Notification

Srinagar, the 4th October, 2024.

SO-494.—Whereas, on 09-04-2024, a written docket from I/c Police Post, Warpora was received at Police Station, Sopore that a naka was established by Police in collaboration with 22 RRArmy and

179 Bn CRPF at Dangerpora. During the checking, a person was noticed in suspicious circumstances, who while seeing naka party tried to flee but was tactfully apprehended on the spot. The said person was identified as Ashiq Ahmad Kaboo S/o Ali Muhammad Kaboo R/o Arampora Sopore. On being searched, 64 rounds and a mobile phone were recovered from his possession ; and

2. Whereas based on the above, a Case FIR No. 80/2024 under sections 7/25 Arms Act, 13, 18, 23 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Sopore, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Section 39 ULA (P) Act was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, the involvement of four more persons namely, Mudasir Ahmad Kaboo S/o Ab. Khaliq Kaboo R/o Arampora Sopore, Sajad Ahmad Changa S/o Mohammad Sultan Changa R/o Yaseen Colony Sopore, Showkat Ahmad Rather S/o Mohammad Ramzan Rather and Shabir Ahmad Din S/o Abdul Rashid Din R's/o Arin Bandipora, came to fore in the commission of offence, who were subsequently arrested and during the investigation 03 hand grenades and 197 rounds were recovered at their instance respectively ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused namely Ashiq Ahmad Kaboo actual name Ashiq Ali Kaboo, Mudasir Ahmad Kaboo, Sajad Ahmad Changa, Showkat Ahmad Rather and Shabir Ahmad Din, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of banned LeT outfit and were in close contact with slain terrorist of LeT, a banned outfit, namely Usman, who provided the recovered grenades/ammunition to them for promotion of terrorism in the area. The investigation of the case shall continue and Supplementary Charge Sheet could be filed in the Court of law ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the

below-mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against their names :—

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents independent examme relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Ashiq Ali Kaboo, Mudasir Ahmad Kaboo, Sajad Ahmad

Changa, Showkat Ahmad Rather and Shabir Ahmad Din, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 18, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 80/2024 of Police Station, Sopore.
