### Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.

Notification

Srinagar, the 29th of August, 2024.

SO—433.— Whereas on 18-03-2024, an information was received at Police Station, Shaheedgunj, to the effect that some unknown terrorists of banned TRF outfit have posted a threat message on social media

against the BLOs/other officials associated with the upcoming parliamentary elections. It was revealed that a list was also uploaded on social media with the intention to refrain these employees to be part of the said election ; and

2. Whereas, on receipt of information. FIR No. 11/2024 under section 506 IPC, 13 of ULA (P) Act came to be registered in the Police Station, Shaheedgunj, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during investigation, the offence under sections 18,20,38,39,40 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas during the course of the investigation the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded ; and

4. Whereas during the investigation, 02 persons namely Mohammad Manan Dar S/o Gulzar Ahmad Dar R/o Firdousabad, Batamaloo and Adnan Bashir Bangroo S/o Bashir Ahmad Bangroo R/o Batamaloo, were found involved in the Commission of crime. The accused were arrested and during the investigation, 39 posters of TRF, a banned outfit and cash of Rs. 100,000/- (Rupee one lac) was recovered at their instance respectively; and

5. Whereas during the investigation, it was found that the accused Mohammad Manan Dar and Adnan Bashir Bangroo were in close contact with PaK based handler through virtual mode who provided the recovered posters and cash to the accused through an unknown person and investigation also revealed that accused Mohammad Manan Dar with assistance of Adnan Bashir Bangroo, on the directions of PaK handler had to hand over the said amount to an active terrorist namely Momin Gulzar S/o Gulzar Ahmad Mir R/o Eidgah Srinagar, for promotion of terrorism in the area ; and

6. Whereas, the investigation in respect of accused who uploaded threat posters on social media and the unknown persons who handed over the posters and cash to accused Mohammad Manan Dar and Adnan Bashir Bangroo, shall continue, and supplementary charge-sheet could be filed in the court of law ; and

7. Whereas, the investigation conducted by the Police Station Shaheedgunj has *prima facie* established that accused Mohammad

Manan Dar and Adnan Bashir Bangroo, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of banned TRF outfit particularly Momin Gulzar and have in furtherance of conspiracy have committed the activities declared unlawful under UAP Act ; and

8. Whereas, the accused terrorist Momin Gulzar, got killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and proceedings against him would abate ; and

9. Whereas, on the strength of evidence collected and the statement of witnesses recorded, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* case against the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names:—

10. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act,

1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mohammad Manan Dar and Adnan Bashir Bangroo, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13,18,39,40 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 11/2024 of Police Station, Shaheedgunj.
