Notification

Jammu, the 9th February, 2024.

SO-89.66-Whereas, on 25-08-2023, the Police Station, Kupwara, received a docket to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Shalpora, Dragmaulla. During the checking, the Police intercepted a vehicle (Alto-800) and recovered a hand grenade from the vehicle and arrested the driver of the vehicle identified

as Zahoor Ahmad Khan S/o Gh. Nabi Khan R/o Nagri, Malpora,
Kupwara ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 229/2023 under
Sections 7/25 Arms Act and Sections 13,23 & 39 of ULA (P) Act,
was registered in the Police Station, Kupwara, and the investigation,
of the case was set into motion ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of
the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and
the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances
of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused
viz. Zahoor Ahmad Khan, was in contact with an unknown terrorist
of HM, a banned outfit, through the virtual mode who provided the
recovered hand grenade to the accused viz. Zahoor Ahmad Khan,
through an unknown person in order to promote terrorist activities in
the area ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the
accused viz. Zahoor Ahmad Khan, was working as Over Ground
Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of HM, a banned outfit, and was
providing logistic support to them, besides, procured a hand grenade
from the terrorists for carrying out the terrorist/unlawful activities in
the area ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of
witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating
Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below
mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under
Sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown
against his name :

7. Whereas, 'the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

8. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary file, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Zahoor Ahmad Khan, for the commission of offences punishable under Section 13, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 229/2023 of Police Station, Kupwara.
