SO-105 Whereas, on 03-10-2017, Police Post, Humhama through reliable sources came to know that some unknown terrorists with their illegal arms/ammunition barged into the BSF camp of 182 Bn Gogoland, Humhama and resorted to indiscriminate firing upon the security forces in order to kill them ; and

Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently scrutinized Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the accused ; and

10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Fayaz Ahmad Magray, Mohammad Amin Allie, Mushtaq Ahmad Wani and Javaid Ahmad Sofi for the commission of offences punishable under relevant sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as indicates against each accused in para (8) above, arising out of FIR No. 229/2017 of Police Station, Budgam.
