#### Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.

GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR

#### Notification

Jammu, the 2nd December, 2024.

SO-557.—Whereas, on 10.06.2024, the Police Station, Chararisharief received a docket to the effect that a Naka was established by the Police in collaboration with 181 Bn. CRPF at Bachinad crossing. During the checking, a suspect while seeing the Police/Security forces tried to flee but was chased down on the spot and identified as Umer Ahad Nagroo S/o Abdul Ahad Nagroo R/o Tilsara, Chararsharief. On being searched, 03 letter heads of banned TRF/LcT outfit were recovered from his possession ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 49/2024 under section 13 of ULA(P) Act was registered in the Police Station, Chararisharief, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Sections 20, 38 and 39 of ULA(P) Act, 'were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused namely, Umer Ahad Nagroo was in close contact with a terrorist of LeT, a banned outfit. namely Aqib Ahmad Shergojri S/o Nazir Ahmad Shergojri R/o Sari Khampora, Chadoora, who provided some posters to the accused viz. Umer Ahmad Nagroo, with the directions to paste the same in the area. Subsequently, during the investigation, 11 posters of TRF, a banned outfit, were also recovered at his instance ; and

5. Whereas, the investigation conducted by the investigating agency has *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Umer Ahad Nagroo, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorist viz. Aqib Ahmad Shergojri, and procured incriminatory material from the said terrorist for carrying out the unlawful activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima face* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against their names :—

S. No.	Name of the accused	Offence

2.	Aqib Ahmad Shergojri S/o Nazir Ahmad Shergojri R/o Sari Khampora, Chadoora.	13, 20, 38 of ULA (P) Act.

7. Whereas, the accused viz. Aqib Ahmad Shergojri, is absconding and proceedings under Section 299 Cr.PC. are proposed to be initiated against him ; and

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *a prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967,' the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Umcr Ahad Nagroo and Aqib Ahmad Shergojri, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against the each accused at Para (6) above, arising out of FIR No. 49/2024 of Police Station, Chararisharief.
