivated her to work for terrorists. The accused Imtiyaz Ahmad Dar was arrested and the role of another lady namely Jamsheeda Ramzan D/o Mohammad Ramzan Sheikh R/o Mughalpora, Khaipora came to the fore who too was arrested ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was revealed that the accused viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Dar, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of banned HM outfit and in furtherance of the conspiracy with Jamsheeda Ramzan had close contacts with a PoK-based unknown terrorist through virtual mode and was providing logistic/ other support to the terrorists for promotion of terrorism in the area ; and

7. Whereas, the identity of the unknown terrorist is yet to be ascertained and the investigation shall continue and Supplementary Charge Sheet would be filed in the Court of law ; and

8. Whereas, the investigation conducted by the investigating agency has *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Dar. was Working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of banned HM outfit and in furtherance of conspiracy with Jamsheeda Ramzan were promoting unlawful activities ; and

9. Whereas on the strength of evidence collected and the statement of witnesses recorded, the Investigating Officer has established a *prima facie* case against the below-mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against their names :—

10. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution, under provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against

the accused viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Dar and Jamsheeda Ramzan, for the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each at para (9) above, of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 04/2024 of Police Station, Sogam.
