Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.

Notification

Srinagar, the 27th September, 2024.

SO—486.—Whereas, on 27-05-2024 a written docket was received at Police Station Mattan, to the effect that a Naka was established by the Police in collaboration with the Security Forces at Mulsoo, K.P. Road, Mattan. During checking a Baleno car was intercepted and two persons boarded in the vehicle tried to flee from the spot but were tactfully apprehended. The persons were identified as Waseem Ahmad

Shah S/o Ab. Gani Shah R/o Nambal Mattan and Adnan Mohammad Beigh S/o Gh. Mohammad Beigh R/o S.K. Colony, Anchidora, Anantnag. On being searched, 01 Pistol with a magazine, 08 rounds and 01 Hand Grenade were recovered from their possession respectively, besides 120 rounds of AK were recovered from the vehicle ; and

2. Whereas, on receipt of information, Case FIR No. 57/2024 under sections 7/25 Arms Act, 13, 18 and 39 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Mattan, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Sections 5 ESA, 8/20, 29 NDPS Act and Sections 20, 23 and 38 of ULA(P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the involvement of other person namely Firdous Ahmad Bhat S/o Wali Mohammad Bhat R/o Hugam, Lonepora, came to the fore in the commission of crime and subsequently, was arrested in the case. During the investigation, 01 Pistol with Magazine and 03 rounds were also recovered at his instance ; and

5. Whereas, the investigation conducted by the investigating officer has *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Waseem Ahmad Shah, Adnan Mohammad Beigh and Firdous Ahmad Bhat were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists and were in close contact with 02 terrorists namely Omais Nisar Wani S/o Nisar Ahmad Wani R/o Chawalgam and Aquib Shergojri S/o Nazir Ahmad Shergojri R/o Khampora Chdoora, who provided the recovered arms/ammunition to them for promotion of terrorism in the area, besides, the accused Firdous Ahmad Bhat received a consignment of Narcotic from a PaK handler namely Ali Sajid Jatt R/o Pakistan. Subsequently, during the investigation 3.20 Kgs (narcotic like substance) was recovered at his instance. The accused was also facilitating the transportation of terrorists from one place to another for carrying out terrorist activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, on the strength of evidence collected and the statements of witnesses recorded, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* case against the below-mentioned accused

for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against their names :—

7. Whereas, the accused viz. Omais Nisar Wani, Aquib Shergojri and Ali Sajid Jatt, are absconding and proceedings under Section 299 Cr. PC. have been proposed to be initiated against them ; and

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967,

the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Waseem Ahmad Shah, Adnan Mohammad Beigh, Firdous Ahmad Bhat, Omais Nisar Wani, Aquib and Ali Sajid Jatt, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA(P) Act, as indicated against the each accused at Para (6) above, arising out of FIR No. 57/2024 of Police Station, Mattan.
