Notification

Srinagar, the 17th of October, 2024.

SO—514.— Whereas on 05-05-2024, a written docket was received at Police Station, Imamsahib to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police in collaboration with 178 Bn. CRPF and 34 RR

Army at Aloora. During the checking, two persons were noticed in suspicious circumstances, who while seeing Naka patry, tried to flee but were tactfully apprehended. The said persons were identified as Zaffar Azad S/o Azad Hussain Ganie and Amir Ahmad Mir S/o Zahoor Ahmad Mir residents of Mandujan, Shopian. On being searched, 01 Pistol with magazine 08 rounds and 02 hand grenades were recovered from their possession respectively ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 23/2024 under Sections 7/25 Arms Act and Sections 18, 23, and 39 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in the Police Station, Imamsahib, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Sections 20 and 38 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas during the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

4. Whereas during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Zaffar Azad and Amir Ahmad Mir, was working as OGWs for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, and were in close contact with a PoK based terrorist namely Abid Ramzan Sheikh S/o Mohd Ramzan Sheikh R/o Chotipora, Shopian, through virtual mode, who provided the recovered arms/ammunition and hand grenades to them for promotion of terrorism in the area. The role/involvement in respect of PoK handler is yet to be ascertained and investigation shall continue and the Supplementary Charge Sheet would be filed in the competent court of law ; and

5. Whereas the investigation conducted by the investigating agency has a *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Zaffar Azad and Amir Ahmad Mir, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, and in furtherance of criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition from the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area.; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under

Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names:-

7. Whereas, the accused viz. Zaffar Azad, has been found juvenile and in view of Section 1(4) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, the apprehension, detention, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act; and

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Amir Ahmad Mir, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 18,23,39 of ULA (P) Act arising out of FIR No. 23/2024 of Police Station, Imamsahib.
