Hardushiva, Sopore, During checking, the Police recovered 02 Pistol,
02 Pistol Magazines, 10 rounds and 04 Hand Grenades from the vehicle
and an amount of Rs. 50,000/- from the possession of accused viz.
Muneer Ahmad ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above a case FIR No. 104/2023 under
Section 120-B IPC, 7/25 Arms Act and Sections 13, 16, 18 and 23 of
ULA(P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Uri, and the
investigation, of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the
investigation, the offence under Section 16 of ULA(P) Act was dropped
and the Sections 18-B, 20 and 40 of ULA(P) Act were added in the
case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the
place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the
statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances
of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the
accused viz. Muneer Ahmad, was in contact with his maternal uncle
namely ; Mohd Hassan Awan S/o Raj Mohd Awan R/o Dharkote, Uri,
A/P Bagh Azad, PoK, who crossed the LoC in the year 1990 and is
presently operating from the PoK ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused
viz. Muneer Ahmad, on the directions of Pakistani based accused
viz. Mohd Hassan Awan, motivated the accused viz. Mohammad Aslam
Khatana, for transportation of Arms/Ammunition and narcotics
from across the border in order to promote terrorist activities in the
valley ; and

6. Whereas, the investigation, it was found that as per the
directions of the accused viz. Mohammad Aslam Khatana, procured
arms/ammunition and narcotics from across the border and handed over
the same to the accused viz. Muneer Ahmad, who concealed the arms/
ammunition and Hand Grenades in Village Powdiyan Nallah, and
sold the narcotics to one Atiqullah R/o Sopore, against an amount
of Rs. 3,30,000/- which was later on distributed by the accused among
themselves ; and
