Notification

Jammu, 18th December, 2024.

SO-581.—Whereas, on 6-03-2014, the Police Station, Parimpora, received a docket to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Shalteng, HMT Crossing. During the checking, a suspect while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but was chased down on the spot and identified as Mohd Ramzan Khan @ Altaf S/o Gh. Nabi Khan R/o Gundpora, Nadihal, Sumbal, Bandipora. During his personal search, the Police recovered 01 hand grenade and cash to the tune of Rs. 29000/- from his possession ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 34/2014 under section 7/25 Arms Act, 13, 20, 40 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in the Police Station, Parimpora and the investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Section 20 of ULA (P) Act, was dropped and Sections 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the Case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Ramzan Khan @ Altaf, was in contact with some unknown terrorists of HM, a banned outfit who provided the recovered hand grenade and cash to the accused in order to promote terrorism in the area ; and

5. Whereas, the investigation conducted by the investigating agency has *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Ramzan Khan @ Altaf, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of HM, a banned outfit, and procured hand grenade and cash from the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist/unlawful activities ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his Name :—

7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the

other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is Sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution, under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mohd Ramzan Khan @ Altaf, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 23, 39 and 40 of ULA (P) Act, arising out FIR No. 34/2014 of Police Station, Parimpora.
