SRO-272.—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to section 124 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir, the Governor hereby make the following rules, namely :—

1. *Short title and commencements.*—(1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Government Engineering Colleges (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2017.
(2) These rules shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in the Government Gazette.

2. *Definitions.*—In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—

- (a) “Administrative Department” means the Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the administrative charge of the service ;
- (b) “Cadre” means the Cadre of the service ;
- (c) “Commission” means the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission ;
- (d) “Government” means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir ;
- (e) “Member of the Service” means a person appointed to a post in the service under the provisions of these rules ;
- (f) “Post” means a permanent post carrying a definite time scale sanctioned by the competent authority ;

- (g) “Rules” means the Jammu and Kashmir Government Engineering Colleges (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2017;
- (h) “Schedule” means the schedule(s) annexed to these rules ;
- (i) “Service” means the Jammu and Kashmir Government Engineering Colleges (Gazetted) Service ;
- (j) “State” means the Jammu and Kashmir State ;
- (k) Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

3. *Constitution of service.*—(1) From the date of commencement of these rules there shall be constituted the “Jammu and Kashmir Government Engineering Colleges (Gazetted) Service”.

(2) For the purpose of initial constitution of service, any person who at the commencement of these rules is holding in a substantive capacity any post included in the cadre of the service ; shall be deemed to have been appointed to the service under these rules unless he/she opts otherwise within 15 days from the commencement of these rules.

Explanation :—The word “holding” means a person holding a post included in the cadre of the Jammu and Kashmir Government Engineering Colleges (Gazetted) Service in its sanctioned scale of pay and who has been appointed on substantive basis by the competent authority and will not cover the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on *ad hoc* basis or in a stop-gap arrangement.

4. *Strength and composition of the service.*—(1) The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and the nature of the posts included therein shall be determined by the Government, from time to time

and shall be at the initial constitution of the service under these rules, be such as specified in the Schedule-I annexed to these rules.

(2) The Government shall, at the interval of every three years or at such other intervals as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of the cadre of the service and make such alterations therein as is required.

5. *Qualification and method of recruitment.*—(1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in any class, category or grade in the service unless he/she possesses the qualifications as laid down in the Schedule-II/Career Advancement Scheme and fulfils other requirements of recruitment as provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force.

(2) Appointment to the service shall be made on the recommendations of the Public Service Commission—

- (a) by direct recruitment ;
- (b) by selection/promotion ; and
- (c) partly by direct recruitment and partly by selection/promotion in the manner mentioned against each post in Schedule-II appended to these rules and under Career Advancement Scheme :

Provided that all the vacancies shall be filled through Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission/DPC as per the rules/statutory order of the Government issued for the purpose :

Provided further that all posts to be filled by promotion/placement shall be processed through a process of selection

by the Screening Committee to be constituted in the Administrative Department :

Provided also that Minimum qualification for direct recruitment/promotion reflected in Schedule-II is applicable for the teachers who will be appointed after the enforcement of these rules.

6. *Career Advancement Scheme—*

- i. Persons, on their appointment in the college, shall be designated as Assistant Professors and shall be placed in the pay band of Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP of Rs. 6000/- . Lecturers, already in-service in the pre-revised scale of Rs. 8000-13500 shall be re-designated as Assistant Professors with the AGP of Rs. 6000/- ;
- ii. An Assistant Professor with completed service of 4 years, possessing Ph. D. Degree in the relevant discipline, shall be eligible for moving up to the AGP of Rs. 7000/- ;
- iii. An Assistant Professor, possessing an M. Phil Degree or a Master's Degree in professional courses, shall be eligible for the AGP of Rs. 7000, after the completion of five years service as Assistant Professor ;
- iv. An Assistant Professor, who does not have a Ph. D. or an M. Phil Degree or a Master's Degree in professional courses, shall be eligible for the AGP of Rs. 7000/- only after the completion of six years service as Assistant Professor ;
- v. The upward movement from the AGP of Rs. 6000 to the AGP of Rs. 7000 for all Assistant Professors shall be subject to their satisfying other conditions, as laid down by the AICTE (Schedule-II) ;

