## PART I—B

### Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.

GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR

Notification

Srinagar, the 10th of September, 2024.

SO—465.— Whereas on 23-03-2024, an information was received by Police Station, Kulgam, to the effect that OGWs of proscribed terrorist organizations operating within J&K and across the LOC are

channeling funds to separatist organizations for promoting terrorism. One Sajad Ahmad Mir S/o Gulam Mohammad Mir R/o Tengbal, Kulgam, acting under the directions of Manzoor Ahmad Shah of Kupwara (operating from Pakistan), collected and raised a substantial amount of cash to the tune of around 40 to 50 lakh INR in the recent past and distributed among the terrorists and their sympathizers to promote and launch a secessionist campaign against the territorial integrity and sovereignty of the India; and

2. Whereas, on receipt of information, Case FIR No. 33/2024 under Sections 13,18,39,40 of ULA (P) Act, 124A, 124B IPC was registered in the Police Station, Kulgam, and investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during investigation, the offence under Section 18 of ULA (P) Act, 124A, 124B IPC was dropped and Sections 120-B, 506 IPC, 20 ULA(P) Act, were added in the case; and

3. Whereas during the course of the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded; and

4. Whereas during the investigation, it was found that the accused namely, Manzoor Ahmad Shah S/o Ghulam Ahmad Shah R/o Salkoot, Kupwara A/P Pakistan based Kashmiri terrorist of Jamait-ul-Mujahideen, a proscribed terrorist organization, who hatched a criminal conspiracy with the accused viz. Sajad Ahmad Mir, to radicalize Youth of J&K through a proxy organization named Itihad-i-Islami, to gather public support, by delivering sermons and speeches on social evils and after getting the support, use the same organization in propagating, advocating and supporting terrorism and secessionist activities in J&K; and

5. Whereas the accused namely, Manzoor Ahmad Shah through Sajad Ahmad Mir coaxed a considerable number of Muslim clerics of J&K for joining Itihad-i-Islami and was successful in motivating Molvis namely, Mohammad Iqbal Sheikh S/o Mohammad Shaban Sheikh R/o Nathpora, Khanbal, Anantnag and Manzoor Ahmad Mir of Tengbal, Kulgam to propagate secessionism and express support to terrorists by exploiting religious sermons in the mosques; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established the accused viz. Manzoor Ahmad Shah, was to create an undercurrent and conducive atmosphere, whereby youth of J&K would be radicalized and also to

ensure acceptance of terrorists within general masses for logistic support, and also provided money to several religious clerics through the accused viz. Sajad Ahmad Mir and Mohammad Iqbal Sheikh for carrying on the task of disseminating anti-Indian content and to garner support for terrorist activities in J&K; and

7. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of Manzoor Ahmad Mir of Tengbal, Kulgam and other suspects shall continue and supplementary charge sheet under Section 173 (8) Cr.PC against them would be filed in the court of competent jurisdiction; and

8. Whereas, on the strength of evidence collected and the statements of witnesses recorded, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* case against the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names:-

9. Whereas, the accused namely, Manzoor Ahmad Shah, is absconding and proceedings under Section 299 Cr.PC have been proposed to be initiated against him; and

10. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Manzoor Ahmad Shah, Sajad Ahmad Mir and Mohammad Iqbal Sheikh, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Section of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against the each accused at para (8) above, arising out of FIR No. 33/2024 of Police Station, Kulgam.
