Srinagar, the 23th August, 2024.

SO-423.—Whereas, on 29-02-2024 information was received at Police Station, Lalpora to the effect that 02 persons namely Parvaiz Ahmad Bhat @ Pervaiz Molvi S/o Mohammad Abdullah Bhat R/o Mandalpora Lalpora and Hilal Ahmad Dar S/o Late Ab. Ahad Dar R/o Cheerkote hatching a conspiracy with PoK-based terrorist handler namely Rayaz Ahmad R/o Bandipora A/P PoK with the intention to

carry out terrorist activities in the valley, besides the duo is instigating the youth to join militant ranks and are advocating for the separation of J&K from the Union of India ; and

2. Whereas, on receipt of information, a Case FIR No. 04/2024 under Senctions 13, 18, 18-B and 20 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Lalpora and the investigation of the case was set in to motion. Subsequently, during the Investigation, the offence under Section 18-B of ULA (P) Act was dropped and Sections 38, 39 of ULA (P) Act, were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused namely Parvaiz Ahmad Bhat and Hilal Ahmad Dar were arrested and it was established that they were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists and were in close contact with PoK-based terrorist handler namely Reyaz Ahmad whose particulars were identified as Jan Mohd Sontra @ Reyaz Ahmad S/o Shair Ahmad Sontra R/o Malangam Bandipora A/P PoK through virtual mode. All three accused were found working closely to promote unlawful and terrorist activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, on the strength of evidence collected and the statements of witnesses recorded, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* case against the below-mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against their names :—

6. Whereas, the accused namely Jan Mohd Sontra @ Reyaz Ahmad, is absconding and proceedings under Section 299 Cr.PC have been initiated against him ; and

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Parvaiz Ahmad Bhat, @ Parvaiz Molvi, Hilal Ahmad Dar and Jan Mohd Sontra @ Reyaz Ahmad for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against the each accused at Para (5) above, arising out of FIR No. 04/2024 Police Station, Lalpora.
