**Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.**

Notification

Srinagar, the 06th November, 2024.

SO-535.—Whereas, on 12-05-2024 a written docket was received at Police Station, Pethkote, to the effect that some unknown terrorists have directed their OGWs to carry out some terrorist activities in the area. Accordingly, a CASO was launched by Police in collaboration with 26 Assam Rifles and 3rd Bn. CRPF at Mohalla Herpora, Bonakoot. During the search a person was noticed in suspicious circumstances,

who while seeing the Security Forces tried to flee from the spot but was tactfully apprehended. The person was identified as Ubaid Gulzar Malik S/o Gulzar Ahmad Malik R/o Bonakoot, Bandipora and arms/ammunition viz. 02 pistols, 08 magazines, 24 rounds, 01 grenade, 04 detonator and 207 rounds of AK-47 were recovered at his instance ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above a Case FIR No. 33/2024 under Sections 7/25 Arms Act, 20, 23, 39 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Pethkote, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Sections 18 and 38 of ULA(P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Ubaid Gulzar Malik, was working as OGW for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, and was in close contact with an active terrorist namely Hurrera S/o unknown R/o Pakistan, who provided the recovered arms/ammunition to him in order to promote terrorism in the area. The role/involvement in respect of PaK handler is yet to be ascertained and investigation would continue an supplementary charge sheet could be filed in the court of law ; and

5. Whereas, the investigation conducted by the investigating agency has *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Ubaid Gulzar Malik, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, particularly the PaK based terrorist viz. Hurrera, and in furtherance of conspiracy procured arms/ammunition for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation , the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against his name :—

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Ubaid Gulzar Malik, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 18, 23 39 of ULA(P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 33/2024 of Police Station, Pethkote.
