The terms of reference for the Committee shall be as follows :—

Terms of Reference

- i. To take effective measures for collection, comparing and analyzing road accident data, provision of trauma and health care facilities to the victims of the road accidents ;
- ii. To provide regular inputs to the State Road Safety Council and recommend road safety measures especially with the identification of major accident prone areas/black spots, etc. ;
- iii. To coordinate with District Disaster Management Committee/ Quick Reaction Teams (QRTs), concerned organisation dealing with Road Safety Management, conduct the road

safety audit of the roads within the territorial limits of the District and advise for measures to be taken mitigating the road accidents and for better management of traffic within the district ;

- iv. To implement the State Road Safety Policy ;
- v. To conduct road safety programmes at regular intervals ;
- vi. To implement directions of the Government of India and the State Government as may be issued from time to time on matter of road safety ;
- vii. To act as the nodal body for placing requirement and disbursal of road safety funds and interacts with the State Road Safety Council as and when required ;
- viii. To formulate District Road Safety Action Plan ;
- ix. To take such other steps as may be necessary for ensuring road safety within the jurisdiction of the district ;
- x. Meet at least once in quarter of the year ; and
- xi. Submit such reports/returns/information to the Transport Commissioner as may be required from time to time and the Transport Commissioner shall submit a consolidated report to the State Road Safety Council.

The District Road Safety Committee shall exercise such powers and perform such functions, as the State Road Safety Council may specify from time to time.
