Notification

Jammu, the 29th November, 2024.

SO-555.—Whereas, on 12-06-2024 the Police Station, Kralpora, received a docket from Major Adjutant 7th Bn. Parachute Regt (SF)

to the effect that based upon a specific input, a Joint Motor Vehicle Checking Point (MYCP) was established by the Police/Security Forces at Reddi Panzgam Road, Kupwara. During the checking, a suspect while seeing the Police/Security Forces tried to escape but was chased down on the spot and identified as Shabir Ahmad Gojar S/o Gulam Din Gojar R/o Gojar Pati, Laderwan, Kupwara. During his personal search, the Police recovered 01 Pistol with magazine, 10 rounds, 04 hand grenades and 02 IED sets from his possession ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 46/2024 under section 7/25 Arms Act, 5 ESA and Sections 13, 18, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station. Kralpora, and the investigation of the case was set into motion ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Shabir Ahmad Gojar, was working for some unknown terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, who provided the recovered arms/ammunition, hand grenades and IEDs to him in order promote terrorist activities in the area. The identity/involvement in respect of unknown person is yet to be ascertained and the investigation, shall continue and Supplementary Charge Sheet against him would be filed in the competent court of law ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Shabir Ahmad Gojar, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, and in furtherance of criminal conspiracy was facilitating the terrorists for transportation of their arms/ammunition from one place to another for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under

Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :—

S. No.	Name of the accused	Offence
1.	Shabir Ahmad Gojar S/o Gulam din Gojar R/o Gojar Pati, Laderwan, Kupwara	13, 18, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act.

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) or Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Shabir Ahmad Gojar., for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 18, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 46/2024 of Police Station, Kralpora.
