Notification

Jammu, the 30th January, 2018.

SRO-48.—The Government hereby further amend the Jammu and Kashmir Government Medical Colleges (Selection of candidates for Postgraduation Degree and Diploma Courses) Procedure Order 1995, as under :—

- (1) 2nd proviso to sub-clause (v) of clause 3 shall be substituted by the following :—

“provided further that the doctors who are doing postgraduation/diploma courses in any specialty at the

Government expenses including those who leave the course midway after cut of date of admission shall not be eligible to apply for undergoing postgraduation courses in any other specialty in the State Medical Institutions till completion of their Postgraduation/Diploma Courses, as the case may be. In case of candidates having left the course midway after taking admission they shall be barred from seeking admission again until they would have normally completed the course had they not left it midway.”

(2) Clause 4-A shall be substituted by the following :—

“4-A. **Weightage of serving in difficult areas.**—

The candidates shall be entitled to weightage for serving in the difficult areas as defined under notification SRO-201 of 2006 dated 15-06-2006 to the extent of additional 10% for each year of completed service in such areas subject to a maximum of 30% of the marks obtained in the written test :

Provided that each completed year of service shall mean actual service days even on *ad hoc*/contractual basis or as NRHM Doctor in these areas to be certified by the concerned Director, Health Services and shall exclude the days spent on any training programme or absence of any kind except such absence on casual leave”.
