Notification

Srinagar, the 15th of October, 2024.

SO—512.— Whereas on 25-04-2024, a written docket was received at Police Station, Uri to the effect that while on patrolling in the area a person was noticed in suspicious circumstances, who, while seeing naka

party tried to flee from the spot but were tactfully apprehended. The said person was identified as Mohammad Farooq Khokhar S/o Salam-Din Khokhar R/o Madiyan, Kamalkote. On being searched, 01 Pistol with 02 magazines and 20 rounds were recovered from his possession ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 31/2024 under Sections 120-B, IPC, 7/25 Arms Act and Sections 13, 18, 23, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in the Police Station, Uri, and the investigation, of the case was taken up ; and

3. Whereas during the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Mohammad Farooq Khokhar, was working as OGW for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, and was in close contact with a PoK based terrorist namely Nayeem Ahmad Sheikh S/o Karam Din Sheikh R/o Madiyan, Kamalkote A/P PoK through virtual mode, who provided the recovered arms/ammunition to him for promotion of terrorism in the area; and

5. Whereas the investigation conducted by the investigating agency has a *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Mohammad Farooq Khokhar, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, and in furtherance of criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition from the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area. The investigation, in respect of PoK based terrorist viz. Nayeem Ahmad Sheikh, shall continue and supplementary charge sheet against him would be filed in the competent court of law ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name:—

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)

Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mohammad Farooq Khokhar, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13,18,23,39 of ULA (P) Act arising out of FIR No. 31/2024 of Police Station, Uri.
