Notification

Srinagar, the 28th June, 2016.

SRO-202.—Whereas, the Government vide Notification SRO-260 dated 09-09-2008, appointed Additional District and Sessions Judge, Jammu as an Ex. Officio Arbitrator to make an award in respect of land measuring 110 Kanals and 14 Marlas situated at Village Deeli, Tehsil and District Jammu ; and

Whereas, vide SRO-70 dated 26-03-2009, SRO No. 297 dated 25-09-2009, SRO No. 128 dated 19-03-2010, further extension was granted to the Arbitrator for making the Award ; and

Whereas, the said Arbitrator could not complete the arbitration proceedings and make the award within the stipulated period of time ; and

Whereas, the Additional District Judge, Jammu, vide Letter No. 373/ADJ dated 08-12-2015 has requested for extension in time by a period of four months to enable him to conclude the proceedings and make the Award ; and

Whereas, after examining the matter in consultation with the Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs, the Government, has decided that further extension be granted to the Arbitrator to complete the arbitration proceedings.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under sub-rule (1) of rule 10 of the Jammu and Kashmir Requisitioning and Acquisition of Immovable Property Rules, 1969, the Government hereby directs that the time for making the award shall and shall always be deemed to have been extended by a further period of four months, during which the Arbitrator shall make the award positively and no further extension shall be granted.
