Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.

Notification

Jammu, the 1st January, 2024.

SO-4.ô Whereas, on 22-10-2017, a reliable information was received by the Police Station, Kulgam, to the effect that terrorists identified as Altaf Ahmad Kachroo R/o Hawoora, Tawseef Sheikh

R/o Rampora, Rameez Dar R/o Hawoora, Farhan Wani R/o Wanigund
and Javaid Bhat R/o Ghat, on the directions of their self styled
commanders namely Syed Salahuddin and Riyaz Ahmad Naikoo, forcibly
entered in the residential house of one Farooq Ahmad Rather S/o
Mohammad Abdullah Rather R/o Ashmuji, Kuglam, with intention to
kill him, and the terrorists caused damage to his residential house,
besides, harassed his family members in order to create terror among
the general public. The terrorists after the commission of crime fired
some gun shots in air and escaped from the spot ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 183/2017 under
Sections 307, 452, 427 RPC, 7/25 Arms Act and Sections 13 (2), 16,
18, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station,
Kulgam, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion.
Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Section 7/25
Arms Act was dropped and Section 7/27 Arms Act was added in the
case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of
the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and
the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances
of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused
viz. Rameez Ahmad Dar S/o Abdul Rahman Dar R/o Hawoora,
Mishipora, Kulgam, was arrested by Kulgam Police in case FIR
No. 04/2022 of Police Station, Qaimoh, and is presently facing trial in
the said case. During the investigation, no person of the name of Javaid
Ahmad R/o Ghat, was found residing in the said village and accordingly,
the instant name was dropped from the case ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, one more person identified
as Bilal Ahmad Bhat S/o Mohammad Amin Bhat R/o Katrasoo, Kulgam,
was found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the
accused was also arrested in the case ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused
viz. Rameez Ahmad Dar and Bilal Ahmad Bhat, were in contact with
the terrorists of HM, a banned outfit, namely Mohd Altaf Dar @

 Kachroo S/o Gh. Mohd Dar R/o Hawoora, Mishipora, Kuglam, Tawseef
 Ahmad Sheikh S/o Ab. Salam Sheikh R/o Rampora, Qaimoh, Kulgam
 and Farhan Ahmad Wani S/o Gh. Mohd Wani R/o Redwani, Kulgam,
 and were working for them, in order to promote terrorist activities in
 the area ; and

7. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the
 accused viz. Rameez Ahmad Dar and Bilal Ahmad Bhat, were working
 as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of HM, a banned
 outfit, particularly the terrorists viz. Mohd Altaf Dar @ Kachroo,
 Tawseef Ahmad Sheikh and Farhan Ahmad Wani, and were providing
 logistic support to them, besides, on the date of occurrence under a
 well knit criminal conspiracy facilitated the said terrorists to carrying
 out the attack upon Farooq Ahmad Rather and his family members
 in order to create terror among the general public ; and

8. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Mohd Altaf Dar @
 Kachroo, Tawseef Ahmad Sheikh and Farhan Ahmad Wani, have has
 been killed in the different encounters with the Security Forces and
 the proceedings under the law would abate against them ; and

9. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of
 witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating
 Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below
 mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under
 Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown
 against their names :

10. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under
 Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)

Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all
the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to
the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above
accused ; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant
documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority
appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities
(Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is
sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned
accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section
(2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the
Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against
the accused *vrz.* Rameez Ahmad Dar and Bilal Ahmad Bhat, for the
commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 18 and 39 of
ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 183/2017 of Police Station, Kulgam.