- vi. The incumbents on the posts of Lecturers (Sr. Scale) i. e. the pre-revised scale of Rs. 10000-15200, shall be re-designated as Assistant Professors, and their pay shall be fixed at the appropriate stage in the Pay Band of Rs.15600-39100, based on their present pay, with AGP of Rs. 7000 ;
- vii. An Assistant Professor, with completed service of five years at the AGP of Rs. 7000, shall be eligible, subject to other requirements laid down by the AICTE (Schedule-II), to move up to the AGP of Rs. 8000 ;
- viii. Posts of Associate Professors shall be in the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000, with AGP of Rs. 9000. Directly recruited Associate Professors shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000, with an AGP of Rs. 9000, at the appropriate stage in the Pay Band in terms of the conditions of appointment ;
- ix. Incumbent Lecturers (Selection Grade)/Assistant Professors, who have completed 3 years in the current Pay Scale of Rs. 12,000-18,300 on 1-1-2006, shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 37,400-67,000, with AGP of Rs. 9000/-, and shall be re-designated as Associate Professors ;
- x. Incumbent Lecturers (Selection Grade/Assistant Professors), who had not completed three years in the pay scale of Rs. 12000-18300 on 1-1-2006, shall be placed at the appropriate stage in the Pay Band of Rs.15600-39100 with AGP of Rs. 8000, till they complete 3 years of service in the grade of Lecturer (SG)/Assistant Professor, and, thereafter, shall be placed in the higher Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000, with AGP of Rs. 9000, and shall be re-designated as Associate Professors ;

- xii. Lecturers (SG)/Assistant Professors in service at present, shall continue to be designated as Lecturers (SG)/Assistant Professors in the Pay Band of Rs.15600-39100, with AGP of Rs. 8000, until they are placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000, and re-designated as Associate Professor in the manner described at Clause (x) ;
- xiii. Assistant Professors, completing 3 years of teaching in the AGP of Rs. 8000, shall be placed in the Pay Band of Rs. 37400-67000, with AGP of Rs. 9000, and are to be designated as Associate Professors ;
- xiv. Associate Professors, completing 3 years of service in the AGP of Rs. 9000 and possessing a Ph. D. Degree in the relevant discipline, shall be eligible to be appointed and designated as Professors in the Pay Band of Rs. 37,400-67000, with AGP of Rs.10,000, subject to the other conditions of academic performance, as laid down by the AICTE (Schedule-II). No teachers, other than those with a Ph. D. shall be promoted/appointed or designated as Professors ;
- xv. The pay of a directly recruited Professor shall be fixed at a stage not below Rs. 43,000/- in the Pay Band of Rs. 37,400-67,000, with the applicable AGP of Rs. 10,000 ;
- xvi. For initial direct recruitment at the level of Associate Professors and Professors, the eligibility conditions in respect of academic and research requirements shall be such as may be or have been prescribed by the AICTE through Regulations and/or laid down by the AICTE (Schedule-II) ;
- xvii. Appointments to the post of Principal shall be based on the conditions of eligibility, laid down by the AICTE from time to time. The post of Principal shall be in the Pay Band of Rs. 37,400-67,000, with AGP of Rs.10,000, plus a Special Allowance of Rs. 3000/.

7. *Probation*.—(1) Persons appointed to the service by direct recruitment shall be “on probation for two years” and their confirmation for any class or category shall be made under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

(2) The pay of a person appointed to the service under these rules shall be regularized as per the provisions of J&K Civil Services Regulation or General Rules as issued from time to time.

8. *Reservation in appointments*.—While making appointments either by direct recruitment or by selection/placement, reservation shall be made in accordance with the rules and orders issued from time to time for members of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes/Backward Classes or any other category or class of permanent residents of State under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and Reservation Rules in force.

9. *Training and departmental examination*.—Persons appointed to the service by competitive examination shall be required to undergo such training from time to time during the course of service and to pass during the period of probation or trial such departmental examination as the Government may prescribe :

Provided that the Government may exempt persons from such training or departmental examination either wholly or partly, who have passed a departmental examination or undergone training declared by Government to be equivalent to a departmental examination or training prescribed under these rules.

10. *Eligibility of Government servants for direct recruitment*.—A person already in the Government service may apply through proper channel for direct recruitment to a vacant post in any particular class or category in the service if he/she possesses the educational and other qualifications prescribed for recruitment to such class or category

of post. The upper age limit of such Government servants shall be provided in the general rules :

Provided that in the case of a post which requires a higher degree of specialization or experience, the Government may prescribe higher age limit.

11. *Maintenance of seniority lists.*—Seniority of the members of the service shall be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956. The Administrative Department shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of the service.

12. *Residuary matters.*—In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the service shall be governed by the rules, regulations and orders applicable to the State Civil Service in general.

13. *Interpretation.*—If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules the matter shall be referred to the Administrative Department whose decision thereon shall be final and binding.

14. *Repeal and savings.*—(1) All rules corresponding to these rules and in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment order made or action taken under the provisions of the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
