SO-577.—Whereas, on 10-01-2024, an information was received at Police Station, Devsar, to the effect that despite of declaring the Tehreek-e-Hurriyat, Jammu and Kashmir as unlawful association by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, the members affiliated with the association are continuously involved themselves with the affairs of the association ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 05/2024 under sections 10, 13 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in the Police Station, Devsar, and the investigation, of the case was taken up ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the Statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the Case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, one person identified as Faizan Shabir Bhat @ Adil S/o Shabir Ahmad Bhat R/o Malpora, Mirbazar, Kulgam, was found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused was arrested in the case and during the investigation, some incriminating material was recovered at his instance ; and

5. Whereas, the investigation, conducted by the investigating agency has *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Faizan Shabir Bhat @ Adil, was member of Tehreek-e-Hurriyat (TeH), Jammu and Kashmir, an unlawful association, and was carrying out the unlawful activities despite the association was declared an unlawful vide Notification No. 5532(E) dated 31st December, 2023 by the Central Government, Ministry of Home Affairs ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their Names :—

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the

conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is Sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution, under provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Faizan Shabir Bhat @ Adil, for the commission of offences punishable under the Sections 10 & 13 of ULA (P) Act, arising out FIR No. 05/2024 of Police Station, Devsar.
