Notification

Jammu, 23rd December, 2024.

SO—583.—Whereas, on 30-06-2024, the Police Station, Baramulla, received a docket to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Secuirty Forces at Dankhan, Morh, Baramulla. During the checking, a suspect while seeing the Naka Party tried to escape but was chased down on the spot and identified as Shakir Ahmad Lone S/o Abdul Rashid Lone R/o Dangerpora, Sheeri, Baramulla. During his personal search, the Police recovered 01 Pistol with magazine, 08 rounds and 01 hand grenade from his possession ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 160/2024 under section 7/25 Arms Act and the Sections 13, 23, and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Baramulla, and the investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Sections 18, 20 and 38 of ULA (P) Act, were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the Statements of the witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the Case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Shakir Ahmad Lone, was in contact with a Pak based terrorist namely, Rizwan Bhai R/o Pakistan, who provided the recovered arms/ammunition and some hand grenades to the accused in order to promote terrorism in the area. Subsequently, during the investigation, 02 more hand grenades were recovered at his instance of accused viz. Shakir Ahmad Lone ; and

5. Whereas, the identity/role of PaK based terrorist viz. Rizwan Bhai, in the case is yet to be ascertained and the investigation, of the case shall continue and Supplementary Charge against him would be filed in the competent court of law.

6. Whereas, the investigation, conducted by the investigating agency has *prima facie* established that the accused viz. Shakir Ahmad Lone, was working for the terrorists and in furtherance of criminal conspiracy procured arms/ammunition and explosive material from the terrorist (s) for carrying out the terrorist/unlawful activities in the area ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his Name :—

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution, under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Shakir Ahmad Lone, for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 13, 18, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out FIR No. 160/2024 of Police Station, Baramulla.
