**Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.**

Notification

Srinagar, the 05th November, 2024.

SO-531.—Whereas, on 14-07-2019 information was received at Police Station, Kokernag to the effect that a group of terrorists namely Zubair Ahmad Wani, Junaid Ahmad Bhat and Mohammad Ashraf Khan, have fired upon NC leader namely Syed Tauqeer Ahmad and his personal security officer (PSO) at Hillar Arhama, during a party workers meet in the premises of house belonging to Mohammad Jabbar

R/o Hillar, resulting in serious injuries to PSO Riyaz Ahmad who was shifted to a hospital for treatment. The terrorists after the commission of crime escaped from the spot ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 63/2019 under Sections 307 IPC, 7/27 Arms Act, and the Sections 16, 18 and 20 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Kokernag, and the investigation of the case was set in to motion. During the investigation, the injured Police personal succumbed to his injuries. Subsequently, the offence under Section 307 RPC was dropped and Sections 302 RPC, 38 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that on the date of occurrence the accused terrorists viz. Zubair Ahmad Wani S/o Afzal Wani R/o Dharnoo, Junaid Ahmad Bhat S/o Gh. Mohd Bhat R/o Hangalgund and Mohammad Ashraf Khan @ Mansoor-UI-Haq S/o Gh. Mohammad Khan R/o Tangpawa, fired indiscriminately upon the NC activist and his PSO which resulted death of the said police personal ; and

5. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Junaid Ahmad Bhat and Mohammad Ashraf Khan @ Mansoor-UI-Haq, have been killed in the different encounters with the Security Forces and proceedings under the law would abate against them ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against his name :—

7. Whereas, the accused viz. Zubair Ahmad Wani, is absconding and proceedings under section 299 Cr. PC have been proposed to be initiated against him ; and

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Zubair Ahmad Wani, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 16, 18, 20, 38 of ULA(P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 63/2019 of Police Station, Kokernag.
