Notification

Srinagar, the 17th of October, 2024.

SO—515.— Whereas on 15-05-2024, a written docket was received at Police Station, Kralpora, to the effect that a Naka was established by the Police in collaboration with 03 NAGA Army at Lone Harie,

Kralpora. During the checking a person was noticed in suspicious circumstances, who, while seeing naka party tried to flee from the spot but was tactfully apprehended. The said person was identified as Mushtaq Ahmad Lone S/o Ab. Rehman Lone R/o Patro Keran. On being searched, 01 hand grenade and a mobile phone were recovered from his possession ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 32/2024 under Sections 5 ESA and 13, 23 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in the Police Station, Kralpora, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Section 7/25 Arms Act and Section 18, 20, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas during the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

4. Whereas during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Mushtaq Ahmad Lone, was working as OGW for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, and was in close contact with a terrorist namely Mohammad Syed Lone S/o Abdul Rashid Lone R/o Muzaffarabad, PoK, through virtual mode, who provided some arms/ammunition and hand grenades to him in order to promote terrorist activities in the area. Subsequently, during the investigation, 02 Pistols, 02 Magazines, 54 Rounds and 09 Hand grenades were also recovered at his instance ; and

5. Whereas the investigation conducted by the investigating agency has a *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Mushtaq Ahmad Lone, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the PoK based terrorist namely, Mohammad Syed lone, and in furtherance of criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition and hand grenades from the said terrorist for further distribution among the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under

Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names:-

S.No.	Name of the accused	Offence
1.	Mushtaq Ahmad Lone S/o Ab. Rehman Lone R/o Patro Keran.	13,18,23,39 of ULA (P) Act.
2.	Mohammad Syed Lone S/o Abdul Rashid Lone R/o Muzaffarabad, PoK.	18,20,38 of ULA (P) Act.

7. Whereas, the accused viz. Mohammad Syed Lone, is absconding and proceeding under section 299 Cr.PC have been proposed to be initiated against him ; and

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mushtaq Ahmad Lone and Mohammad Syed Lone, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against the each accused at Para (6) above, arising out of FIR No. 32/2024 of Police Station, Kralpora.
