Notification

Jammu, the 26th November, 2024.

SO-548.—Whereas, on 03-06-2024, the Police Station, Kupwara, received a docket to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Govt. Higher Secondary School, Nagri. During

the checking, a suspect while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but was chased down on the spot and identified as Aijaz Ahmad Parray S/o Ghulam Mohammad Parray R/o Kunan, Poshpora, Kupwara. During the search, the Police recovered 01 Pistol with magazine, 04 Rounds and 01 Chinese Hand Grenade from a box carried by the accused ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 125/2024 under Sections 7/25 Arms Act, 13, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Kupwara, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law and during investigation ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Aijaz Ahmad Parray, was in contact with two PaK based handlers namely, Jabbar @ Jibran and Zubair, through virtual mode, who provided the recovered arms/ammunition to the accused viz. Aijaz Ahmad Parray, through an unknown person for the promotion of terrorism in the area. The identity/involvement in respect of PaK based handlers and unknown person are yet to be ascertained and the investigation shall continue and Supplementary Charge Sheet against them would be filed in the competent court of law ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Aijaz Ahmad Parray, was working as Over Ground Worker(OGW) for the terrorist of HM, a banned outfit, and procured arms/ammunition and explosive material from an unknown person for carrying out terrorist activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and the other evidence collected, the Investigating

Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :—

7. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Dairy File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Aijaz Ahmad Parray, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No.125/2024 of Police Station, Kupwara.
