#### Jammu and Kashmir Government—Notifications.

#### Notification

Jammu, the 2nd December, 2024.

SO-558.—Whereas, on 04-07-2024, a written docket was received at Police Station, Keran to the effect that a CASO was established by Police in collaboration with 6 RR Army, 160 TA and 2 Bihar FID at Keran Bazar. During the checking a person Imtiyaz Ahmad Lohar S/o Gh. Mohammad Lohar R/o Dard Hari, Kralpora, was apprehended from a rented accommodation of Naseer Ahmad and arms/ammunition viz. 01 AK-47 with magazine and 30 rounds were recovered from his possession ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 05/2024 under section 7/25 Arms Act and Section 13 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in the Police Station, Keran, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Sections 18, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Lohar was working as OGW for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, and was in close contact with Pak handler namely Karamat Raja S/o Mohammad Arif R/o Kela Bandi, Muzaffarabad, through virtual mode who provided the recovered arms/ammunition to him for distribution among the terrorists. The role/involvement of PaK handler viz. Karamt Raja is yet to be ascertained and the investigation shall continue and Supplementary Charge Sheet against him would be filed in the competent court of law ; and

5. Whereas, Investigation conducted by the investigating agency has *a prima facie* established that the accused viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Lohar was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of LeT a banned outfit, and in furtherance of criminal conspiracy was facilitating the terrorists for transportation of their arms/ammunition from one place to another for carrying out the terrorist activities ; and

6. Whereas .. on the basis or the investigation, the statement or witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name:—

S. No.	Name of the accused	Offence
1.	Imtiyaz Ahmad Lohar S/o Gh. Mohammad Lohar R/o Dard Hari, Kralpora, Kupwara	13, 18, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act.

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary file, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) or Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Lohar, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 18, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 05/2024 of Police Station, Keran.
