Jammu, the 12th January, 2024.

SO658.& Whereas, on 26-07-2023, the Police Station, Taroo, received a written docket to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Sher Colony Sopore, and during the Naka checking 02 suspects while seeing Naka Party tried to flee from the spot but were tactfully apprehended and identified as Manzoor Ahmad Bhat S/o Abdul Rashid Bhat ; Tanveer Ahmad Lone S/o Gh.

 Mohammad Lone residents of Darnambal, Tarzoo, Sopore. During the checking the Police recovered 02 Hand Grenades and 08 Pistol rounds from their possession respectively ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above a case FIR No. 78/2023 under section 7/25 Arms Act, 18, 23, 39 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Tarzoo, and the investigation, of case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Section 18 of ULA(P) Act was dropped from the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Manzoor Ahmad Bhat and Tanveer Ahmad Lone, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT, a banned outfit, and were providing logistic support to them, besides arms/ammunition recovered from them intended to be used for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :

6. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary, File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Manzoor Ahmad bhat and Tanveer Ahmad Lone, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 23 and 39 of ULA(P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 78/2023 of Police Station, Tarzoo.
