Srinagar, the 31st October, 2024.

SO-528.—Whereas, on 10.05.2024, a written docket was received at Police Station, Heerpora, to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police in collaboration with 14 Bn. CRPF and 44 RR Army at Malik Check crossing. During checking 02 persons were noticed in

suspicious circumstances, who while seeing the Naka Party tried to flee from the spot but were tactfully apprehended. The said persons were identified as Suhaib Iqbal Malik S/o Mohd Iqbal Malik and Tufail Yousuf Malik S/o Mohd Yousuf Malik residents of Baba Mohalla, Shopian. On being searched, 06 posters each of 'Lone Wolf Warriors and Al-Bark' outfits were recovered from their possession. The posters were meant to incite the public to boycott the Lok Sabha Elections, 2024 ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 14/2024 Under Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in the Police Station, Heerpora, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law and during investigation ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Suhaib Iqbal Malik and Tufail Yousuf Malik, procured the posters from an unknown masked person near Rajouri Sumo Stand, Shopian, with the directions to paste the posters in Village Malik Check, Shopian, in order to refrain the general public to participate in Lok Sabha elections and intended to cause disaffection against India ; and

5. Whereas on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and the other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under section of the provisions of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :—

6. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Dairy File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Suhaib Iqbal Malik and Tufail Yousuf Malik, for the commission of offences punishable under Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No.14/2024 of Police Station, Heerapora.
