Notification

Srinagar, the 06th November, 2024.

SO-536.—Whereas, on 15-05-2024 a written docket was received at Police Station, Ganderbal to the effect that a Naka was established by the Police at Hadoora crossing. During the checking 02 persons were noticed in suspicious circumstances who while seeing the Naka Party tried to flee from the spot but were tactfully apprehended. The said persons were identified as Aqib Rashid Bhat S/o Ab. Rashid Bhat

R/o Hafroo, Batapora, Budgam and Roman Hilal Matoo S/o Hilal Ahmad Matoo R/o Eidgah, Srinagar. On being searched, 16 posters of TRF, a banned outfit, were recovered from their possession respectively ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above a Case FIR No. 106/2024 under sections 506 IPC, 13 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Ganderbal, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under section 201 IPC and Sections 18, 39 and 40 of ULA(P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, role of 05 more persons identified as Reyaz Ahmad Matta S/o Ab Aziz Matta R/o Rathpora, Eidgah Srinagar, Shahbaz Shameem Bhat S/o Shameem Ahmad Bhat, Pulwama, Tanveer Ahmad Bhat @ Molvi S/o Ali Mohammad Bhat, R's/o Lelhar, Pulwama, Momin Mehraj S/o Mehraj-Ud-Din Sofi R/o Rathpora, Srinagar and Junaid Ahmad Parray S/o Farooq Ahmad Parray R/o Braripora, Srinagar, came to fore in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused viz. Reyaz Ahmad Matta and Shahbaz Shameem Bhat, were arrested in the case and the other accused viz. Tanveer Ahmad Bhat, Momin Mehraj and Junaid Ahmad Parray, were found already arrested by the Police in the different cases and lodged in Central Jail, Srinagar ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Aqib Rashid Bhat, Roman Hilal Matoo, Reyaz Ahmad Matta, Shahbaz Shahmeem Bhat, Tanveer Ahmad Bhat @ Molvi, Momin Mehraj and Junaid Ahmad Parray, were working as OGWs for the terrorists of LeT/TRF banned outfits and Tanveer Ahmad Bhat @ Molvi, Momin Mehraj and Junaid Ahmad Parray, were in contact with a Pakistani based terrorist namely sajad Gull, through virtual mode, who provided the recovered posters to the accused viz. Aqib Rashid Bhat and Roman Hilal Matoo, through an unknown person ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Aqib Rashid Bhat, Roman Hilal Matoo, Reyaz Ahmad Matta, Shahbaz Shameem Bhat, received money from family members of some Jail inmates and later on purchased some mobile phones with accessories and handed over to accused viz. Aqib Rashid Bhat, who was working in the Central Jail, Srinagar. The accused viz. Aqib Rashid

Bhat, further handed over the mobile phones to the accused tanveer Ahmad Bhat @ Molvi, who distributed the same to other accused viz. Momin Mehraj and Junaid Ahmad Parray ; and

7. Whereas, the identity/involvement of unknown person/Pak handler are yet to be ascertained and investigation, would continue and supplementary charge sheet against them could be filed in the competent court of law ; and

8. Whereas, the investigation conducted by the investigating agency has *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Aqib Rashid Bhat, Roman Hilal Matoo, Reyaz Ahmad Matta, Shahbaz Shameem Bhat, Tanveer Ahmad Bhat @ Molvi, Momin Mehraj and Junaid Ahmad Parray, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT/TRF, banned outfits, and in furtherance of conspiracy were providing logistic support to the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist/unlawful activities in the area ; and

9. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against their names :—

10. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Aqib Rashid Bhat, Roman Hilal Matoo, Reyaz Ahmad Matta, Shahbaz Shameem Bhat, Tanveer Ahmad Bhat, Momin Mehraj and Junaid Ahmad Parray, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA(P) Act, against indicated against the each accused at Para (8) above, arising out of FIR No. 106/2024 of Police Station, Ganderbal.
