S.O.-28.6Whereas, on 09-04-2008 Police Station, Pulwama received information to the effect that Police Party along with Army 31 RR apprehended one suspect person namely, Manzoor Ahmad Sheikh S/o Abdul Gani Sheikh R/o Rampora, Kulgam a POK trained militant of HM 2. Whereas, a case FIR No. 105/2008 under sections 121-A RPC, 10 ULA(P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Pulwama and investigation of the case was taken up ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation site plan and seizure memo of the recovered identity card were prepared, statement of witnesses under sections 161, 164-A Cr. P. C. were recorded and investigation conducted revealed that the accused Manzoor Ahmad Sheikh S/o Abdul Gani Sheikh R/o Rampora, Kulgam has been member of HM outfit and has crossed over to POK for arms training and returned back with the aim of committing unlawful activities in the J&K ; and

4. Whereas, the investigation conducted, *prima facie* established the commission of offence punishable unde section 10 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, against the accused person namely, Manzoor Ahmad Sheikh S/o Abdul Gani Sheikh R/o Rampora, Kulgam; and

5. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently scrutinized the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to a definite conclusion that this is a fit case for accord of prosecution sanction against the said accused person; and

6. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the observations/views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused person for his prosecution under the aforesaid provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby accords sanction for launching
