**Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.**

GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR

Notification

Srinagar, the 06th November, 2024.

SO-534.—Whereas, on 30-09-2023 the Police Station, Banihal, received a written docket to the effect a Naka was established by the Police at Railway Chowk, Banihal. During the checking, the Police signaled to stop a vehicle (Innova), the driver and other person boarded in the vehicle tried to escape but were chased down on the spot and identified as Sarabjeet Singh S/o Praduman Singh R/o Balan Pind,

Jalandhar, Punjab and Honey Basra S/o Harmesh Lal R/o Mohalla Plahi Gate, Phagwara, Kapurthala, Punjab and recovered 30 packets of contraband (Heroin like substance) from the vehicle ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 242/2023 under Sections 8/21, 22, 29 NDPS Act, was registered in the Police Station, Banihal, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, Sections 27-A NDPS Act, 467, 468, 471, 489-C, 201, 120-B, 121, 121-A, 122 IPC, 3/7/25 Arms Act, 4/5/6 ESA and Sections 13, 18, 21, 23, 38, 39 and 40 of ULA(P) Act were added in the case.

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Manjit Singh @ Maan and Safeer Ahmad, were working for the terrorists and were providing logistic support to them and under a well knit criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition, Hand Grenade and incriminatory material from the terrorists, besides were facilitating the terrorists to sell the Narcotics so that the money generated could be utilized for carrying out terrorist/unlawful activities and to wage war against the Government of India. The accused viz. Manjit Singh @ Maan, and Safeer Ahmad, were knowingly holding the proceeds to terrorism ; and

5. Whereas, the sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Manjit Singh @ Maan, Safeer Ahmad and Shafiq Ahmed, was accorded by the Government vide Notification S.O No. 158 dated 12-03-2024, and the investigation, in respect of 02 accused kept continued to bring out their role/involvement in the case ; and

6. Whereas, during the further investigation, the accused viz. Satnam Singh S/o Gurdev Singh R/o Thandian, Shaheed Bhagat Nagar, Punjab, was arrested by Jalandhar Police in Case FIR No. 57/2024 of PS Div. No. 1, Jalandhar and his custody has been changed in the instant case and it was found that the accused alongwith his son viz. Manjit Singh @ Maan arranged the vehicle (Innova) and fake documents for the accused viz. Sarabjeet Singh and Honey Basra and deputed them to Parimpora, Srinagar, for procurement of narcotics from the accused viz. Safeer Ahmad ; and

7. Whereas, during the investigation, role of one more person namely, Vinod Kumar @ Lucky S/o Subash Chander R/o Sukhiabad, came to fore in the commission of crime and investigation, in respect of said accused alongwith accused viz. Navpreet Singh, shall continue to bring out their role/involvement in the case and supplementary Charge sheet against them would be filed in the Court of competent jurisdiction ; and

8. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Satnam Singh, was working for the terrorists and under a well knit criminal conspiracy facilitated the vehicle/fake documents for the accused viz. Sarabjeet Singh and Honey Basra for procurement of narcotics from the accused Safeer Ahmad ; and

9. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections as shown against his name :—

10. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law ; and

12. Whereas, the Government has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against

the above accused under the aforementioned provision of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) : and

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of the Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, and Section 196 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Satnam Singh, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections as indicated against his name at Para (9) above, arising out of FIR No. 242/2023 of Police Station, Banihal.
