Notification

Jammu, 18th December, 2024.

SO-578.—Whereas, on 19-02-2024, the Police Station, CI/SIA, Jammu, received an information to the effect that some unknown terrorist and their associaes, in furtherance of large criminal conspiracy, while acting as a front namely 'Kashmir Fights' with an intent to strike terror in the people, sections of people and the threaten the unity, integrity, security and sovereignty of India, uploaded, posted and

circulated, pictures/posters/images/profiles, identities of several persons, Government Servants on social media, who stand with and support the Government established by law and its agencies and labeling them as “Stooges of Indian Agencies” ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 01/2024 under sections 13, 18 of ULA (P) Act, 506 IPC, and 66F IT Act, was registered in the Police Station, CI/SIA Jammu, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation of the offence under Section 201 IPC, and the Sections 38, 39 of ULA (P) Act, were added in the case and Section 66F IT was dropped from the Case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the Statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the Case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that two persons identified as Farhan Muzaffar Matoo S/o Muzaffar Jan Matoo R/o Firdous Colony, Bouchpora, Upper Soura, Srinagar and Sheikh Sajjad Ahmad alias Sajjad Gul S/o Dr. Ghulam Mohammed Sheikh R/o Lane No. 2, Rose Avenue Colony, HMT, Srinagar A/P Pakistan, disseminated threatening posters containing the names, Phone numbers and photographs of Kashmiri Pandits and Non-Locals working in the Kashmir Valley through social media platform linked to “Kashmir Fight” operated by the accused viz. Sajjad Ahmed alias Sajjad Gul, creating an atmosphere of fear and intimidation ; and

5. Whereas, the investigation, conducted by the investigating agency has *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Farhan Muzaffar Matoo, was working for the terrorist viz. Sheikh Sajjad Ahmad alias Sajjad Gul, and on his directions shared the details of Kashmiri Pandits and Non-Locals with the said terrorist through social media platform “Kashmir Fight”, thereby challenged the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Union of India ; and

6. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of accused viz. Sheikh Sajjad Ahmad alias Sajjad Gul, and other shall continue to bring out their role/involvement in the case and the Supplementary Chargesheet against them would be filed in the court of competent jurisdiction ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against his name :—

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is Sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution, under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Farhan Muzaffar Matoo, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 18 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 01/2014 of Police Station, CI/SIA, Jammu.
